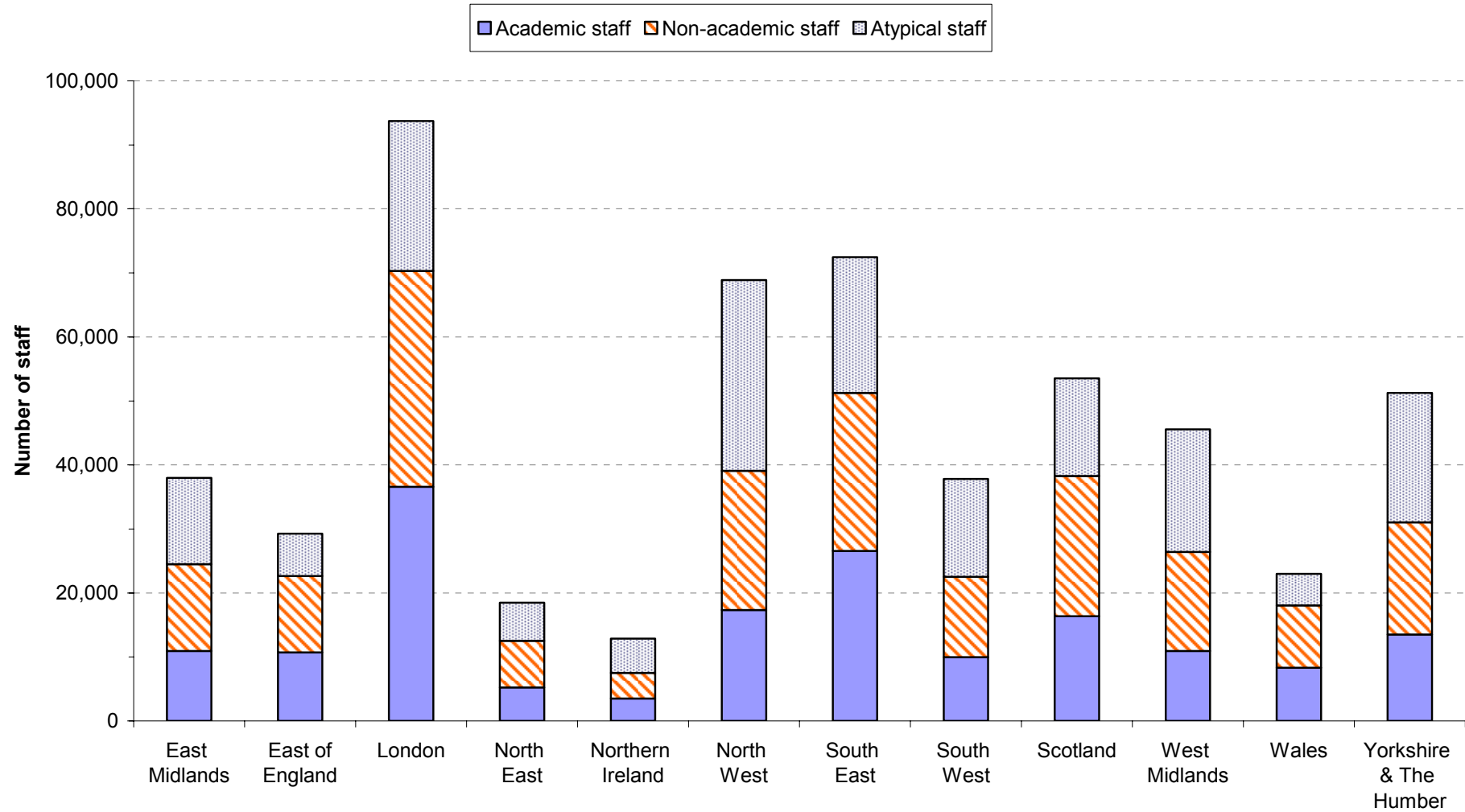


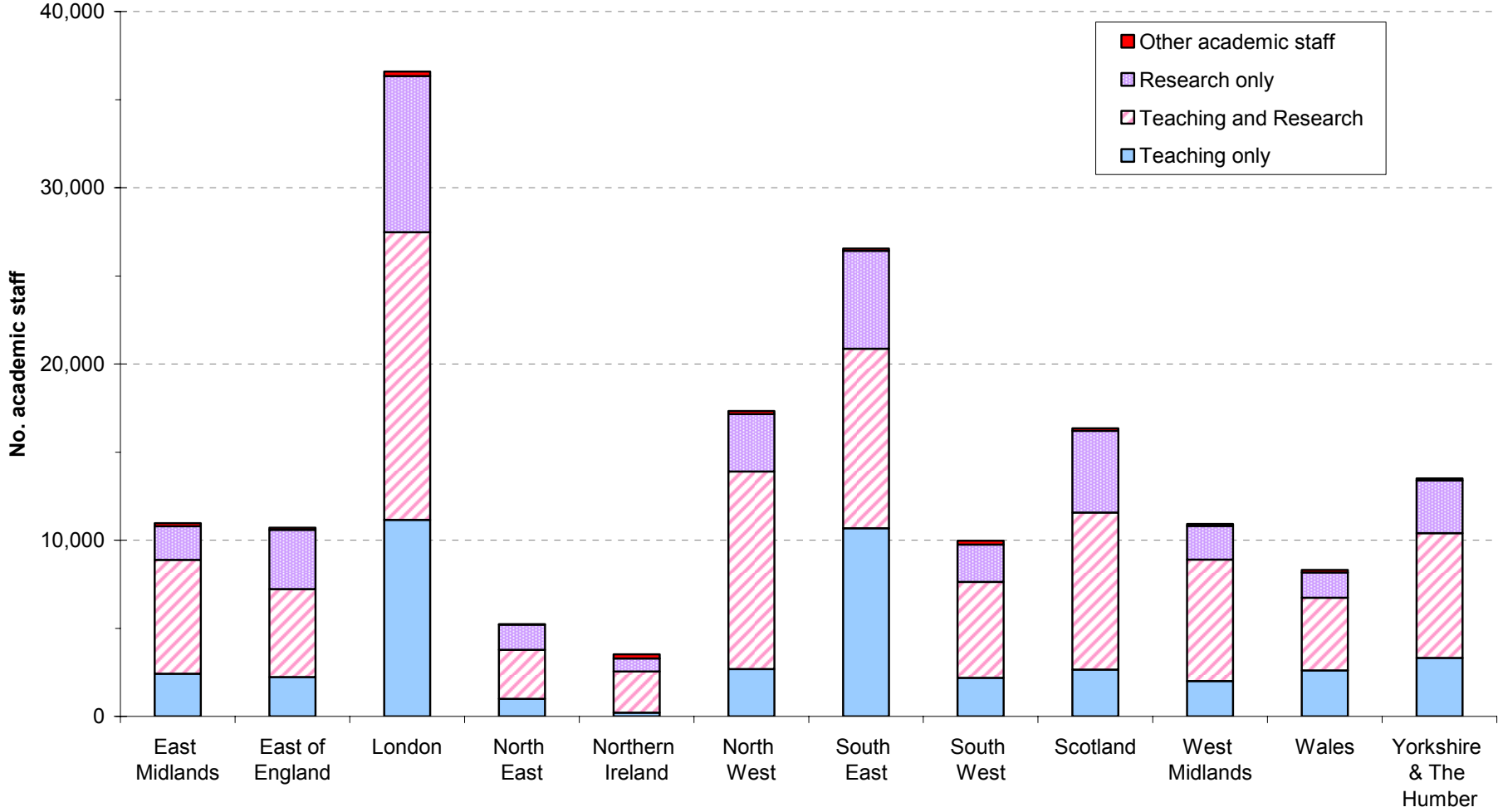
- London universities and colleges employ almost 94,000 staff, or 17% of 545,000 staff at all UK higher education institutions (HEIs)
- There are 36,600 academic staff at London HEIs, comprising 22% of 170,000 academic staff in the UK
- 75% of academic staff in London are involved in teaching or teaching and research
- 60% of academic staff in London are full-time; 45% of academic staff are women
- 35% of London academic staff are employed in Medicine, Dentistry and Healthcare while 3% are in Archeology, Architecture or Geography

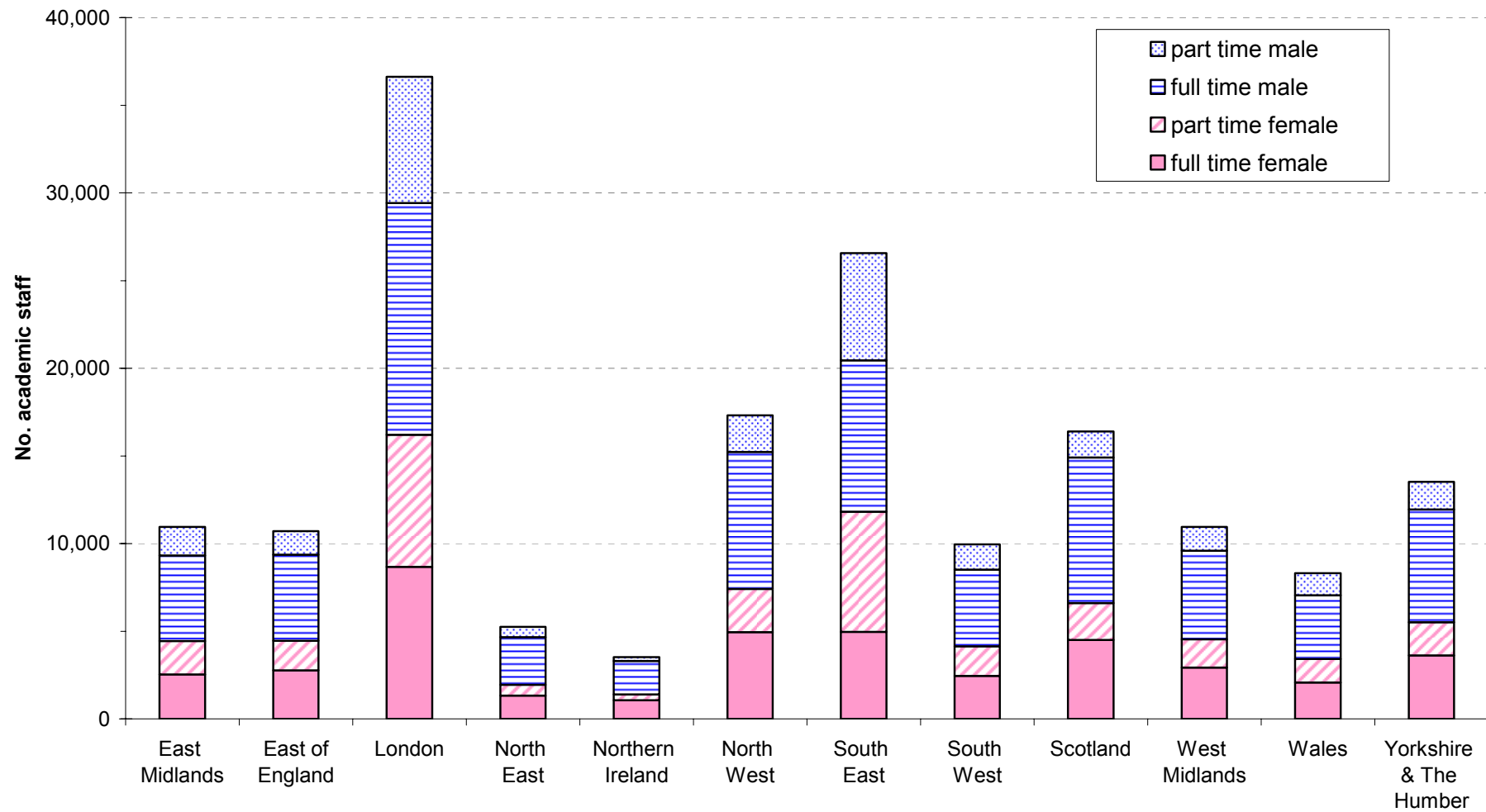
Higher Education staff by Region, 2006/07



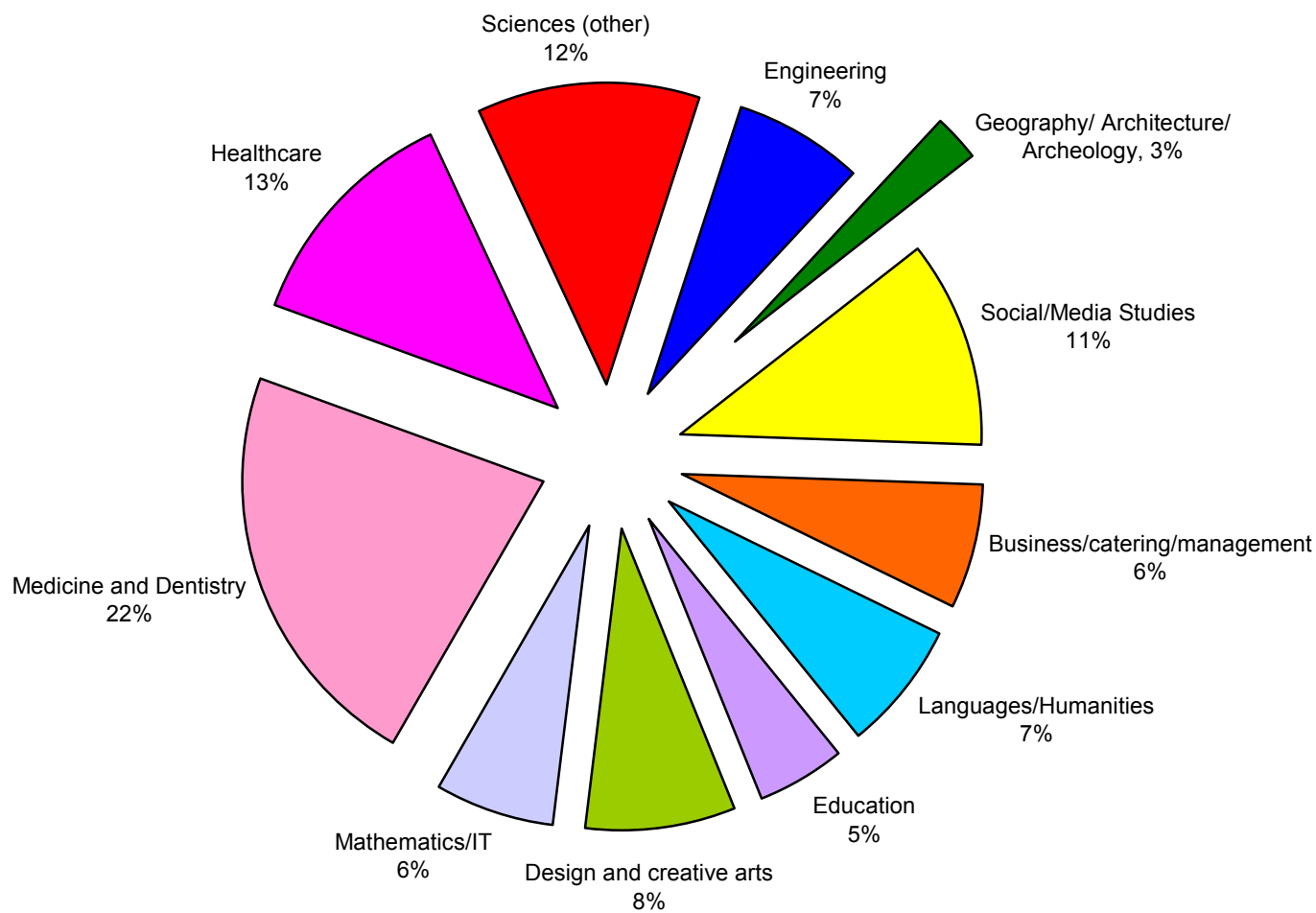
Academic staff by Function and Region, 2006/07
