Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council: research grant awards 2010/11

1. Awards made between April 2010 and March 2011 were summed by UK region for targeted mode , responsive mode and combined research grants, but excluding Fellowships, Research Chairs, Joint External Funding (JEFI) or training awards.
2. Of 114 research organisations (RO) applying for grants, 22 were based in London and 17 received one or more grants.

1. Overall success rates were highest in the East and North East at 42%.
2. The success rate of 37% for London was a slight increase from 31% in 2009/10 (181 awards from 587 applications).
3. In London, ROs received £107.4 million (£11 million more than 2009/10) which was equivalent to 22% of the £487.7 million in grants disbursed by EPSRC.
4. Of the 157 grants awarded to ROs in London, Imperial College obtained 68 and UCL had 46.
