

HEFCE RECURRENT GRANTS FOR 2011/12 – LONDON REGION

- Provisional allocations for grants to higher education institutions (HEIs) and further education colleges (FECs) were released in March 2010
- 41 HEIs in London¹, comprising 32% of 130 HEIs in England, are to receive £1, 375 million, or 24% of £5, 745 million available for 2011/12
- 15 FECs in London, 12% of 124 funded by HEFCE, are to receive £13.7 million, or 7% of the total of £184 million from HEFCE
- London's HEIs will receive 22% of £4,160 million in total teaching funding, 30% of £1,558 million in research funding and 10% of £129 million under widening participation
- For quality-related research funding, London HEIs have been allocated £80 million for charity support; £57 million for postgraduate supervision (RDP); £32 million in London weighting; £18 million for business research and £1 million as special funding for national research libraries
- Overall, recurrent grants to London will be 3.6% less than last year for HE and 4.0% less for FE
- A Top 20 list for total recurrent grant allocation includes four research-intensive HEIs from London
- Within London, the same top four HEIs will receive 67% of research funding and 43% of total recurrent grants

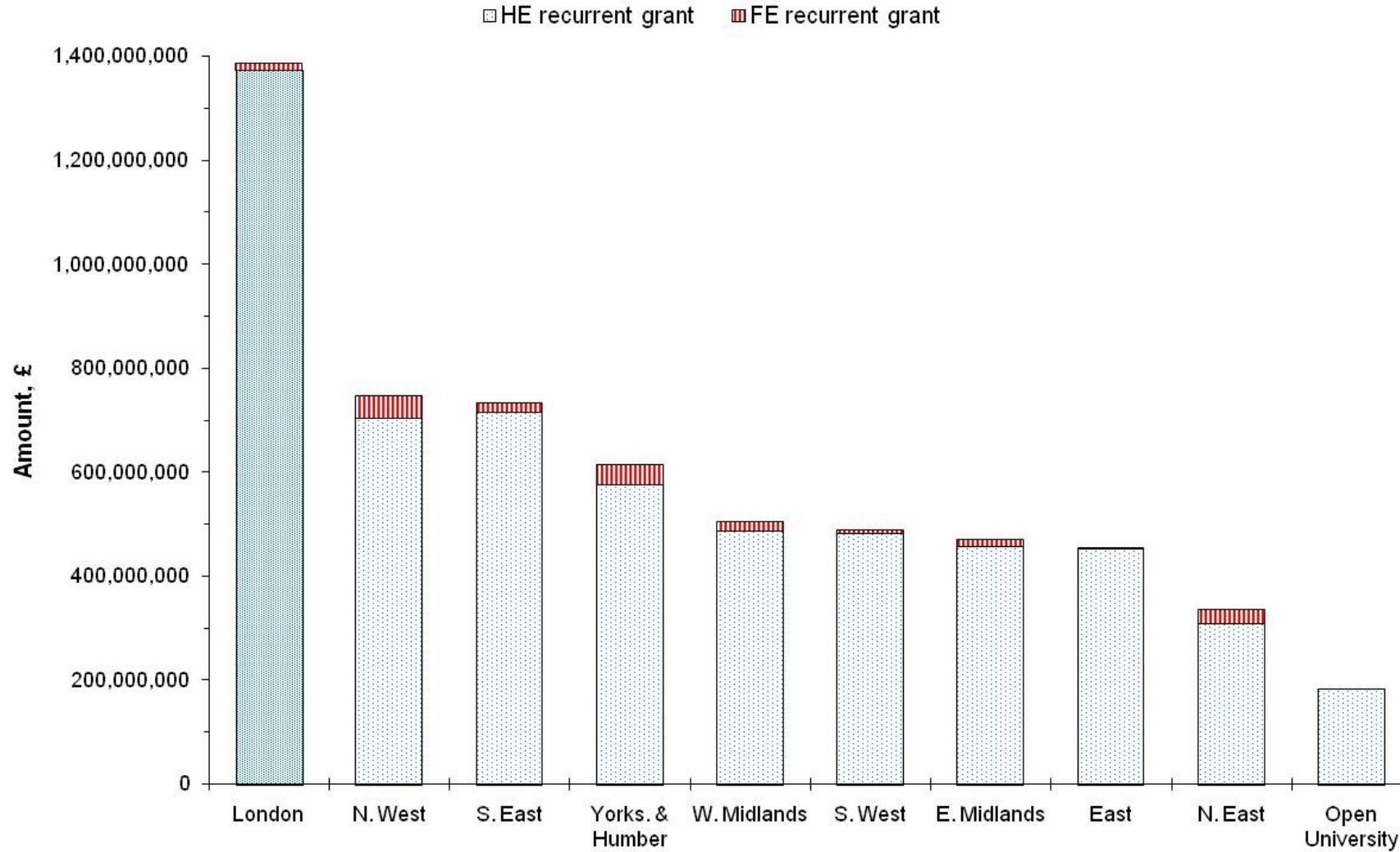

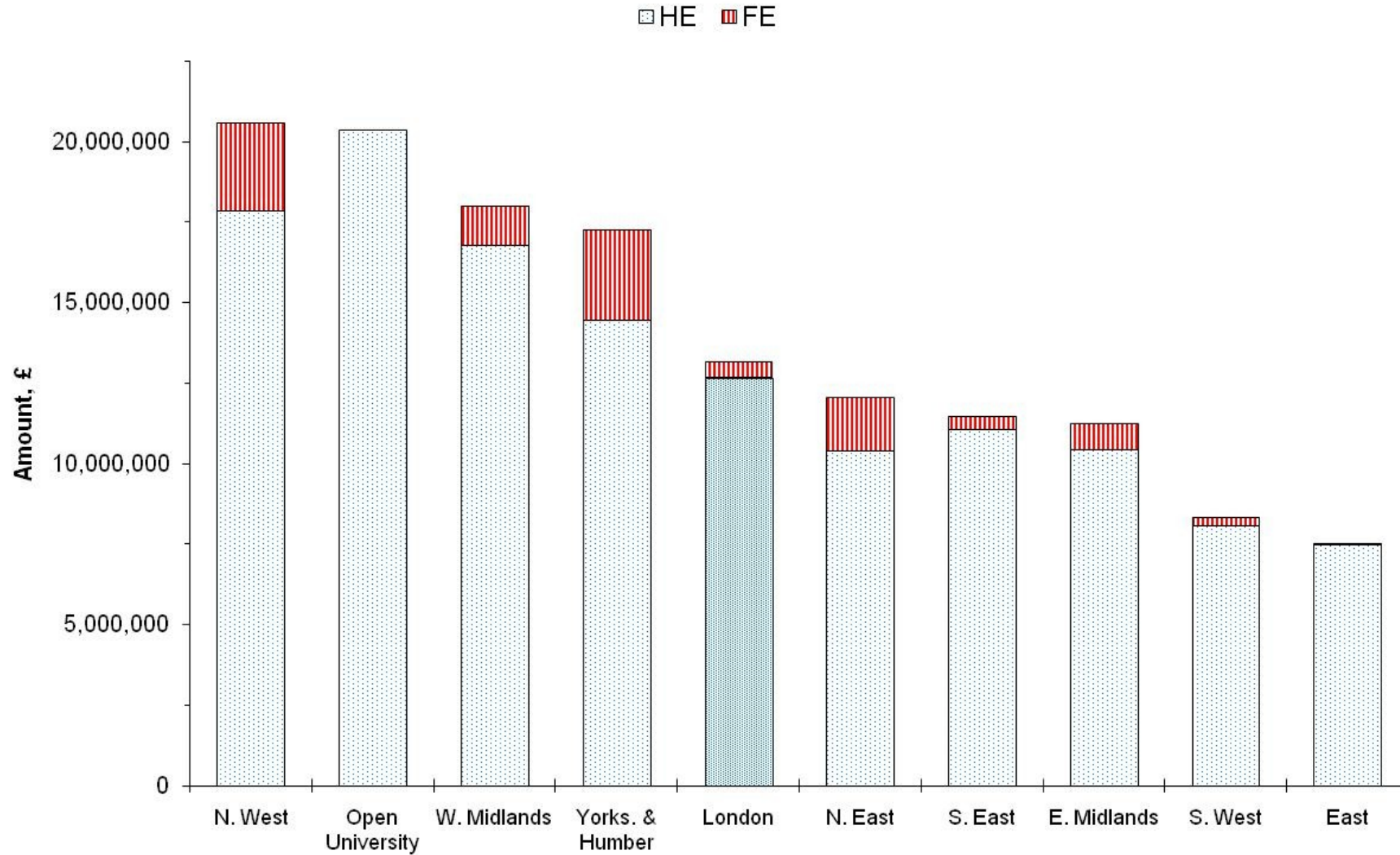

HEFCE total grant allocations for HE and FE by Region, 2011/12



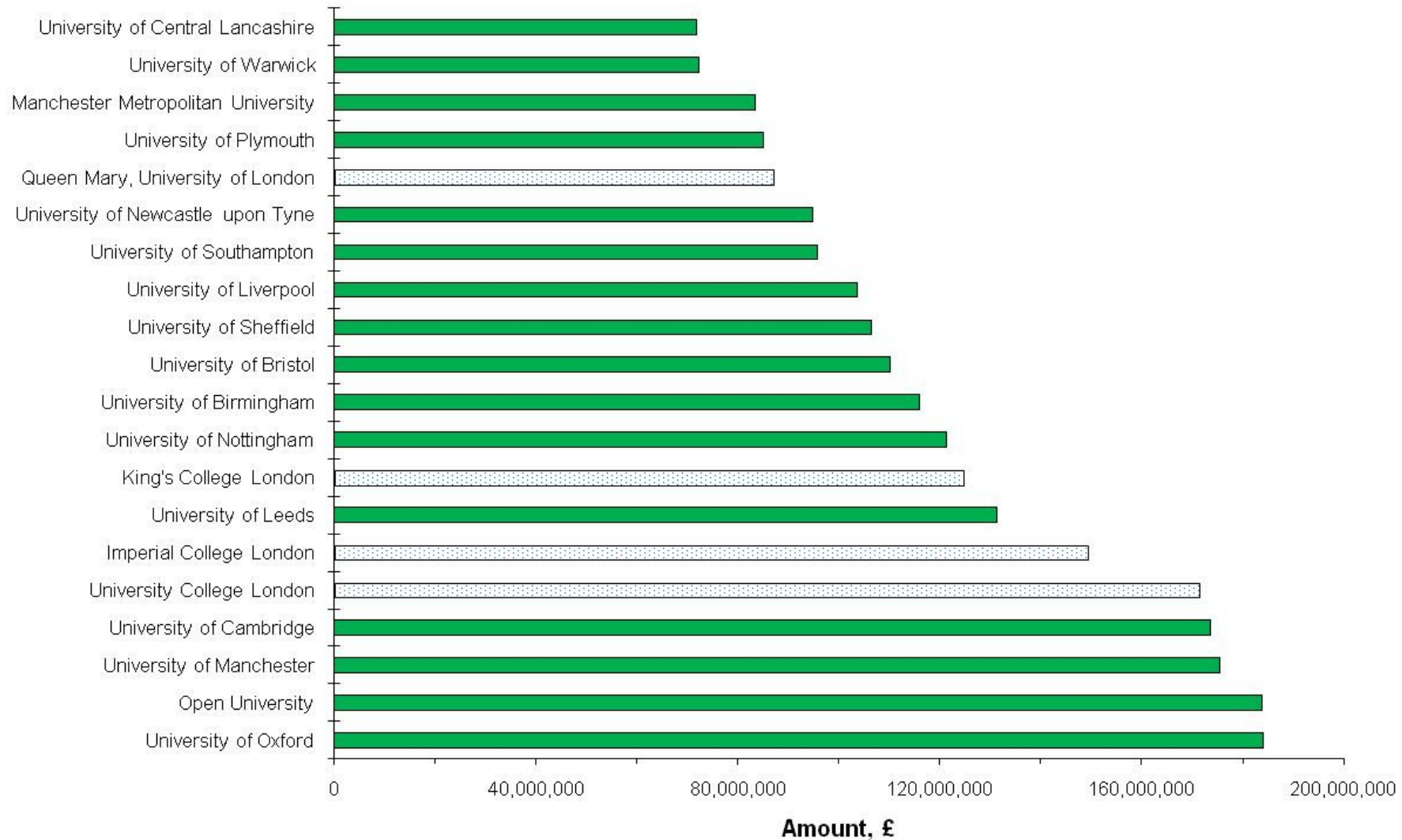

HEFCE grants for widening participation by Region, 2011/2012



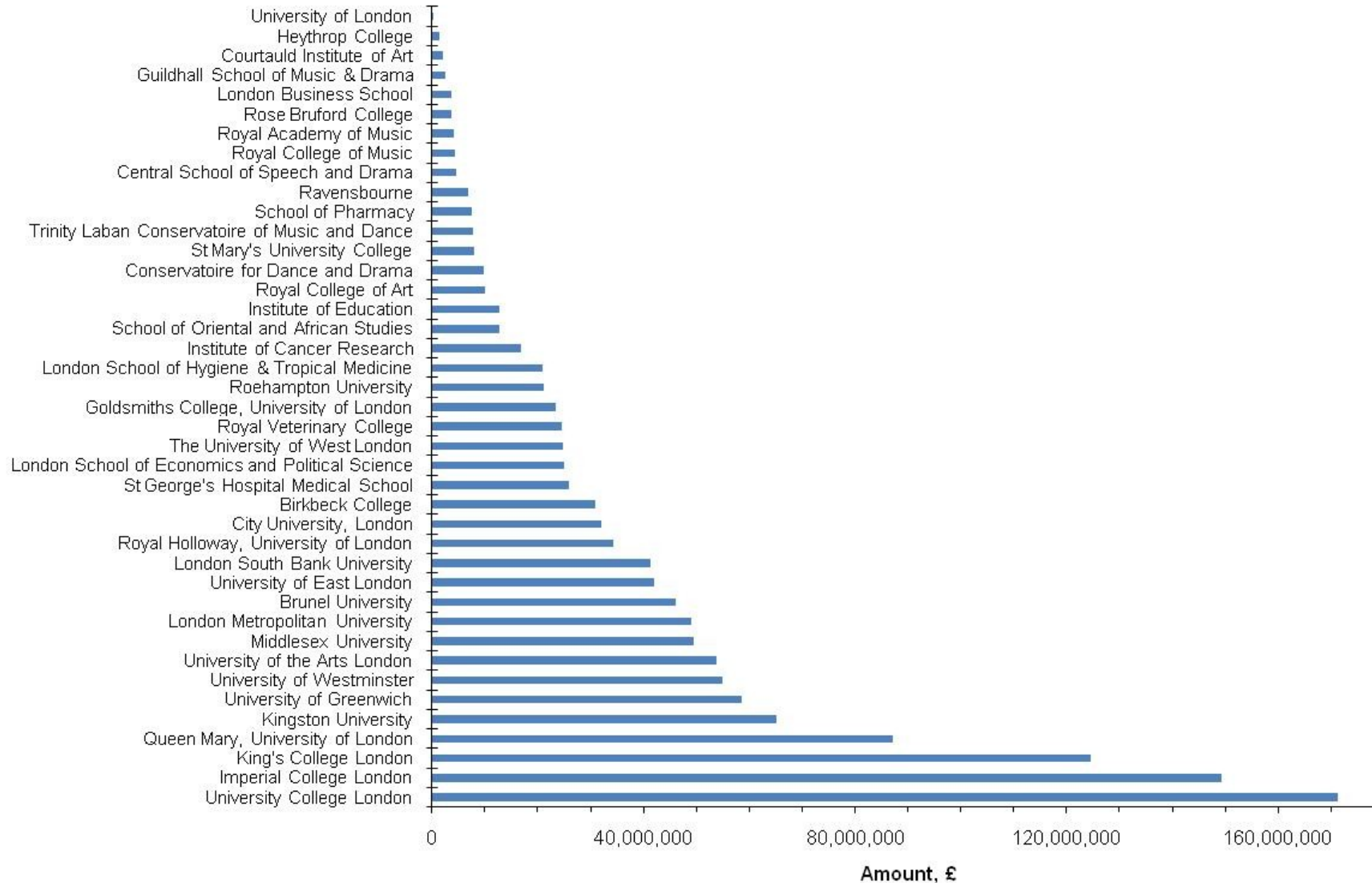

Top 20 for total recurrent grant, 2011/12



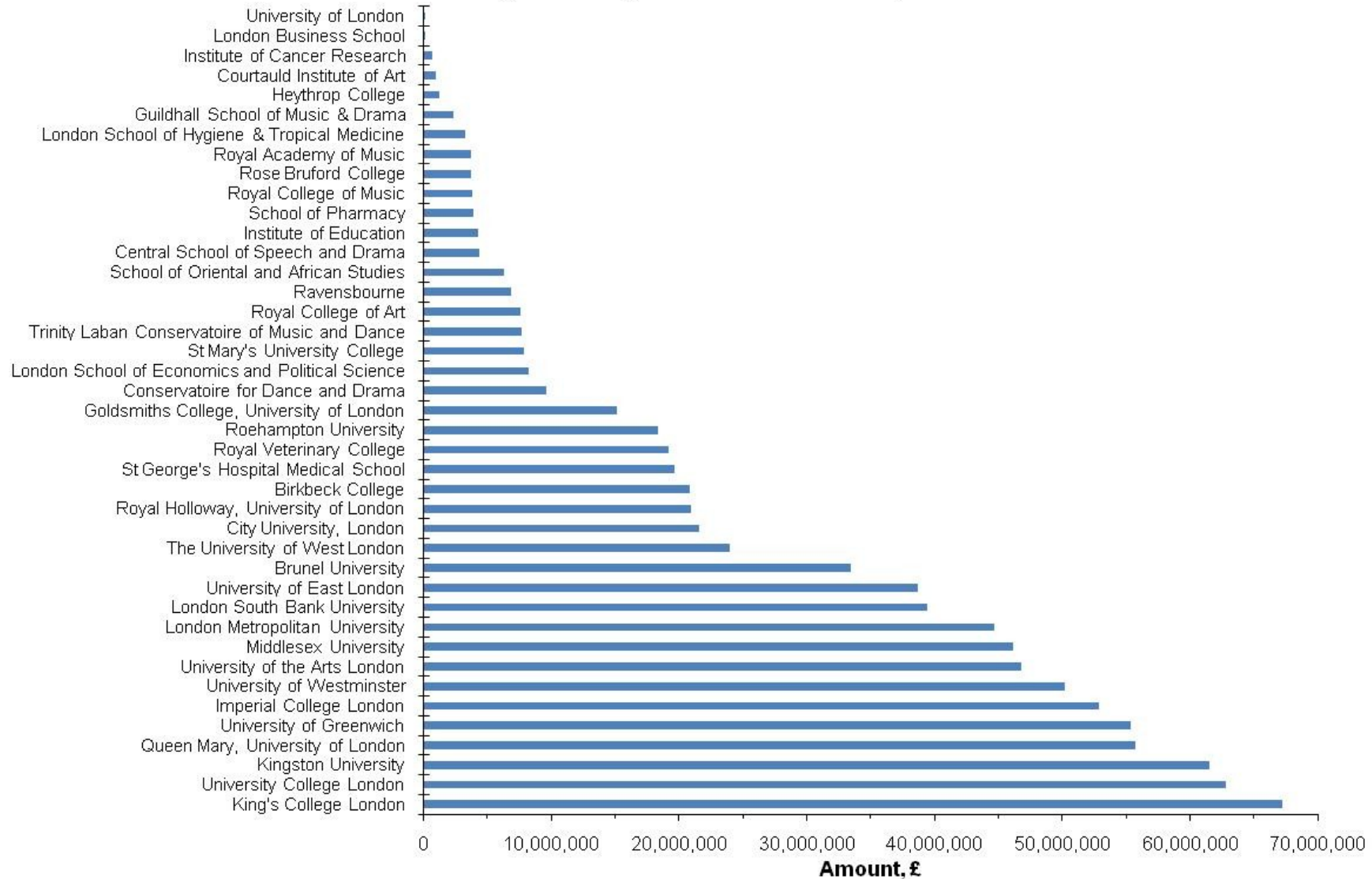

Total recurrent grant for London HEIs, 2011/12



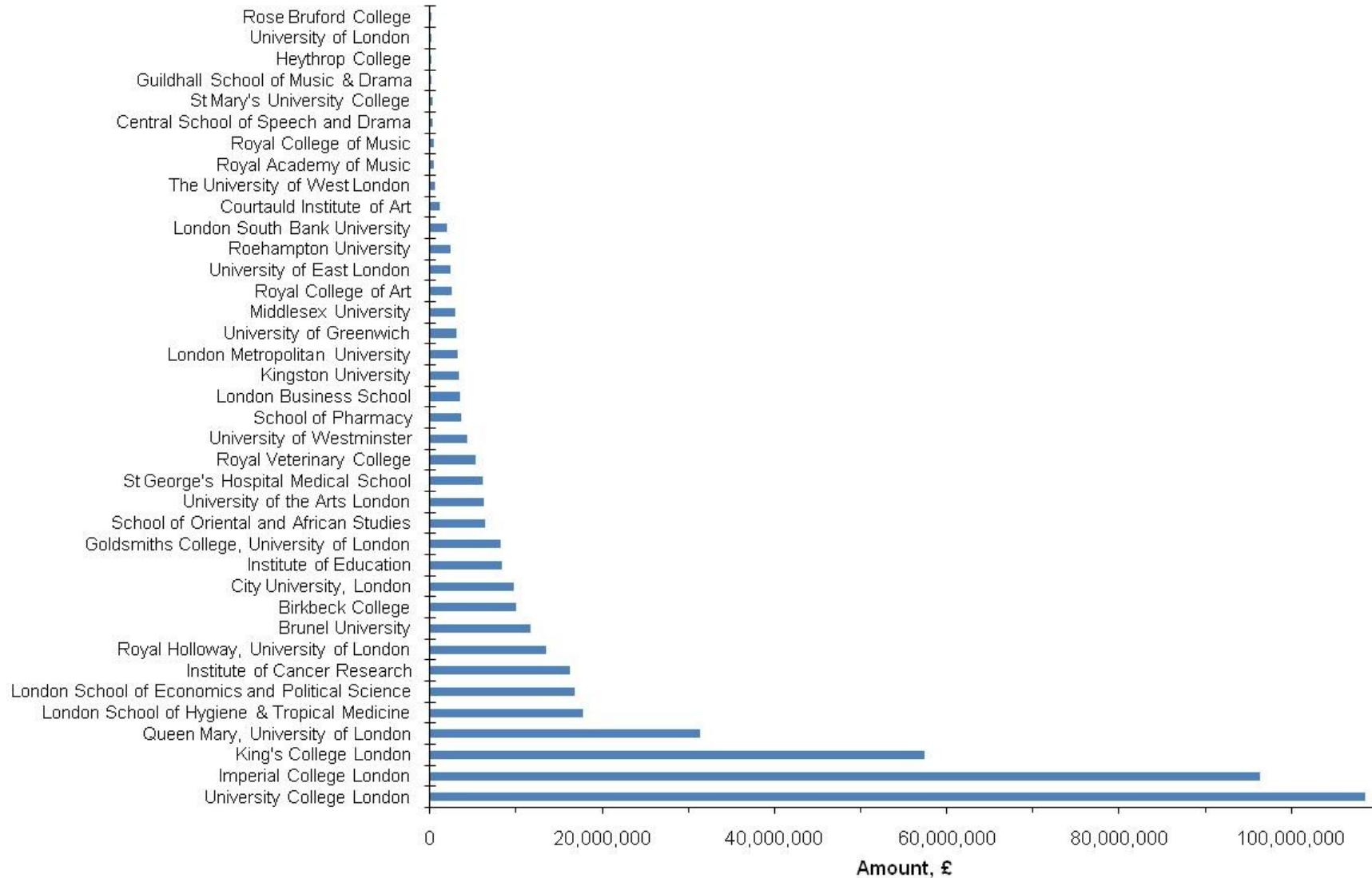
