Economic and Social Research Council: grant awards 2009/10

1. Awards made by ESRC in 2009/10 were summed by UK region for research organisations (ROs).
2. Of 56 ROs awarded standard and/or small grants, 17 were based in London.

3. The overall success rate for ROs in the UK was 16% (218 awards from 1,335 applications).
4. ROs in London obtained £10.4 million which was equivalent to 23% of the total of £44.7 million awarded by ESRC during this time.
5. Of the 51 grants awarded to London ROs, UCL obtained 11, City University had six and LSE obtained five.
