

Arts and Humanities Research Council: Grant success rates, 2011/12

- Awards for thematic and responsive mode grants in 2011/2012 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- From 129 ROs applying for grants, 34 were in London and of these 26 received one or more awards.

- The overall success rate for ROs in London was similar to 2010/11 and had doubled from success rates in 2008/09 and 2009/10.
- ROs in London won £6.8 million, 15% of the £45.9 million awarded by AHRC in this period.
- Of the 45 responsive mode grants in London, six were won by Birkbeck and four by Queen Mary.
- Of the 27 thematic grants to ROs in London, The British Library gained four while Brunel, King's College London, National Museum of Science and Industry Group, Queen Mary, UCL and the University of East London had two each.
