Arts and Humanities Research Council: responsive and strategic mode grant awards 2009/10

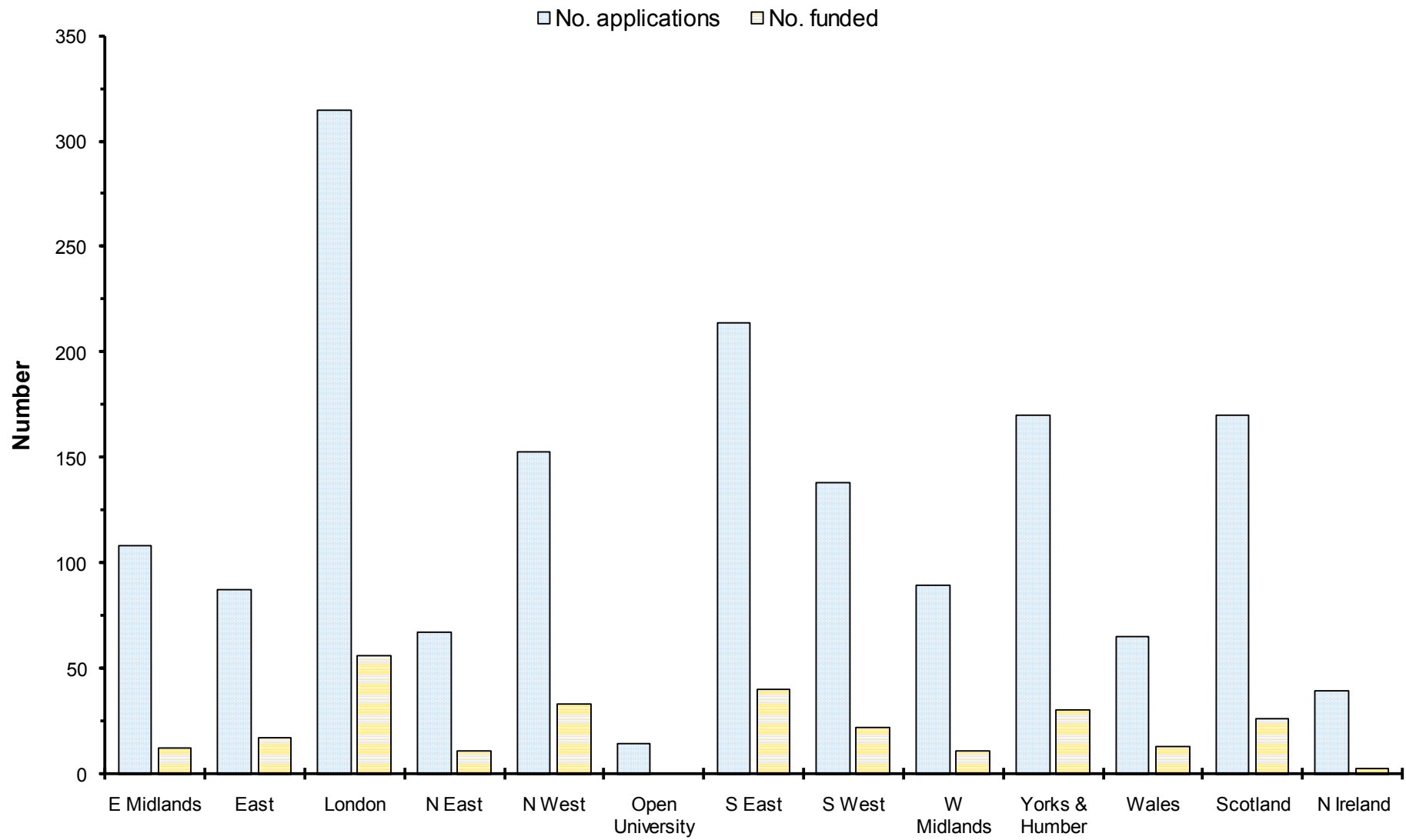
1. Awards made by AHRC in 2009/10 were summed by UK region for research organisations (ROs).
2. Of 140 ROs applying for responsive and strategic mode grants, 39 were based in London and 21 of these received one or more grants.

3. The success rate for ROs in London at 18% was similar to the 19% in 2008/09 (66 awards from 348 applications), and ROs in the North West had the highest success rate at 22%.
4. ROs in London obtained £6.1 million which was equivalent to 20% of the total of £30.9 million awarded by AHRC during this time.
5. Of the 43 responsive mode grants awarded to London ROs, Queen Mary, University of London, and UCL obtained seven each, while Royal Holloway and University of the Arts London had four each.
6. Queen Mary and UCL also received three strategic mode grants each from the 13 awarded to London ROs.
