

Arts and Humanities Research Council: Grant Success Rates for 2014/15

- Awards for responsive and thematic grants during 2014/2015 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- From 130 ROs applying for grants, 35 were in London and of these 20 received one or more awards.

- The overall success rate for ROs in London was 3% lower than during 2013/14.
- ROs in London won a total of £9.5 million, 20% of the £47.6 million awarded by AHRC during this period.
- Of the 42 grants in London, UCL won seven, King's College London had six and University of the Arts London obtained four.
