

### Arts and Humanities Research Council: grant success rates, 2013/14

- Awards for grants and Fellowships during 2013/2014 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- From 132 ROs applying for grants, 36 were in London and of these 18 received one or more awards.

- The overall success rate for ROs in London was 50% lower than during 2012/13.
- ROs in London won a total of £12.5 million, 17% of the £72.5 million awarded by AHRC in this period.
- Of the 54 grants in London, King's College London and UCL won six each, and Birkbeck, University of London and Queen Mary University of London won five each.
