

Biotechnology and Biological Sciences Research Council: Grant success rates, 2011/12

- Awards for all research grant applications in 2011/2012 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- From 103 ROs applying for grants, 19 were in London and of these 12 received one or more awards.

- The overall success rate for ROs in London was 3% higher than in 2010/11.
- ROs in London won £25.4 million, 15% of the £164.5 million awarded by BBSRC in this period.
- Of the 71 research grants in London, 22 were awarded to UCL, 14 to King's College London and 13 to Imperial College.
