Biotechnology and Biological Sciences Research Council: Responsive mode and research initiative grant awards 2010/11

1. Awards made between April 2010 and March 2011 were summed by UK region
2. Of 109 research organisations (ROs) applying for grants, 22 were based in London and 16 of these were awarded one or more grants.

3. The success rate for London ROs was 25% and success rates >30% were found for the East, North West and the South East
4. ROs in London obtained £31.6 million, compared with £25 million in 2009/10, which was equivalent to 17% of the £189 million disbursed by BBSRC.
5. Of the 80 grants awarded to London Imperial College London obtained 27, UCL received 23 and King's College London had six.
