

### Biotechnology and Biological Sciences Research Council: grant success rates for 2014/15

- Awards for research grants submitted during 2014/2015 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- From 120 ROs applying for grants, 22 were in London and of these 10 received one or more awards.

- The overall success rate for ROs in London was 5% lower than during 2013/14.
- ROs in London won £24 million, 10% of the £244 million awarded by BBSRC in this period.
- Of the 62 grants in London, 19 were won by UCL, 15 by Imperial College and 11 by King's College London.
