

Biotechnology and Biological Sciences Research Council: grant success rates for 2013/14

- Awards for all research grants submitted during 2013/2014 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- From 114 ROs applying for grants, 21 were in London and of these 13 received one or more awards.

- The overall success rate for ROs in London was 9% lower than during 2012/13.
- ROs in London won £34 million, 13% of the £261 million awarded by BBSRC in this period.
- Of the 79 grants in London, 21 were won by UCL, 18 by Imperial College and 16 by King's College London.
