

### Biotechnology and Biological Sciences Research Council: grant success rates for 2012/13

- Awards for all research grants submitted during 2012/2013 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- From 104 ROs applying for grants, 20 were in London and of these 15 received one or more awards.

- The overall success rate for ROs in London was 4% lower than for 2011/12.
- ROs in London won £29 million, 16% of the £181 million awarded by BBSRC in this period.
- Of the 64 grants in London, 18 were won by Imperial College, 16 by UCL and 11 by King's College London.
