

### Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council: Grant success rates, 2011/12

- Awards for research proposal grants in 2011/2012 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- From 100 ROs applying for grants, 22 were in London and of these 12 received one or more awards.

- The overall success rate for ROs in London was 3% higher compared with 2010/11.
- ROs in London won £82 million, 22% of the £377 million awarded by EPSRC during this period.
- Of the 130 research grants in London, 46 were given to Imperial College and 42 to UCL.
