Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council: research grant awards 2009/10


1. Awards made between April 2009 and March 2010 were summed by UK region for research grants, excluding Fellowship awards, Research Chairs, Joint External Funding (JEFI) or training awards.
2. Of 115 research organisations (RO) applying for grants, 22 were based in London and 18 of these received one or more grants.

3. The success rate for ROs in London at 31% was an increase from 26% in 2008/09 (195 awards from 748 applications).
4. ROs in the North East and the Open University had the highest success rate with 36% of successful applications, followed by the South East.
5. ROs in London obtained £96 million (£5 million more than 2008/09) and this was equivalent to 21% of the £459 million of grants made in 2009/10.
6. Of the 181 grants awarded to ROs in London, Imperial College received 78, UCL obtained 34 and Queen Mary, University of London, had 21.
