

### Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council: grant success rates for 2013/14

- Research proposal applications and awards during 2013/2014 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- From 102 ROs applying for grants, 18 were in London and of these 11 received one or more awards.

- The overall success rate for ROs in London was 3% more than for 2012/13.
- ROs in London won £96.7 million, 26% of the £366 million awarded by EPSRC in 2013/14.
- In the previous year, ROs in London won £167 million, 23% of the £734 million disbursed during this period.
- Of the 129 grants in London, 48 were won by Imperial College, 36 by UCL, 11 by Queen Mary and 10 each by Brunel University and King's College London.
