

### Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council: grant success rates for 2012/13

- Research proposal applications and awards during 2012/2013 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- From 109 ROs applying for grants, 21 were in London and of these 12 received one or more awards.

- The overall success rate for ROs in London was 5% less than for 2011/12.
- ROs in London won £167 million, 23% of the £734 million awarded by EPSRC in this period.
- Of the 203 grants in London, 76 were won by UCL, 69 by Imperial College and 15 by King's College London.
