Economic and Social Research Council: grant awards 2010/11

1. A total of 55 research organisations (ROs) were awarded 130 responsive mode and knowledge exchange grants from July 2010 to July 2011.
2. Success rates for responsive mode grants varied between 14 to 19% in 2010 from three assessment panel meetings.

3. Thirteen ROs in London received £7.3 million, equivalent to 19% of the £37.6 million made available by ESRC during this time.
4. Of the 24 grants awarded to London ROs, King's College London received four while City University, the Institute of Education and the London School of Economics and Political Science had three each.
