

### Economic and Social Research Council: Grant success rates, 2012/13

- Awards for responsive mode grants during 2012/2013 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- Of 114 ROs obtaining grants, 24 were in London and they won 26% of the £42 million awarded by ESRC in this period.
