

### HEFCE Recurrent Grants for 2012-13

---

- Provisional allocations for grants to higher education institutions (HEIs) and further education colleges (FECs) were released in March 2012
- 40 HEIs in London\*, comprising 31% of 129 HEIs in England, are to receive £1, 206 million, or 25% of £4, 800 million available for 2012-13
- 24 FECs in London, 13% of 186 funded by HEFCE, are to receive £9.5 million, or 8% of the total of £124 million from HEFCE
- London's HEIs will receive 23% of £3,088 million in total teaching funding, 30% of £1,558 million in research funding and 10% of £129 million under widening participation
- For quality-related research funding, London HEIs have been allocated £79 million for charity support; £69 million for postgraduate supervision (RDP); £32 million in London weighting; £18 million for quality-related business research, and £1.3 million as special funding for national research libraries
- Recurrent grants to HEIs in London will be 12% less than last year, which follows a 4% reduction from the previous grant year
- FECs in London will receive 31% less recurrent grant funding compared with 2011-12 although the number of eligible FECs will increase from 15 to 24

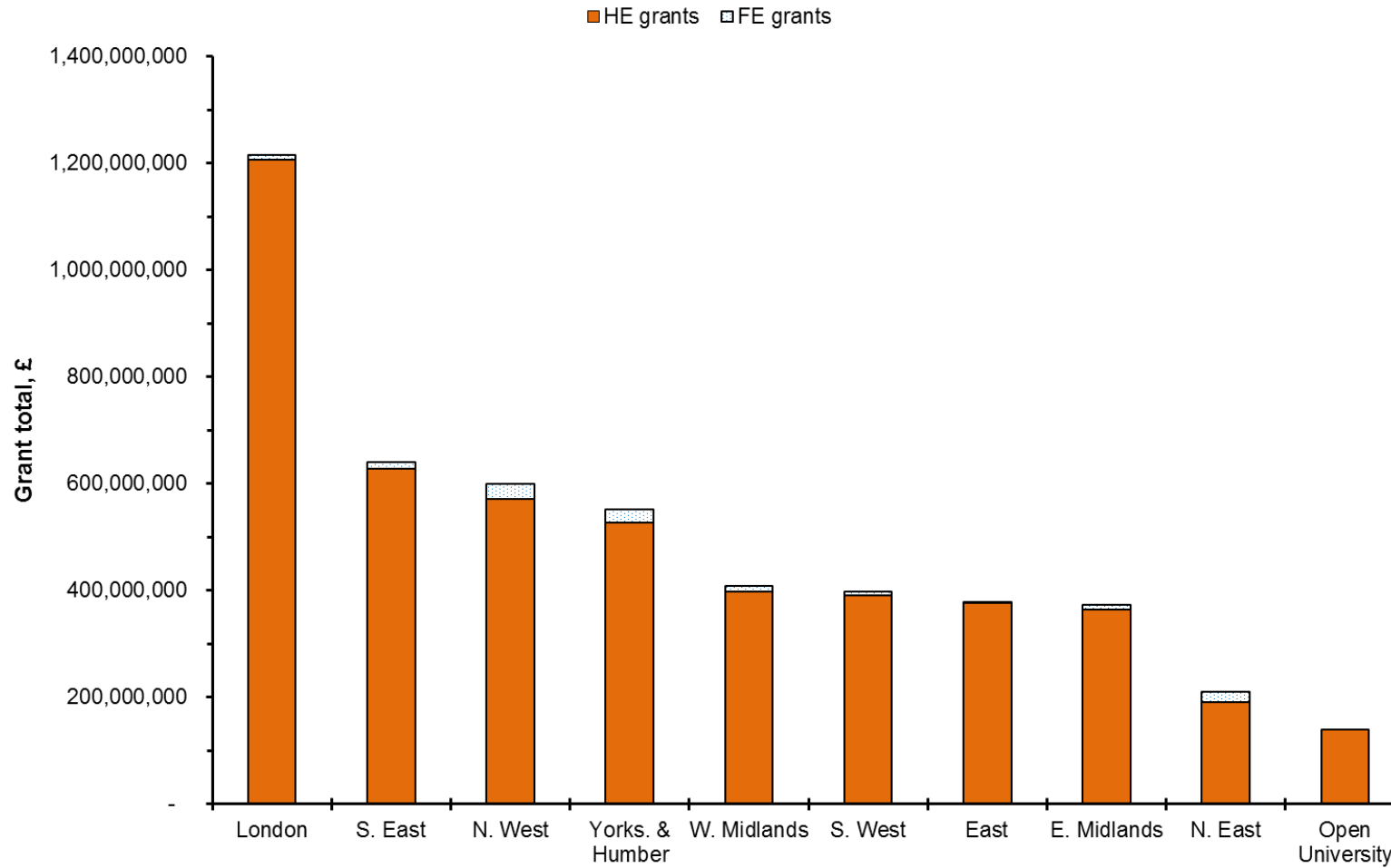
