

### HEFCE Recurrent Grants for 2013-14

---

- Allocations for grants to higher education institutions (HEIs) and further education colleges (FECs) were released in March 2013;
- 40 HEIs in London\*, comprising 31% of 129 HEIs in England, are to receive £1,206 million, or 25% of £4,800 million available for 2012-13;
- 24 FECs in London, 12% of 186 funded by HEFCE, are to receive £6.9 million, or 8% of the total of £82.9 million from HEFCE;
- London's HEIs will receive 25% of £2,238 million in total teaching funding, 30% of £1,558 million in research funding and 25% of £150 million from the Higher Education Innovation Fund (HEIF);
- For mainstream quality-related (QR) research funding, London HEIs have been allocated £272 million along with £78 million for QR charity support and £17 million for QR business research;
- London Weighting for all London HEIs remains unchanged at £32 million;
- Recurrent grants to HEIs in London will be 12% less than 2012-13, and follows declines of 12% and 9% in previous academic years;
- FECs in London will receive 27% less recurrent grant funding and comes after a 31% reduction in the preceding year;
- Reductions in recurrent grants to HEIs and FECs are due solely to decreases in the teaching elements of the funding.

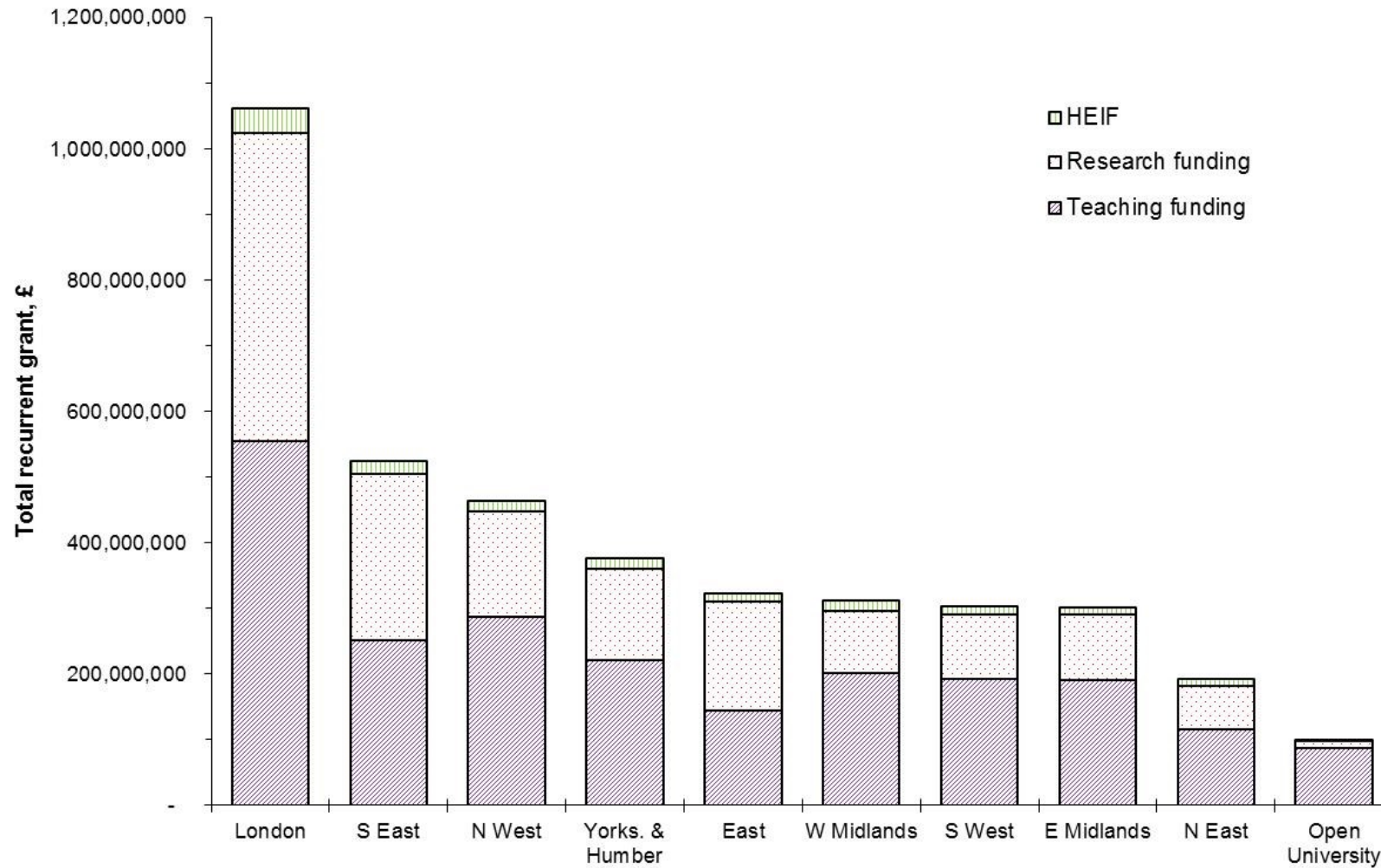
