

## LONDON HIGHER FACTSHEET 2012



### Income for Higher Education Institutions, 2010/11

- During 2010/11, the 164 UK higher education (HE) institutions had an income of £27,562 million, a decrease of £114 million from the previous year;
- HE institutions in London recorded a combined income of £5,779 million, equivalent to 21% of the UK total;
- Overall, London HE institutions obtained 65% of income from tuition fees, education contracts and funding body grants, 19% from research awards, 16% from other sources and 1% from endowments and investments;
- Income from tuition fees and education contracts was £2,017 million with 41%, or £823 million, obtained as HE fees from non-EU students;
- UK sources provided £866 million, including £332 million (38%) from UK Research Councils and £295 million (34%) from UK charities;
- 62% of Research Council grants came from the Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council and the Medical Research Council;
- London HE institutions obtained £230 million from non-UK sources, with £93 million (40%) from EU government bodies and £38 million (16%) from non-EU charities;
- Various other sources contributed £904 million, of which £308 million (34%) came from residences, catering and conference operations, while intellectual property rights returned £8.2 million (1%) in income.

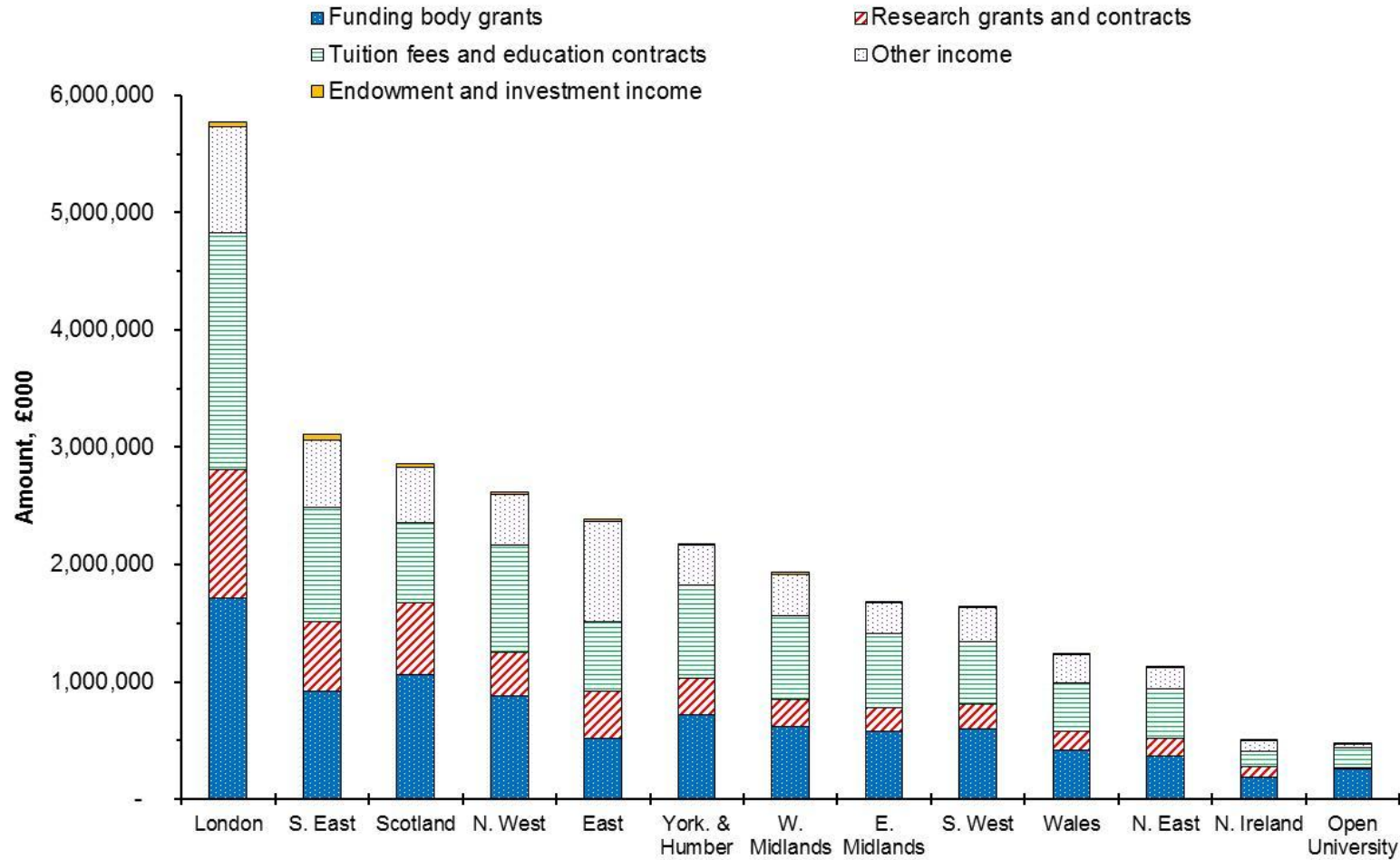

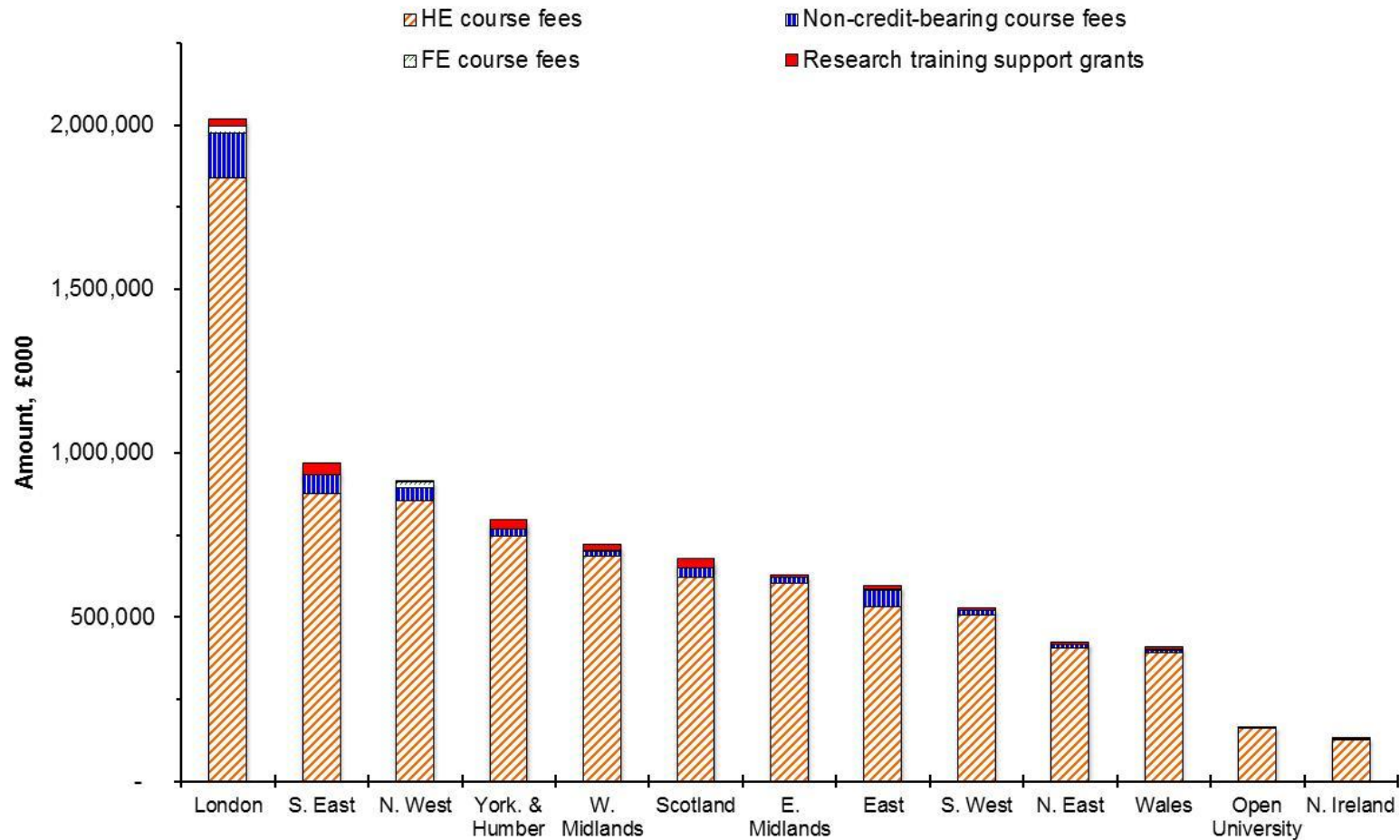
### Income for Higher Education Institutions, 2010/11

Income from Tuition Fees and Education Contracts, 2010/11

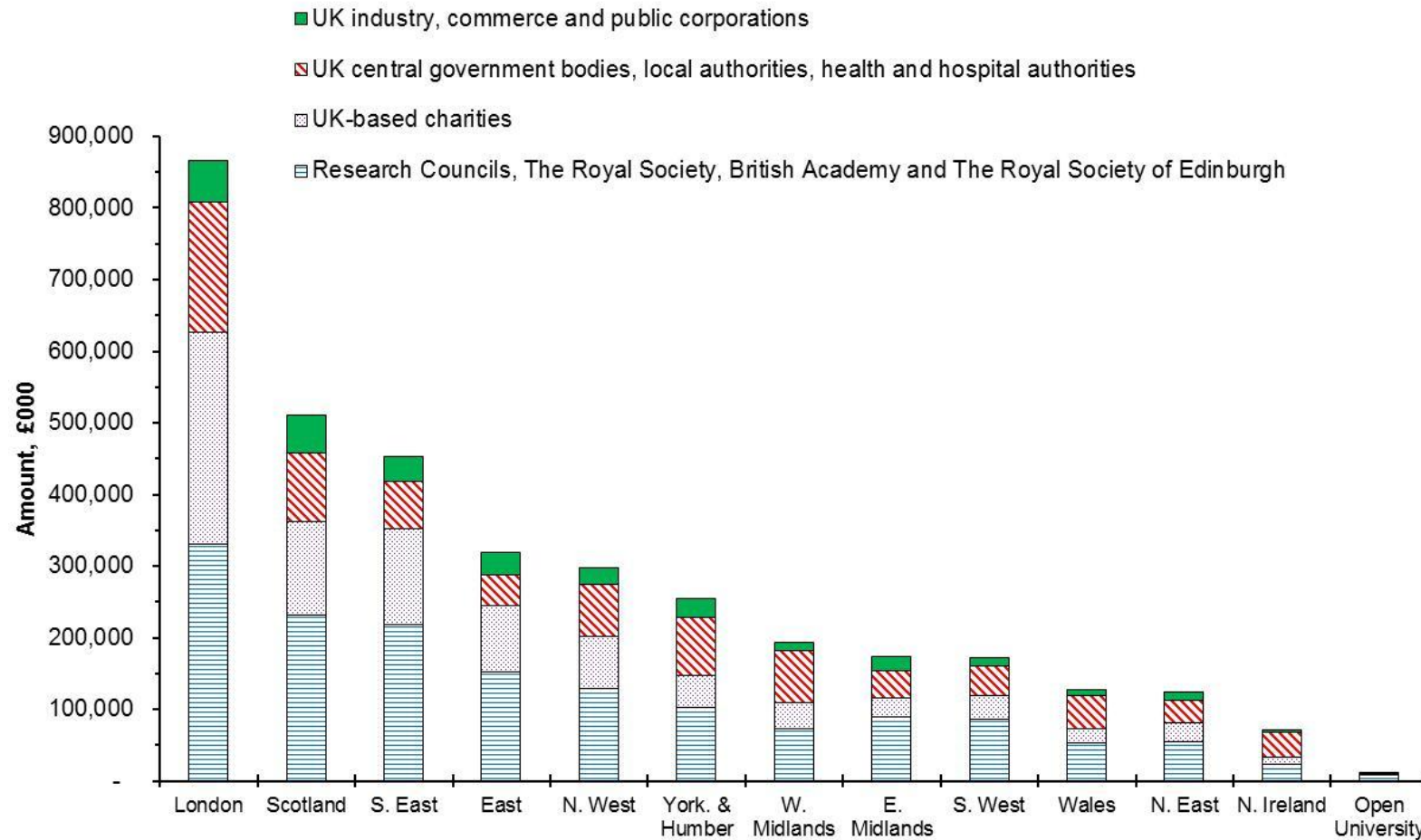

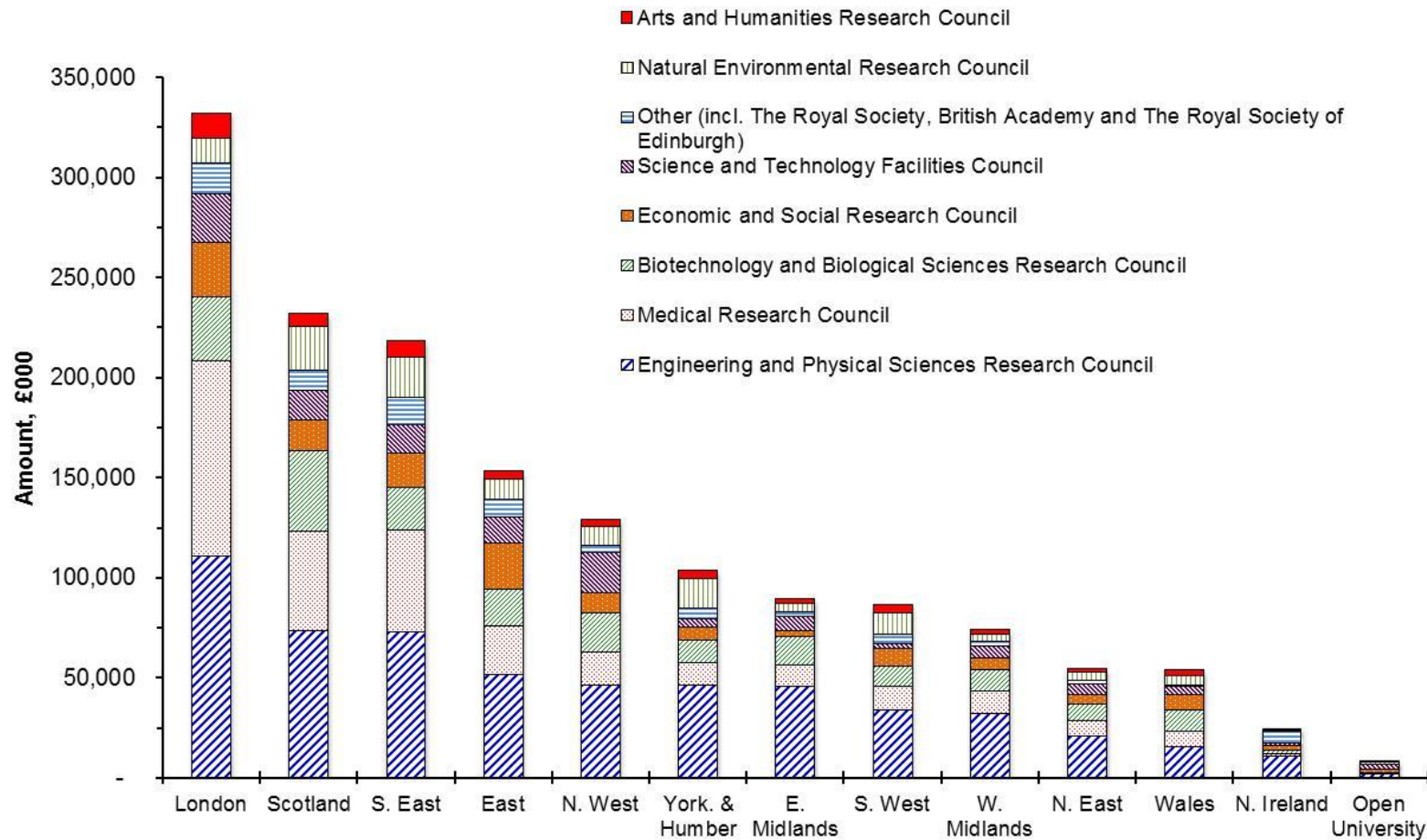
#### Research Grants and Income from UK sources, 2010/11

#### Income from Research Councils and Societies, 2010/11

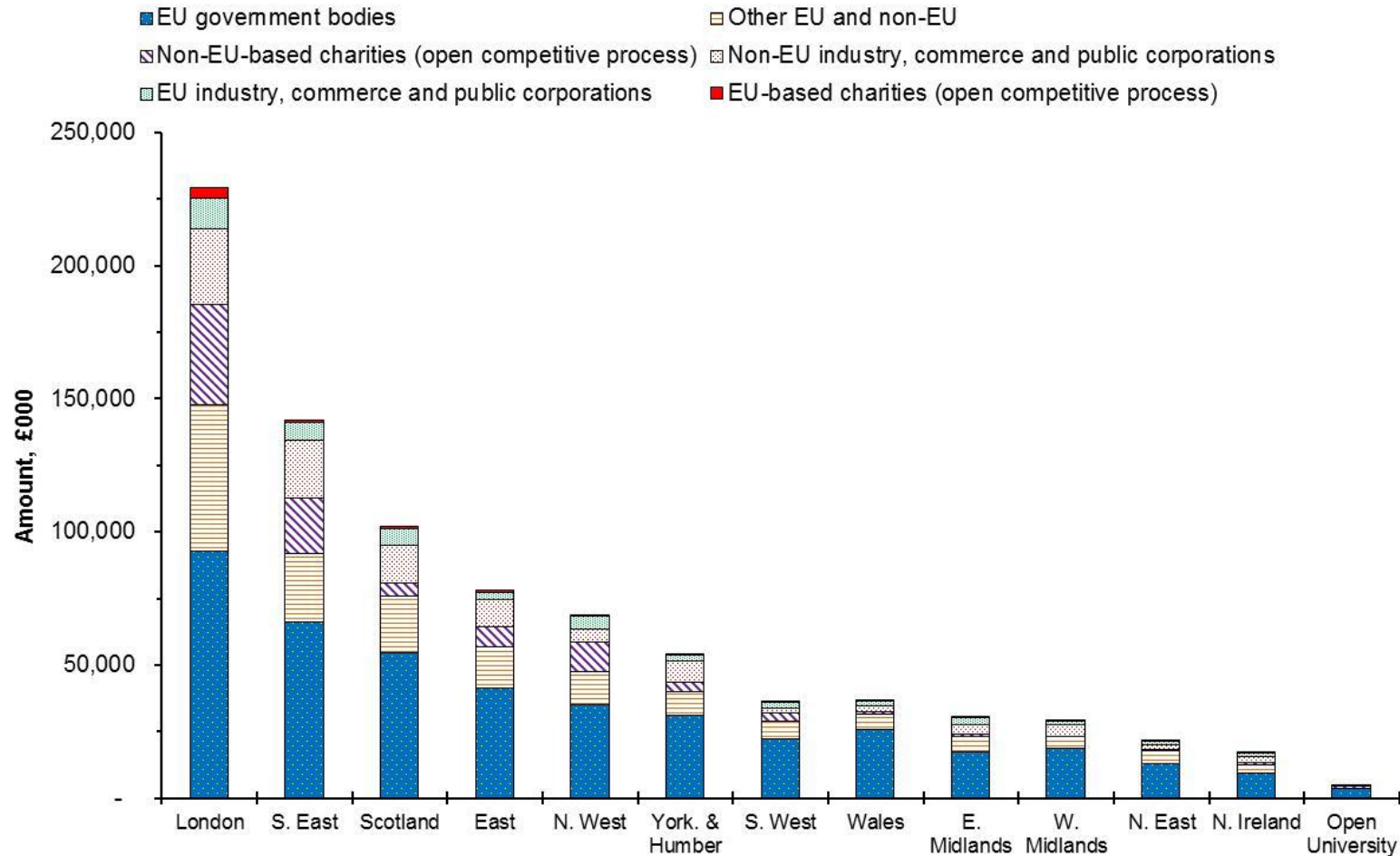
