

RESOURCES OF HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS 2007/08: STAFF DATA FOR LONDON REGION

- In 2007/08 a total of 565,000 staff were employed at UK higher education (HE) institutions with over 94,000 HE staff, or 19%, employed in London
- there were 37,500 academic, 33,400 non-academic and 23,200 atypical* staff employed at London HE institutions
- more non-academic staff were employed full-time in London (71%) compared to academic staff (60%)
- 76% of academic staff carried out teaching or teaching and research with 23% carrying out solely research activities
- women made up 38% of full-time academic staff and 53% of part-time academic staff
- 35% of academic staff were employed in medical and healthcare cost centres
- * Note atypical staff are those whose working arrangements are not permanent, involve complex employment relationships and/or involve work away from the supervision of the normal work provider. For further information see Terms of Employment <u>here</u>.




Academic staff by activity in London, 2007/08 based on 27,772 FTE








Academic staff by cost centre in London, 2007/08 based on 27,265 FTE
