

### RESOURCES OF HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS, 2008/09

- During the 2008/09 academic year 577,000 staff were employed at 166 higher education institutions (HEIs) in the UK
- 98,000 staff, comprising 17% of the UK total, were employed in London which was an increase of 4,000 from the previous year
- HE staff in London consisted of 39,300 academic, 35,600 non-academic and 23,100 atypical\* staff
- 28% of academic staff carried out teaching duties, 49% did both teaching and research and 22 % worked solely on research activities
- Women made up 41% of full-time academic staff and 52% of part-time academic staff
- 34% of academic staff in London were employed in medicine, dentistry, veterinary and related healthcare subject areas
- Nearly 60% of non-academic staff were employed in administrative roles or as technicians

**\* Note atypical staff are those whose working arrangements are not permanent, involve complex employment relationships and/or involve work away from the supervision of the normal work provider. For further information [see Staff Definitions on the HESA website](#).**

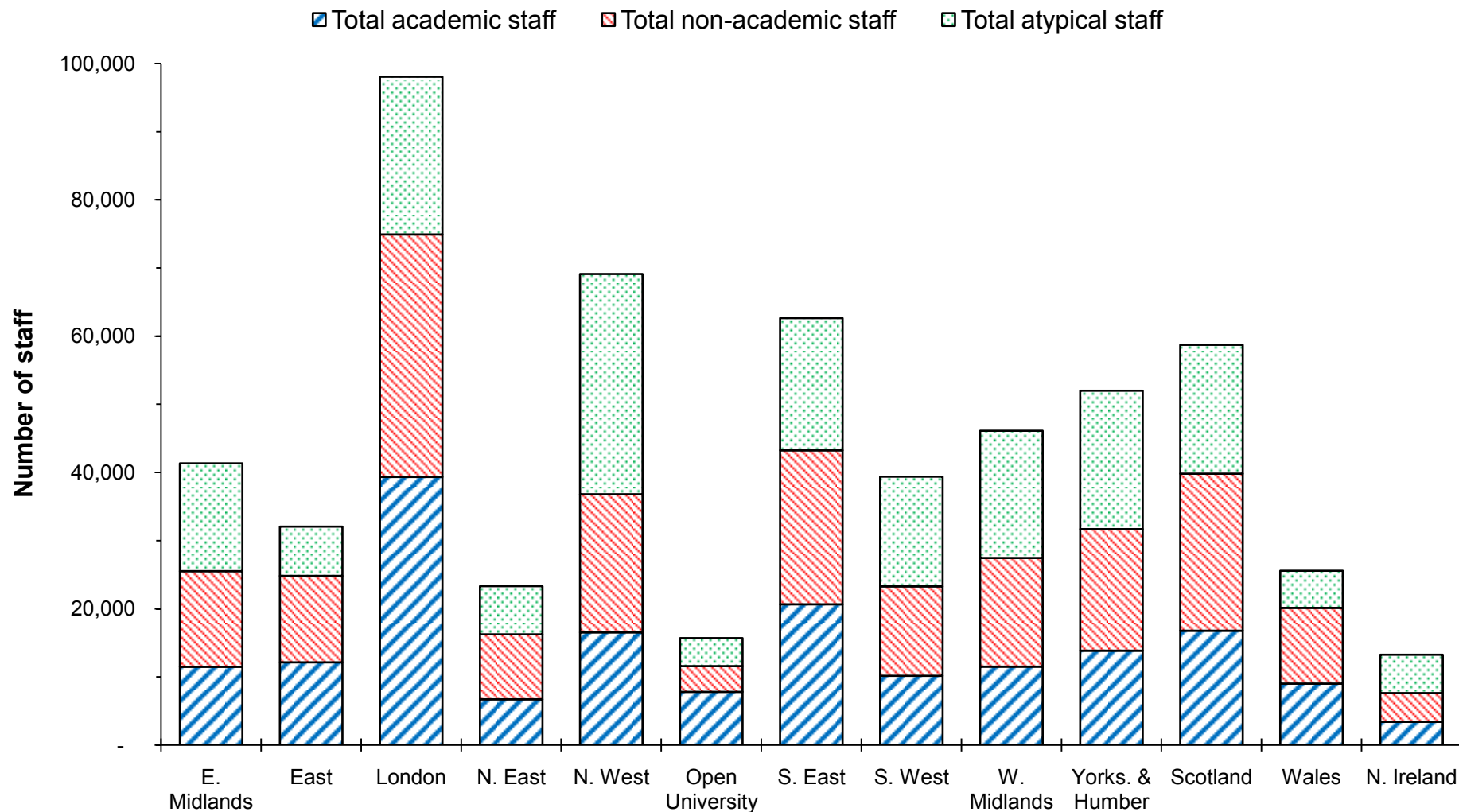

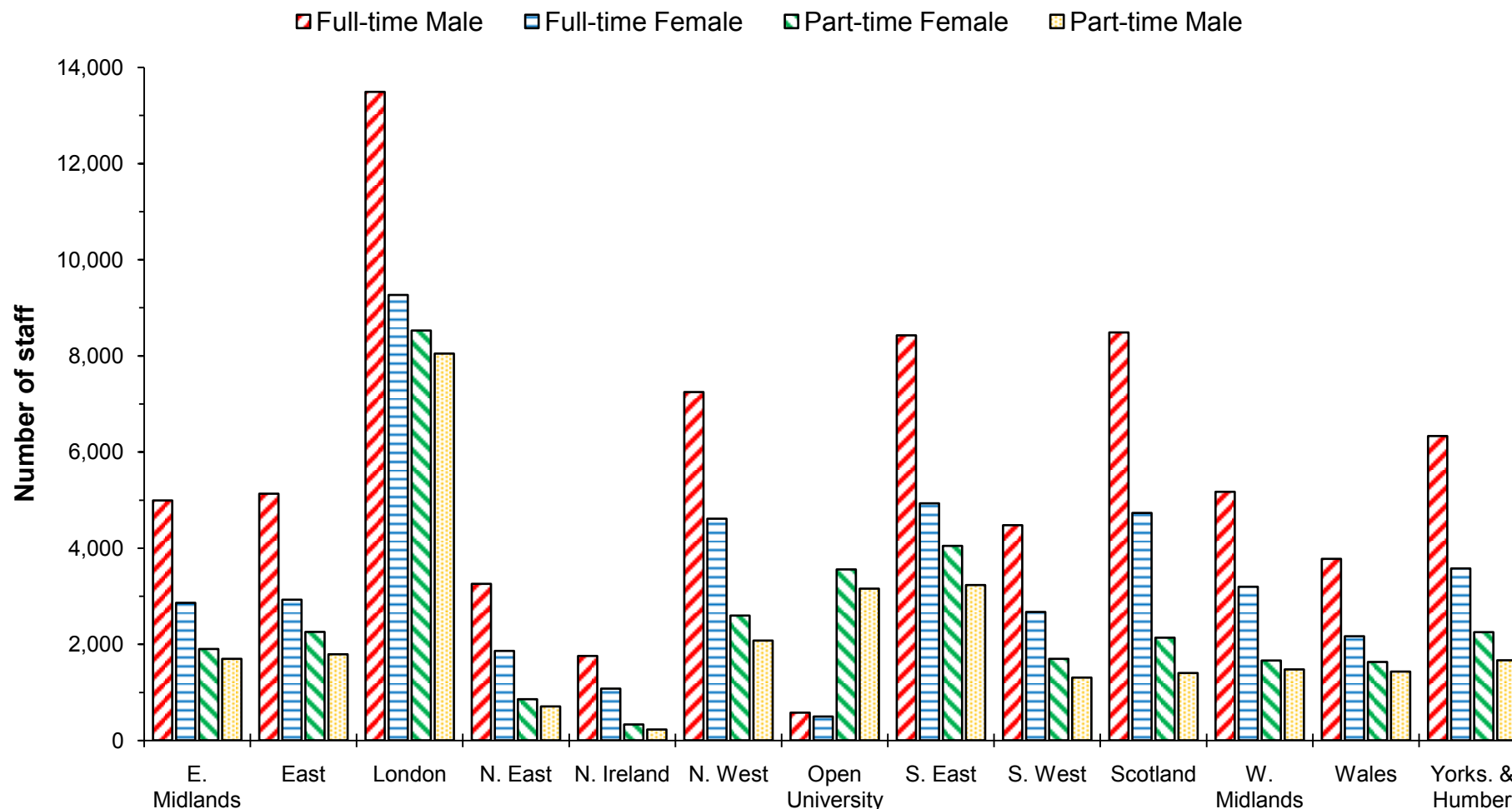

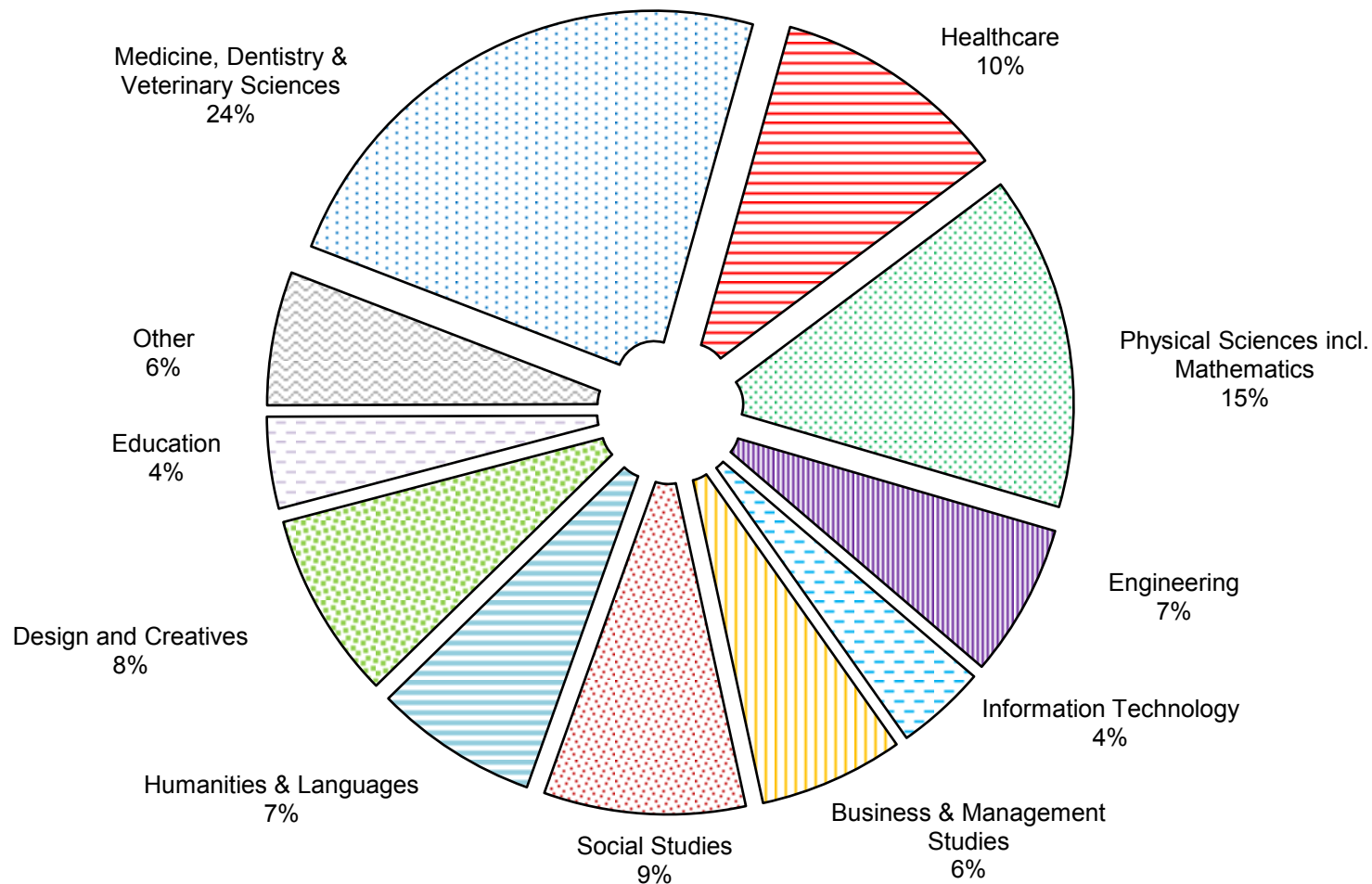
### Numbers of staff by region, 2008/09
