

FACT SHEET: PROFILE OF STUDENTS IN LONDON

HESA Student Record 2005/06

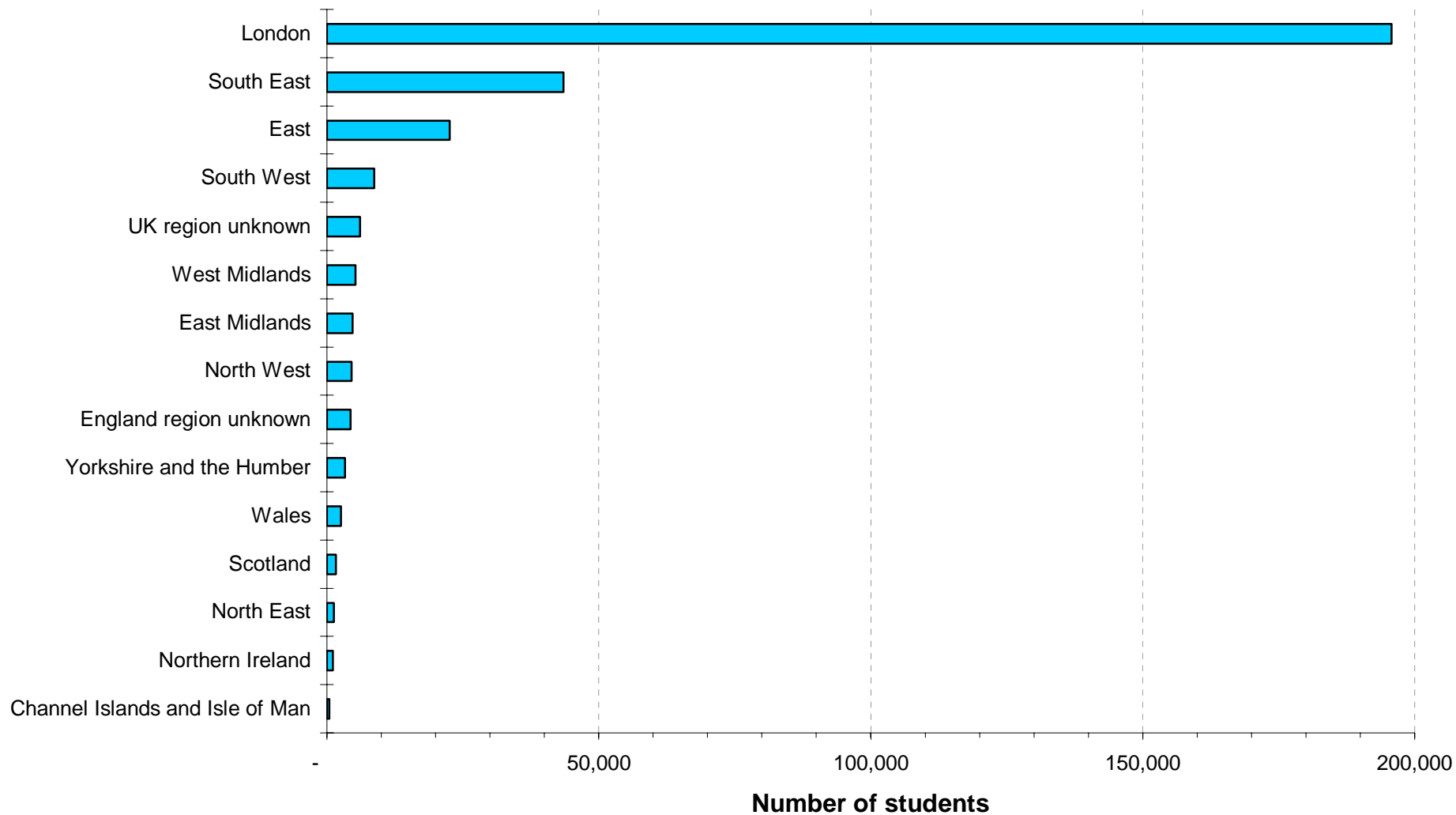
- Nearly 392,000 students were registered at London Higher Education (HE) institutions in 2005/06, a 4% increase from the previous year
- Of these, almost 86,000 (22%) were based overseas on distance learning courses and external programmes
- London had the highest numbers of HE students in the UK, with 16.8% of 2.4 million UK registered students
- London also had the most ethnically diverse student population in the UK, with 137,000 students (52%) who were classed as non-white
- Excluding overseas based students, there were 181,500 female (60%) and 123,800 male (40%) HE students in London
- About 29% of all students were registered for business and administrative studies or subjects related to medicine
- The majority of London students in 2005/06 were less than 30 years old, doing a first degree and a third were studying part-time

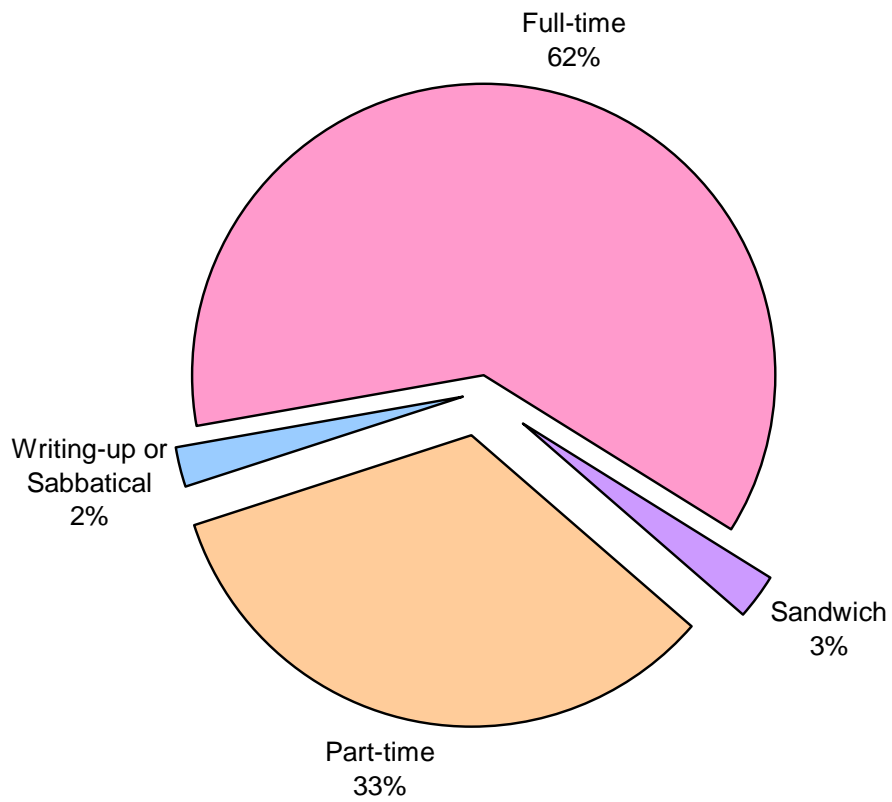

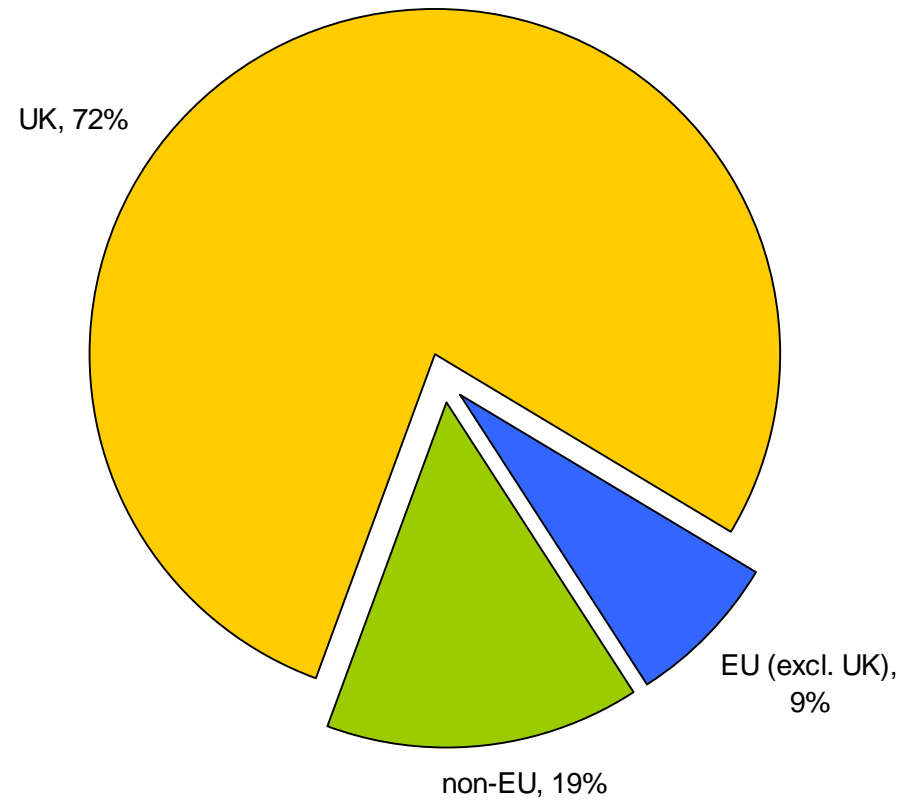
### Regional origin of UK students at London HEIs (excluding overseas students)



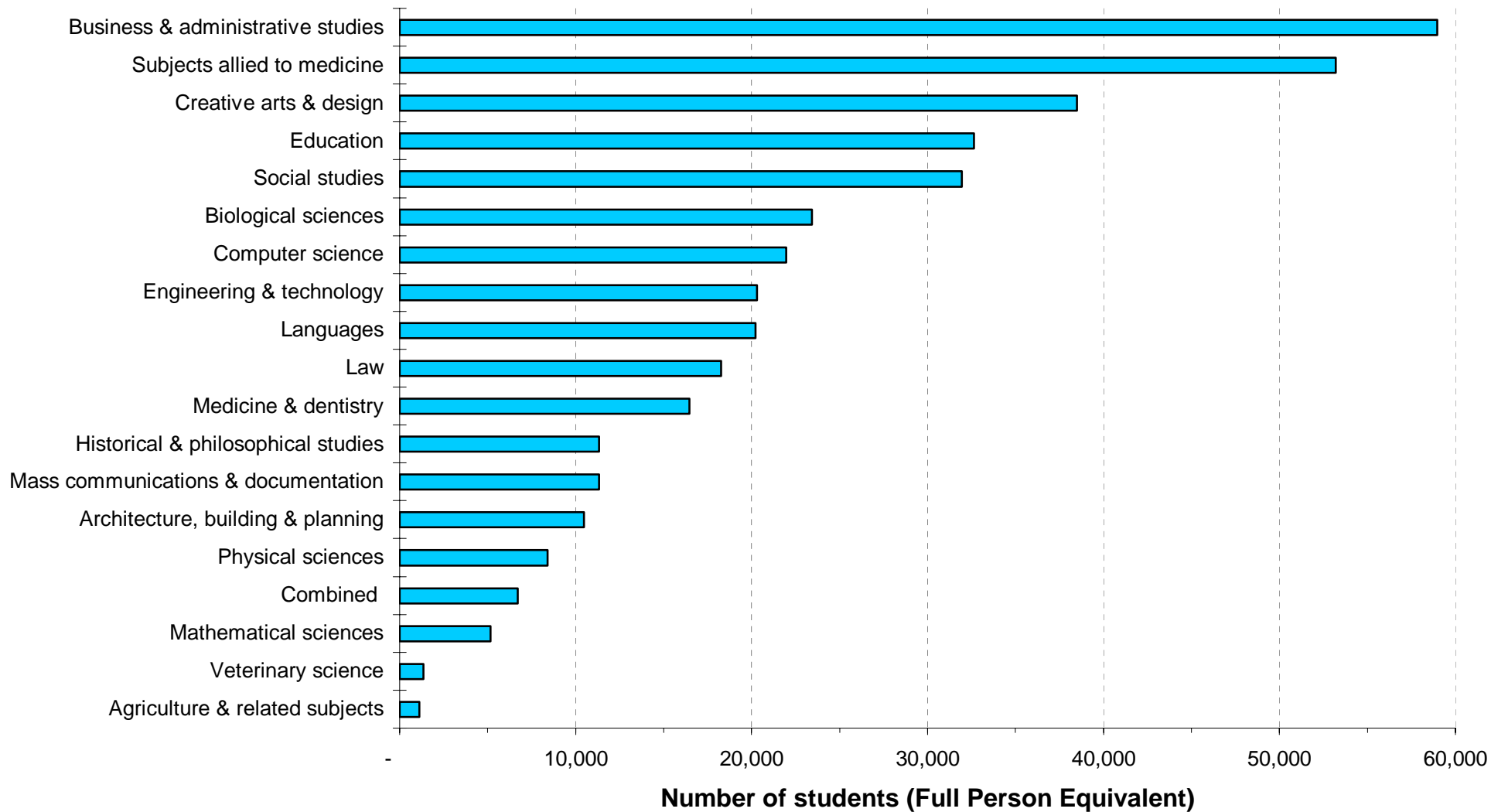
Mode of study at London HEIs, 2005/06



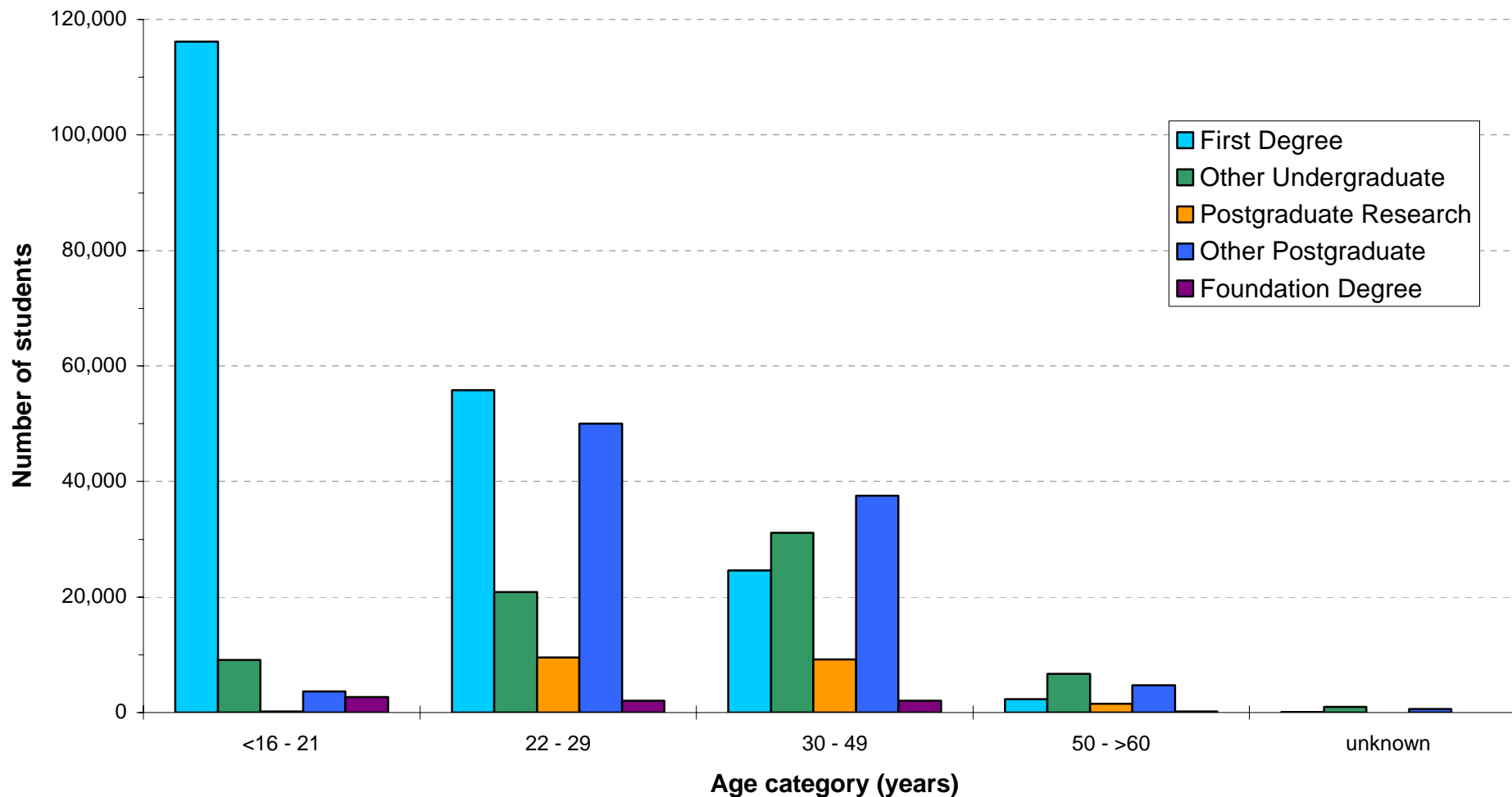
Country of origin for London students (excluding overseas students)



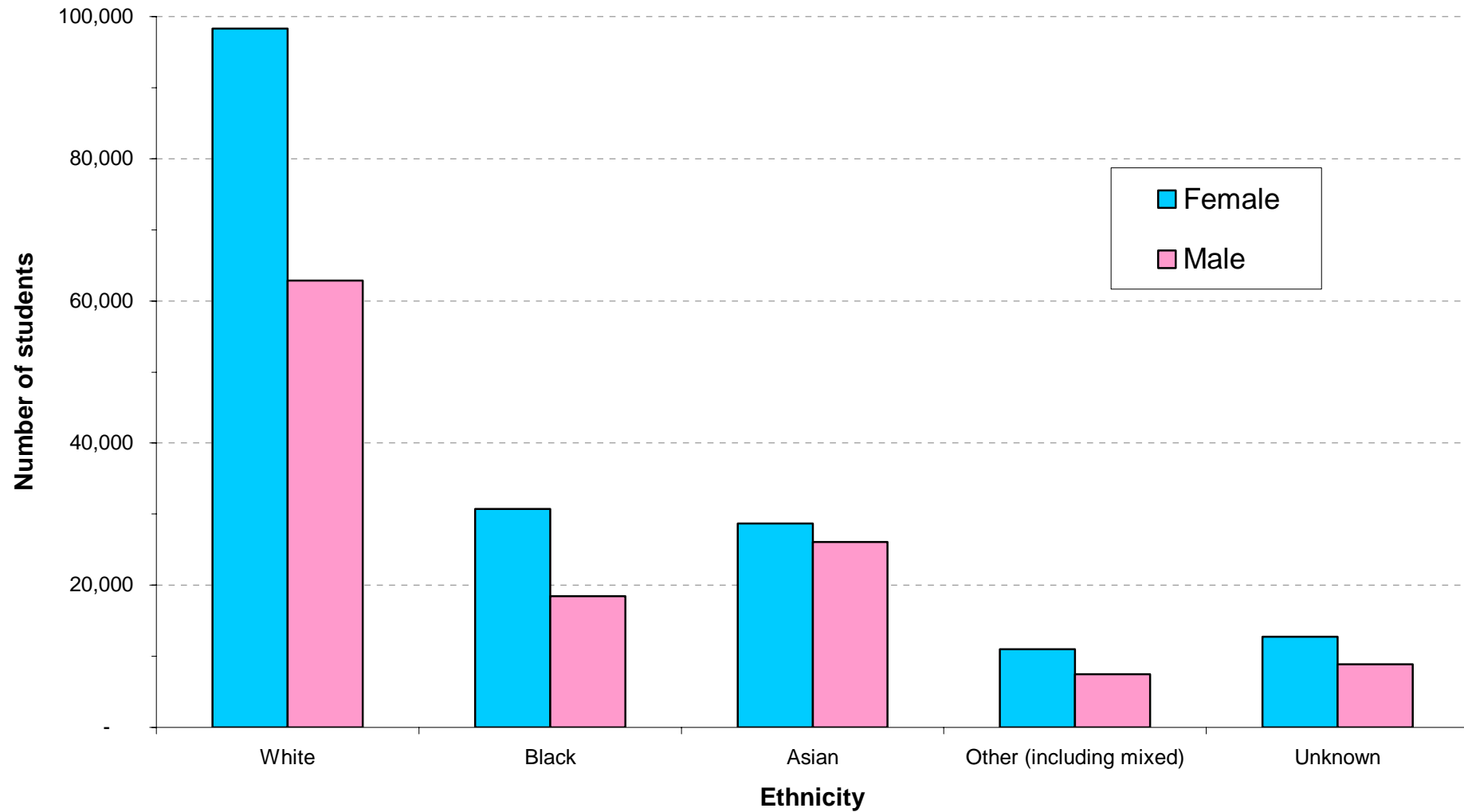
**Subjects studied at London HEIs by all students, 2005/06**



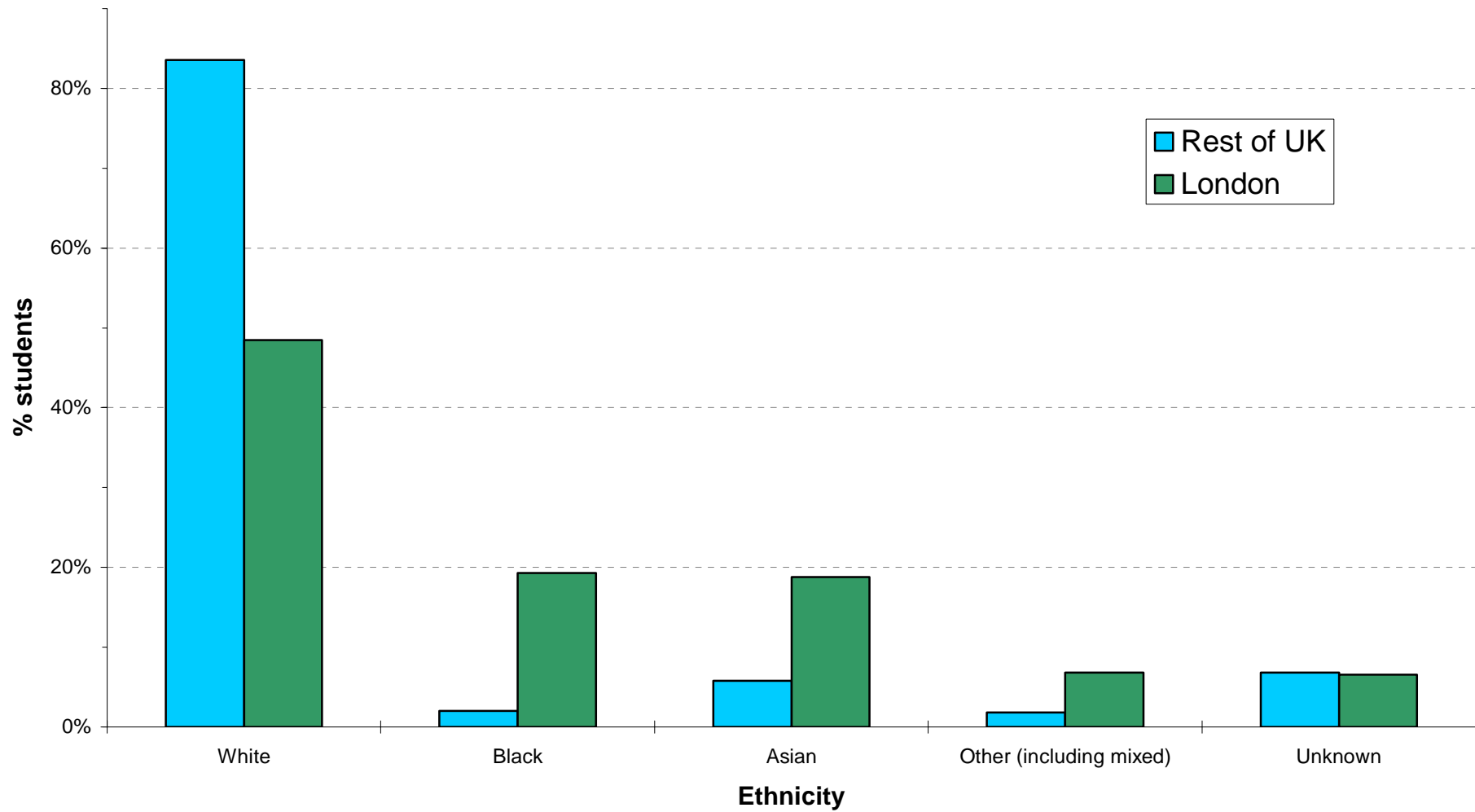
## Age and level of study for all students at London HEIs, 2005/06



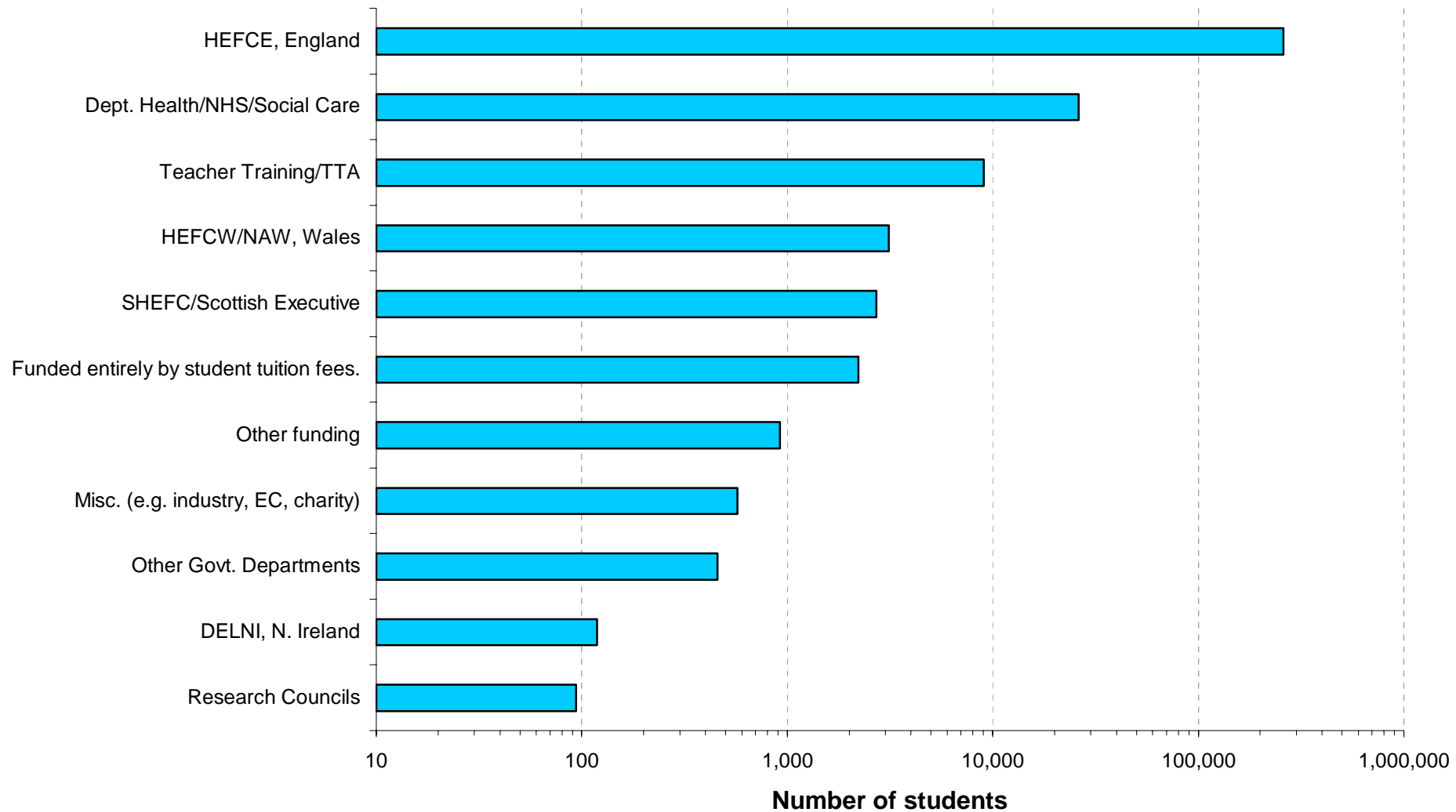
**Ethnicity and gender of students at London HEIs, 2005/06

### Ethnic background of students in and outside of London, 2005/06 (excluding overseas students)

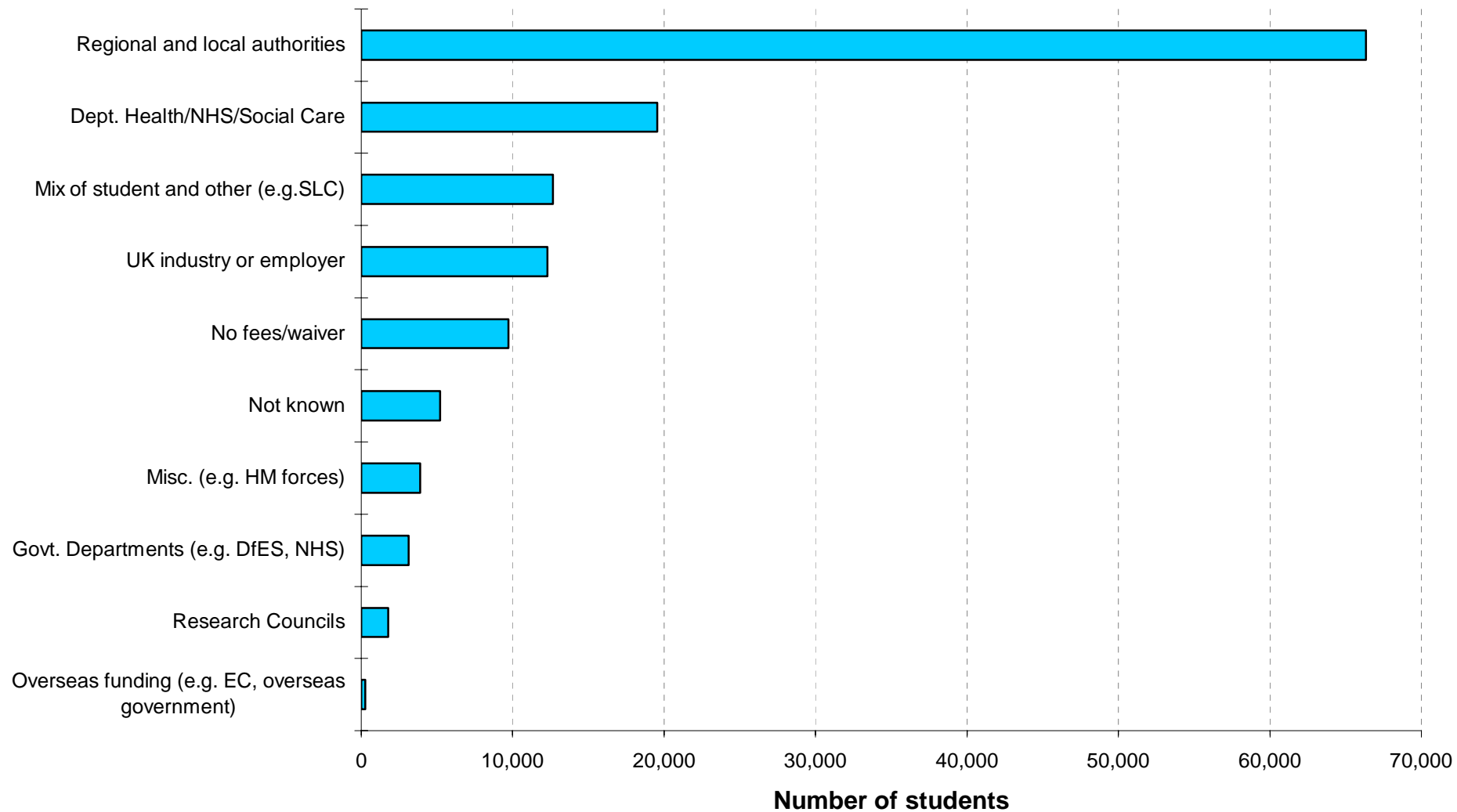


**Sources of funding for UK students at London HEIs, 2005/06  
(excl. overseas students)**

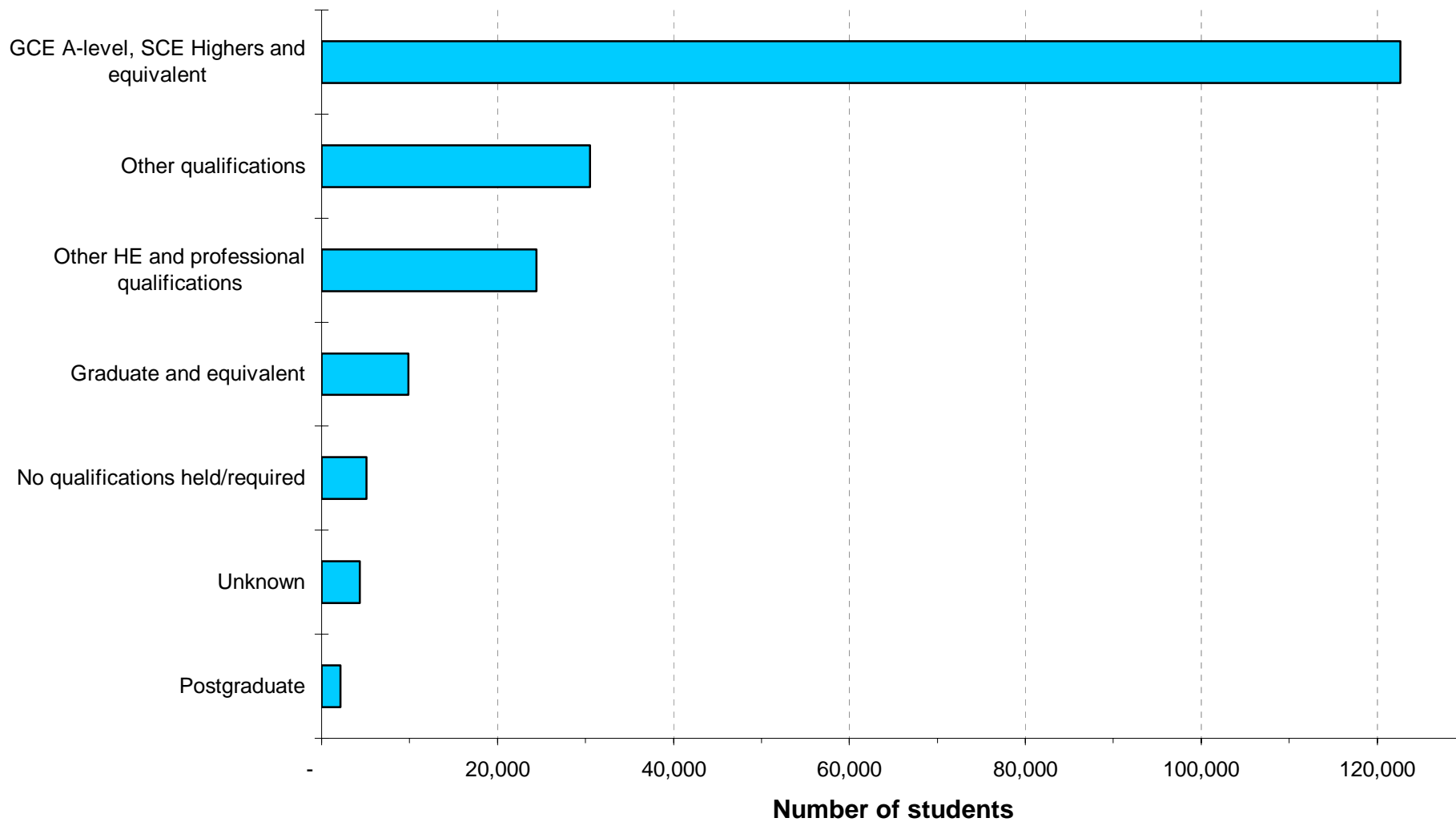




**Tuition fee sources for London students, 2005/06 (excl. overseas students)**
