

LONDON HIGHER FACTSHEET 2016

FINANCES OF HE INSTITUTIONS IN LONDON 2014/15



- During 2014/15, 162 UK higher education institutions (HEIs) had a total income of £33,199 million and a total expenditure of £31,176 million;
- The 39 HEIs in London had a combined income of £7,023 million and expenditure of £6,592 million;
- London HEIs obtained about 47% of combined income from tuition fees and education contracts; 21% from research grants; 15% from funding body grants; 17% from other sources, and less than 1% from endowments and investments;
- In London income from tuition fees and education contracts amounted to £3,278 million with 34%, or £1,120 million, from non-EU students and 44%, or £1,431 million, from full time UK and EU undergraduates;
- For research grants and contracts in London:
 - UK sources provided £1,126 million, including £400 million (36% of UK sources) from UK Research Councils; £316 million (28%) from UK charities, and £76 million (7%) from UK industry;
 - Nearly £360 million came from non-UK and other sources, with £172 million (48%) from EU government bodies and £43 million (12%) from non-EU charities;
- Income from intellectual property rights returned £34 million, 12 times smaller than income from residences and catering at almost £400 million;
- Academic departments in London counted for 36% of combined expenditure, with an additional 17% spent from research grants and contracts.

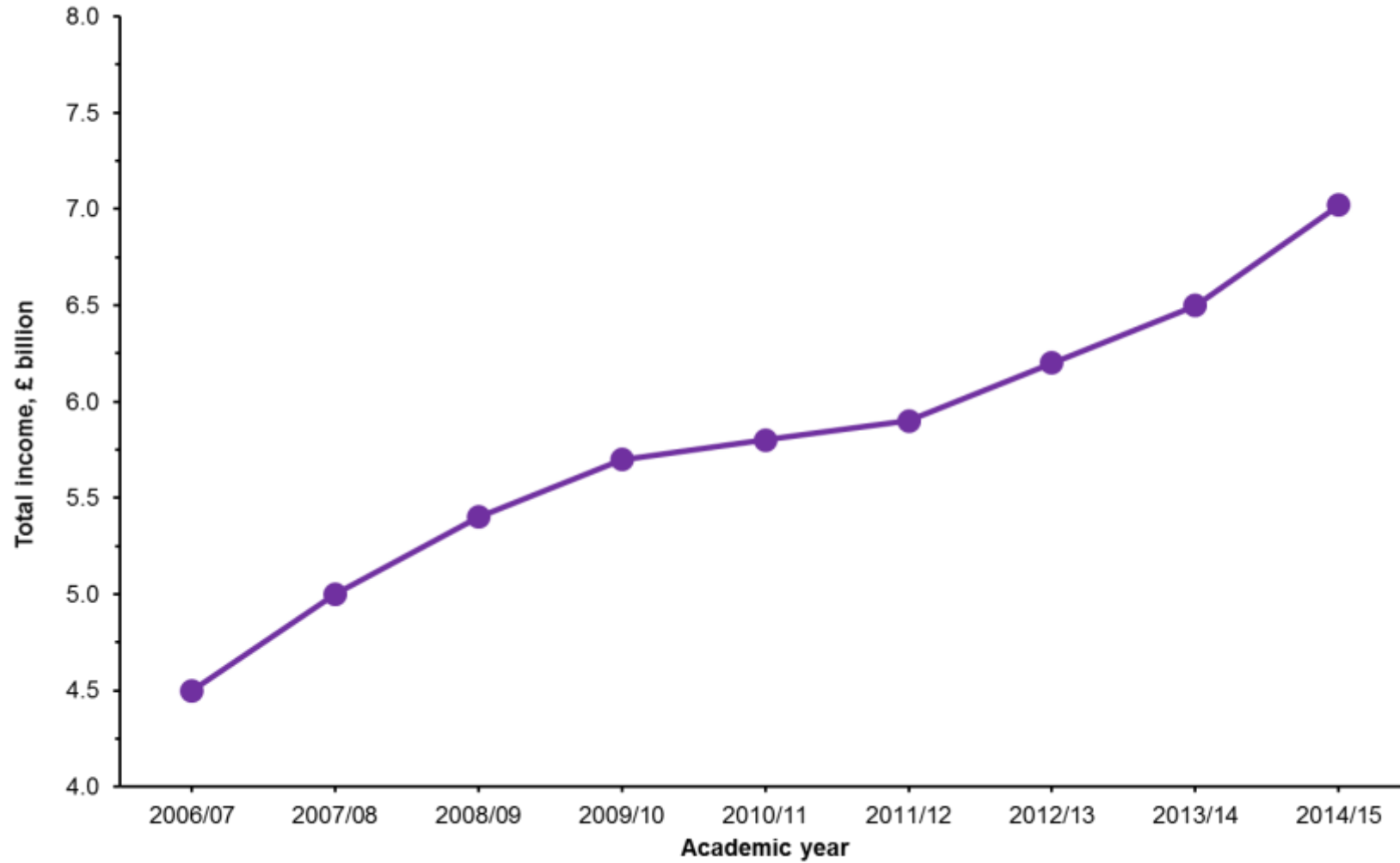

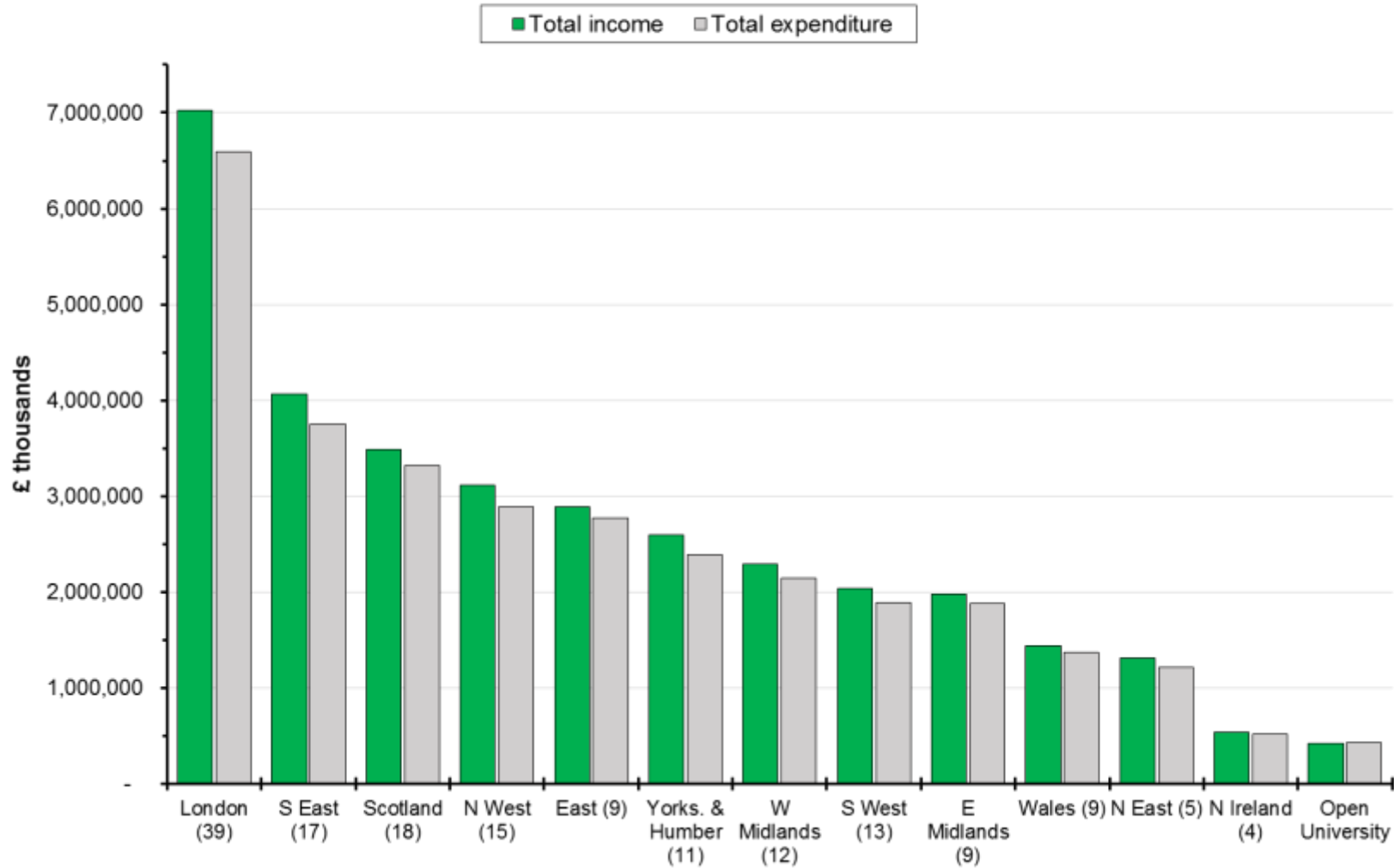
Total income of HE institutions in London

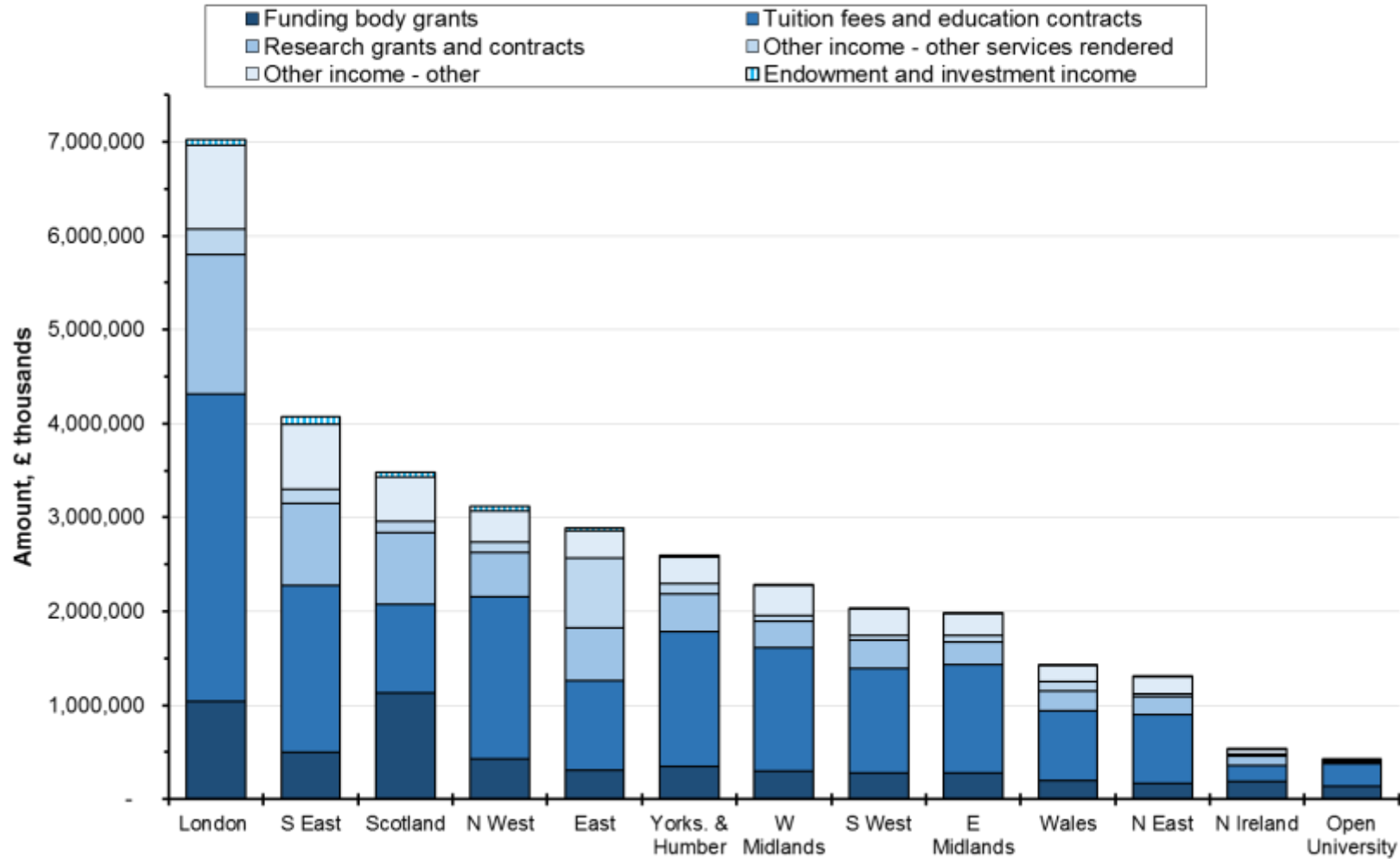
Total income and expenditure by UK region, 2014/15

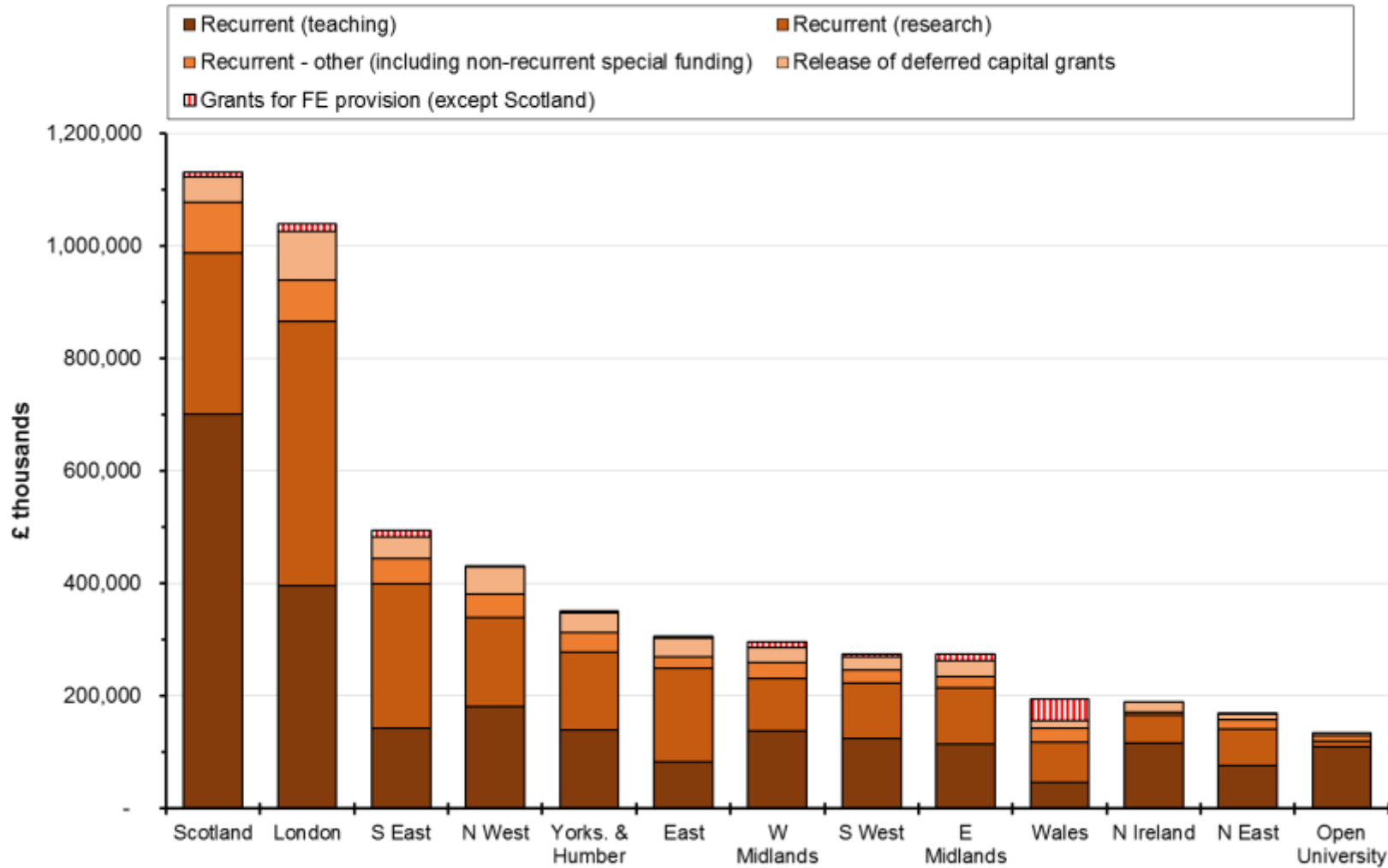
Income sources for HE institutions by region, 2014/15

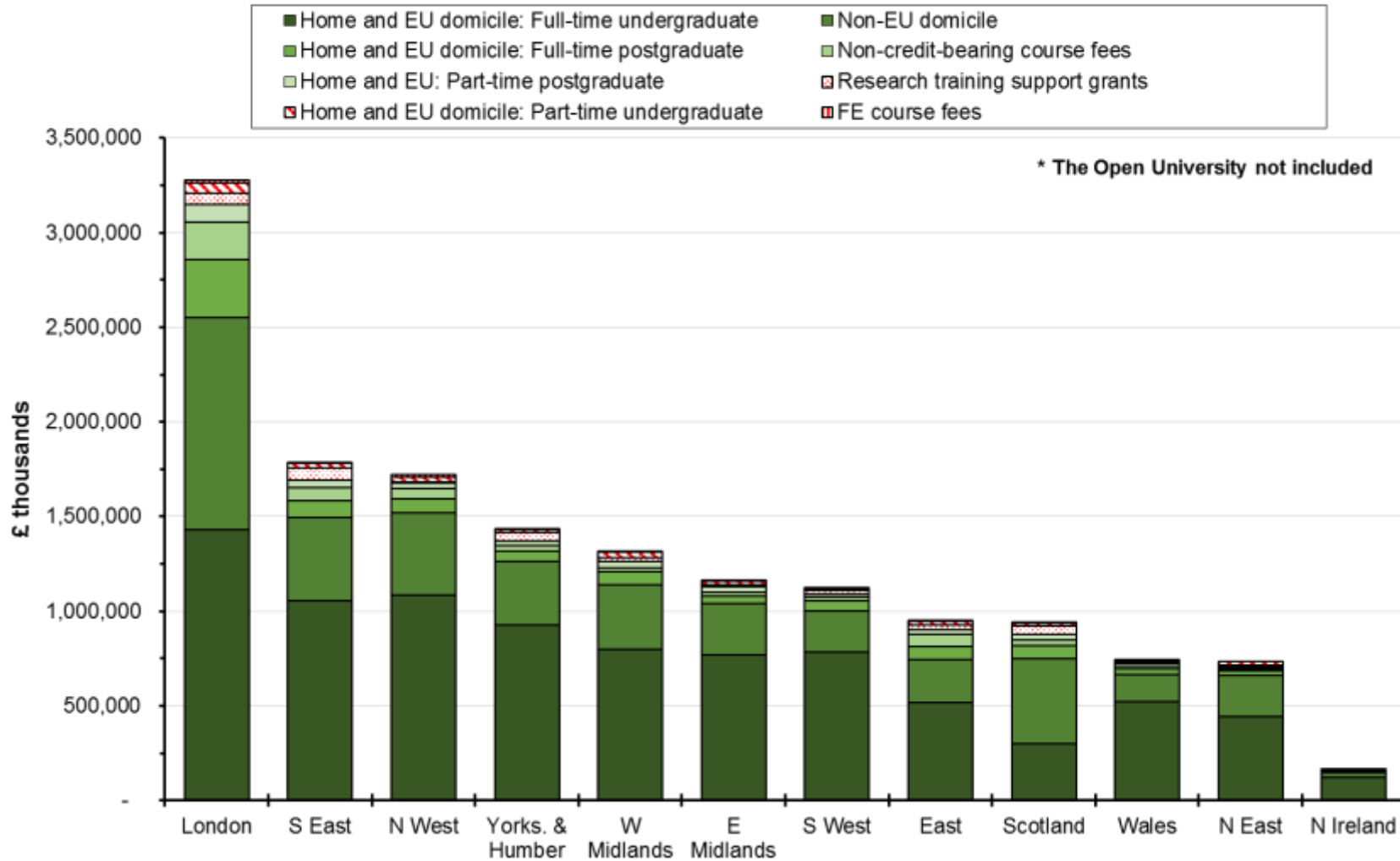
Income from funding body grants by region, 2014/15

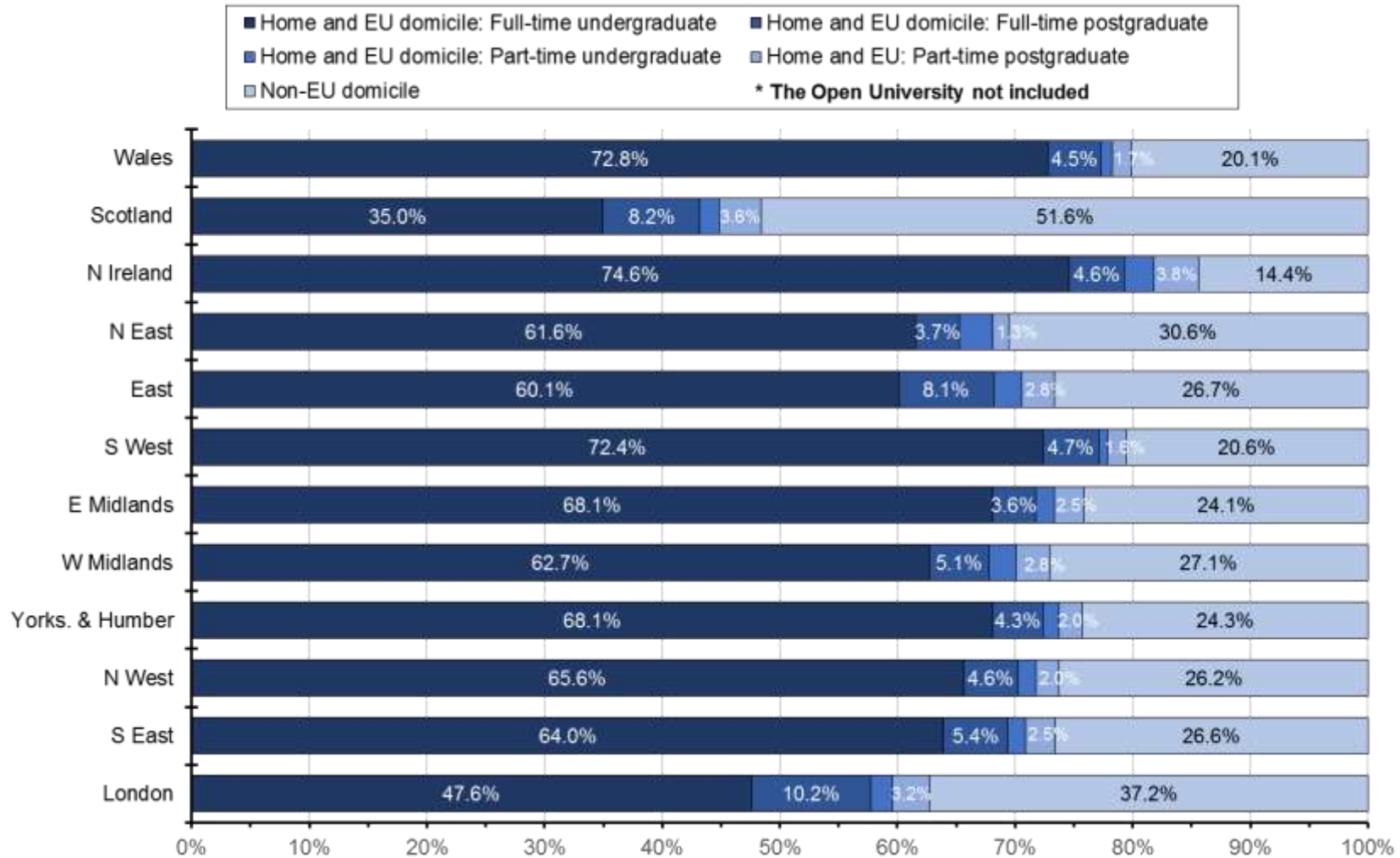
Income from HE and other course fees by region*, 2014/15

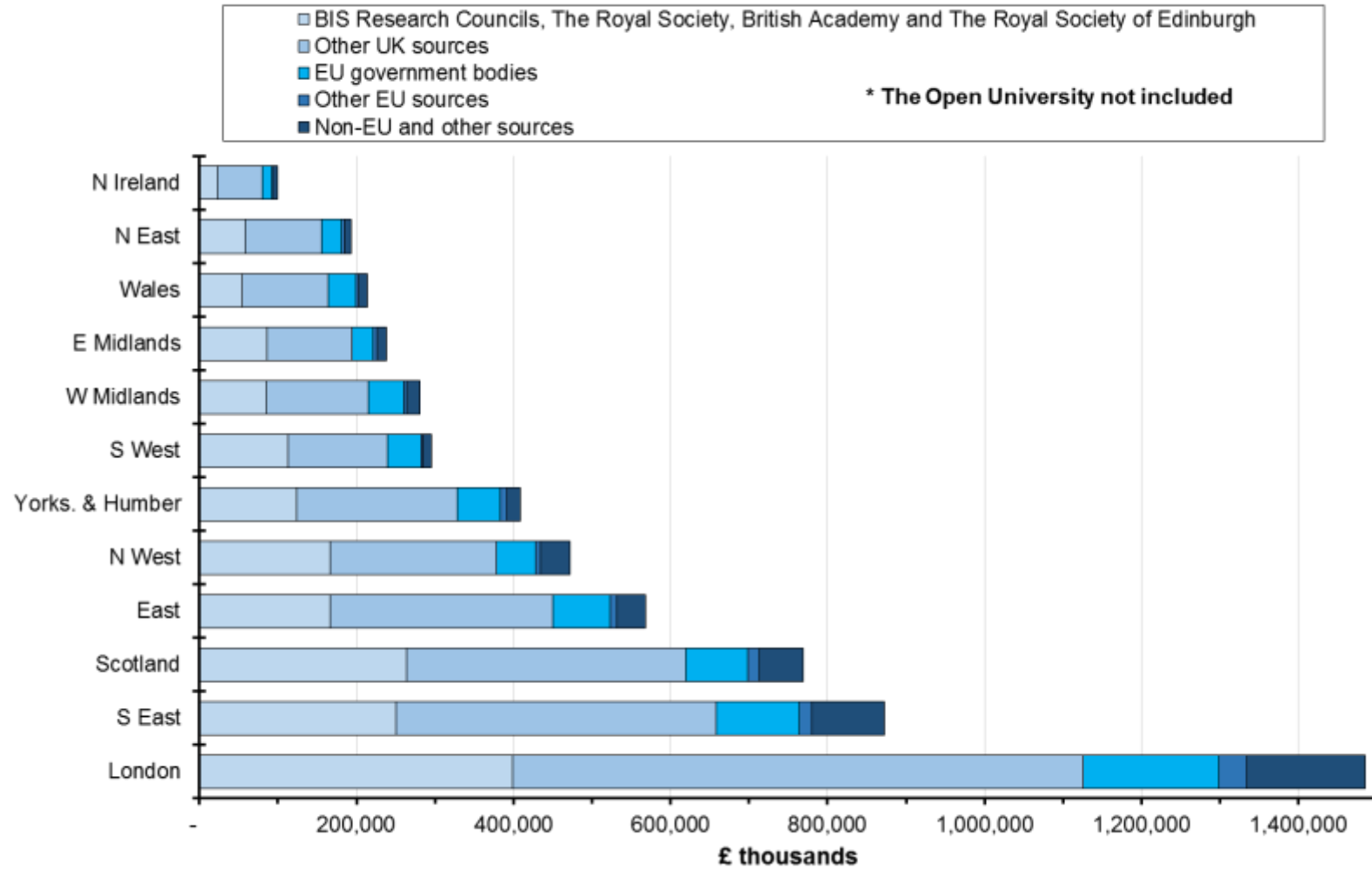
Income from HE course fees by region*, 2014/15

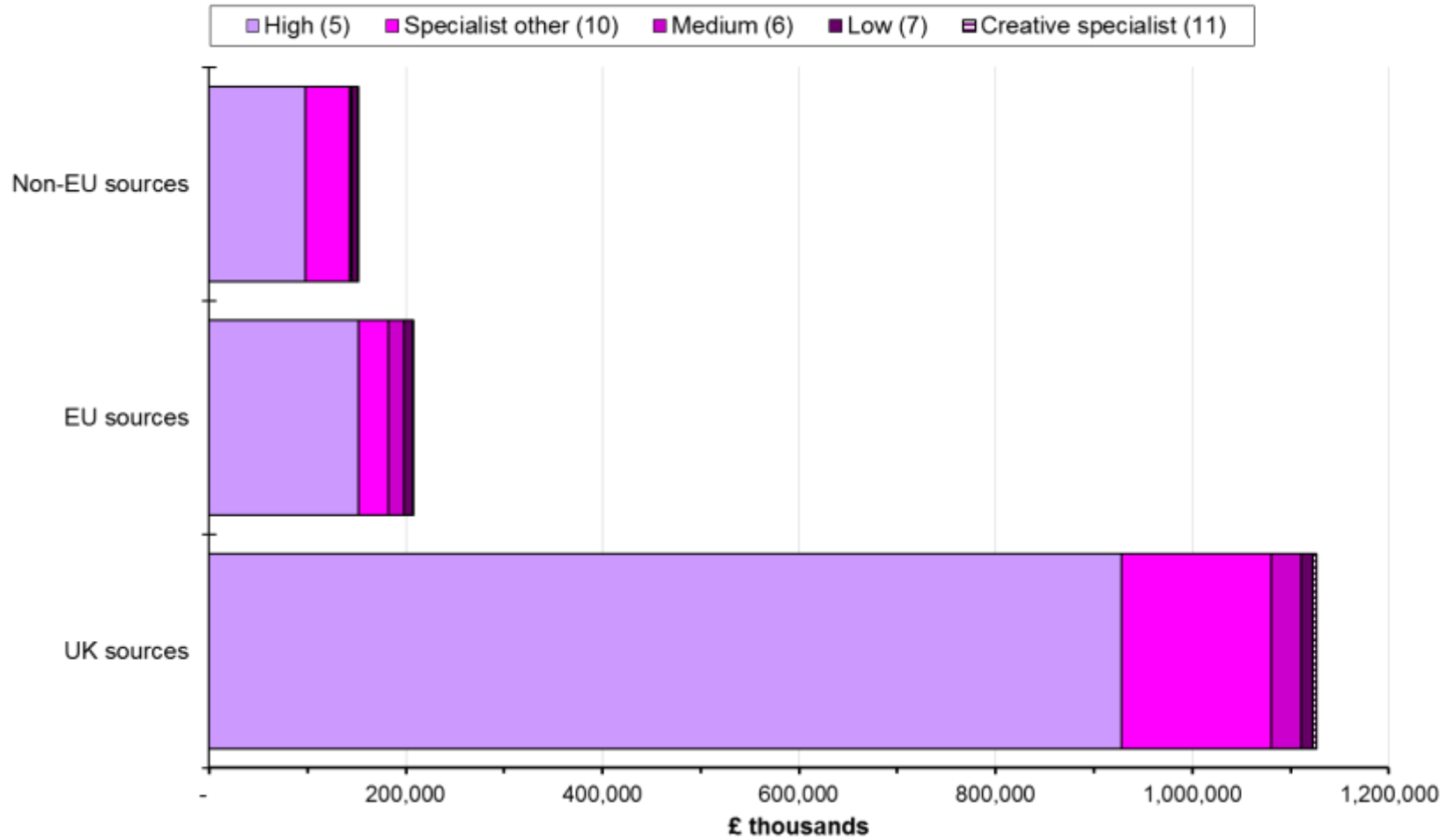
Income from research grants and contracts by region*, 2014/15
