

## LONDON HIGHER FACTSHEET 2014



### HE-BCI SURVEY, 2012/13

#### Income from research and other services

- Higher education institutions (HEIs) in London won over £156 million through collaborative research involving public funding;
- Income from contract research by HEIs in London was almost £304 million, with 2% from SMEs and 67% involving non-commercial organisations;
- In addition, £74 million was obtained from consultancies, making up 19% of the £400 million obtained by HEIs in the UK from consultancies;
- HEIs in London gained £21 million from facilities and equipment services, comprising 15% of the £141.5 million received by all HEIs in the UK;
- Regeneration and redevelopment grants totalled almost £6.8 million to HEIs in London;
- CPD and continuing education courses amounted to 1,146 million learner days with a revenue of £170 million.

#### Intellectual property and spin-offs

- HEIs in London had a cumulative portfolio of over 5,400 patents;
- Revenue from IP activities was £23 million, a decrease by £9 million since 2009/10, with a revenue to cost ratio of 3.3 to 1;
- HEIs in London supported over 1,700 active spin-off companies, mostly as graduate start-ups (88%);
- Active spin-offs employed 6,700 staff (FTE) with 63% in graduate start-ups;
- Turnover of active spin-offs was £148 million, an increase of £31 million from 2011/12.

#### Social, cultural and community activities\*

- Attendance at events organised by HEIs in London was over 2.5 million people with 60% going to exhibitions at galleries and museums;
- Academic staff spent about 21,700 days on organising and assisting in events for the public.

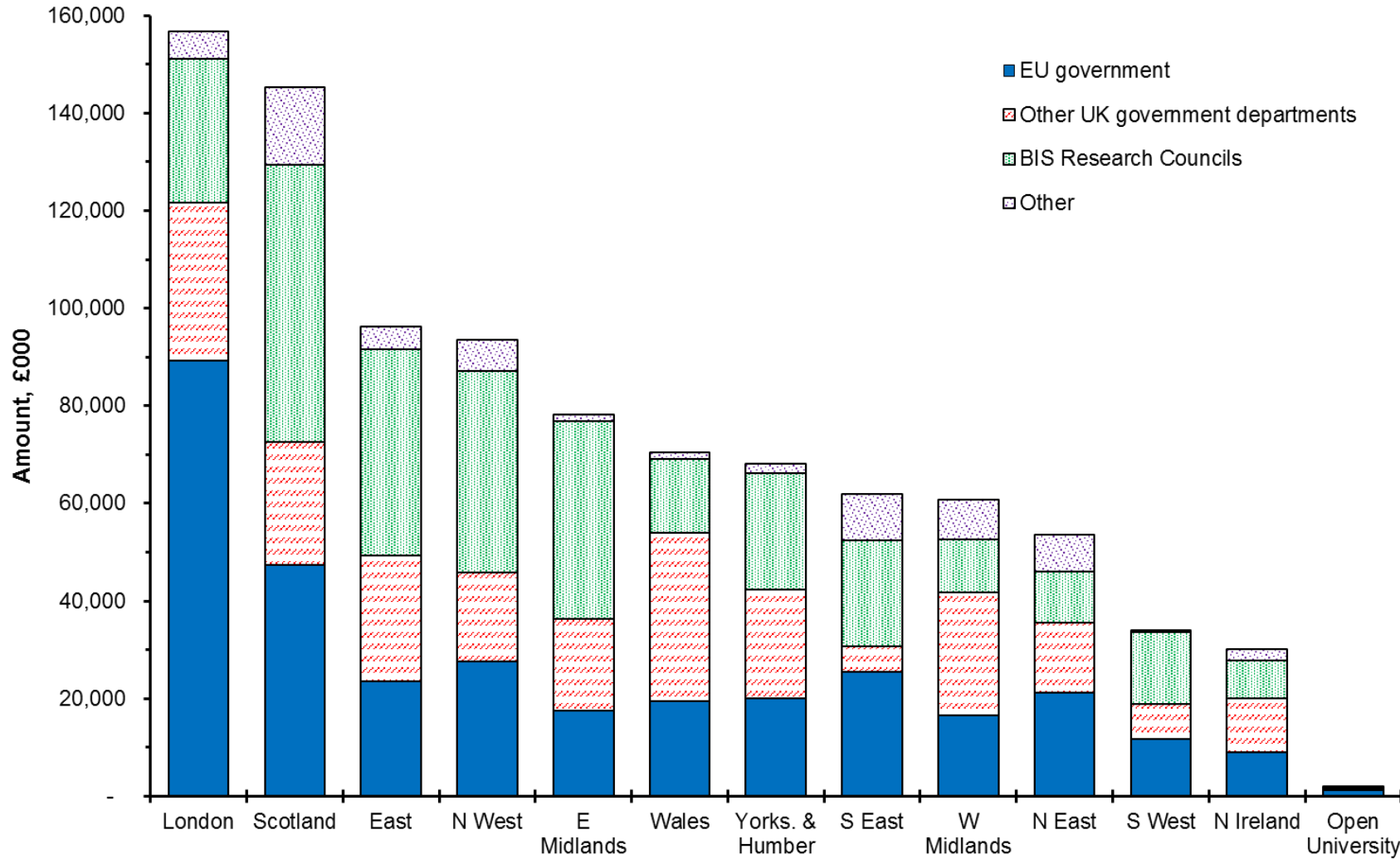

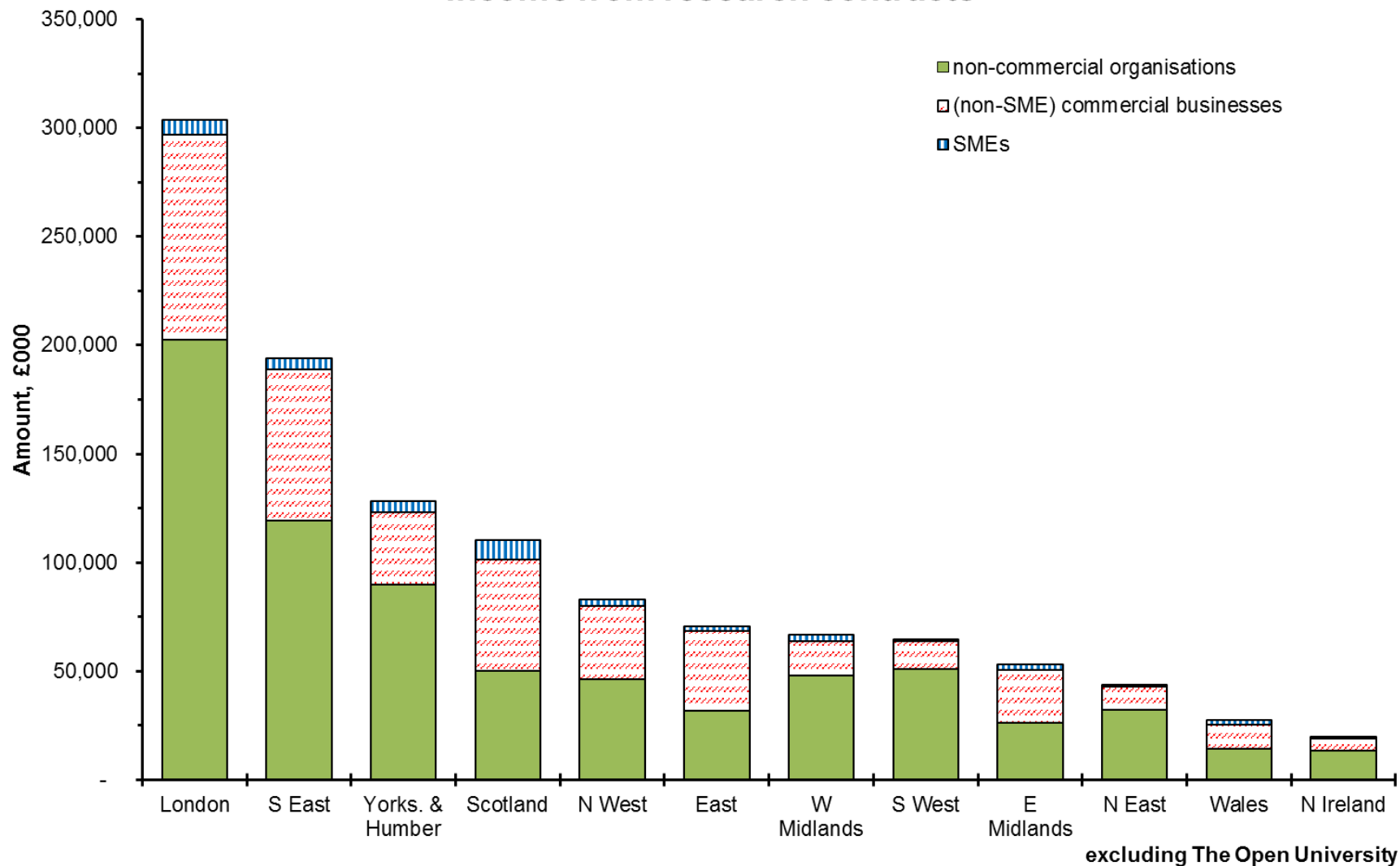

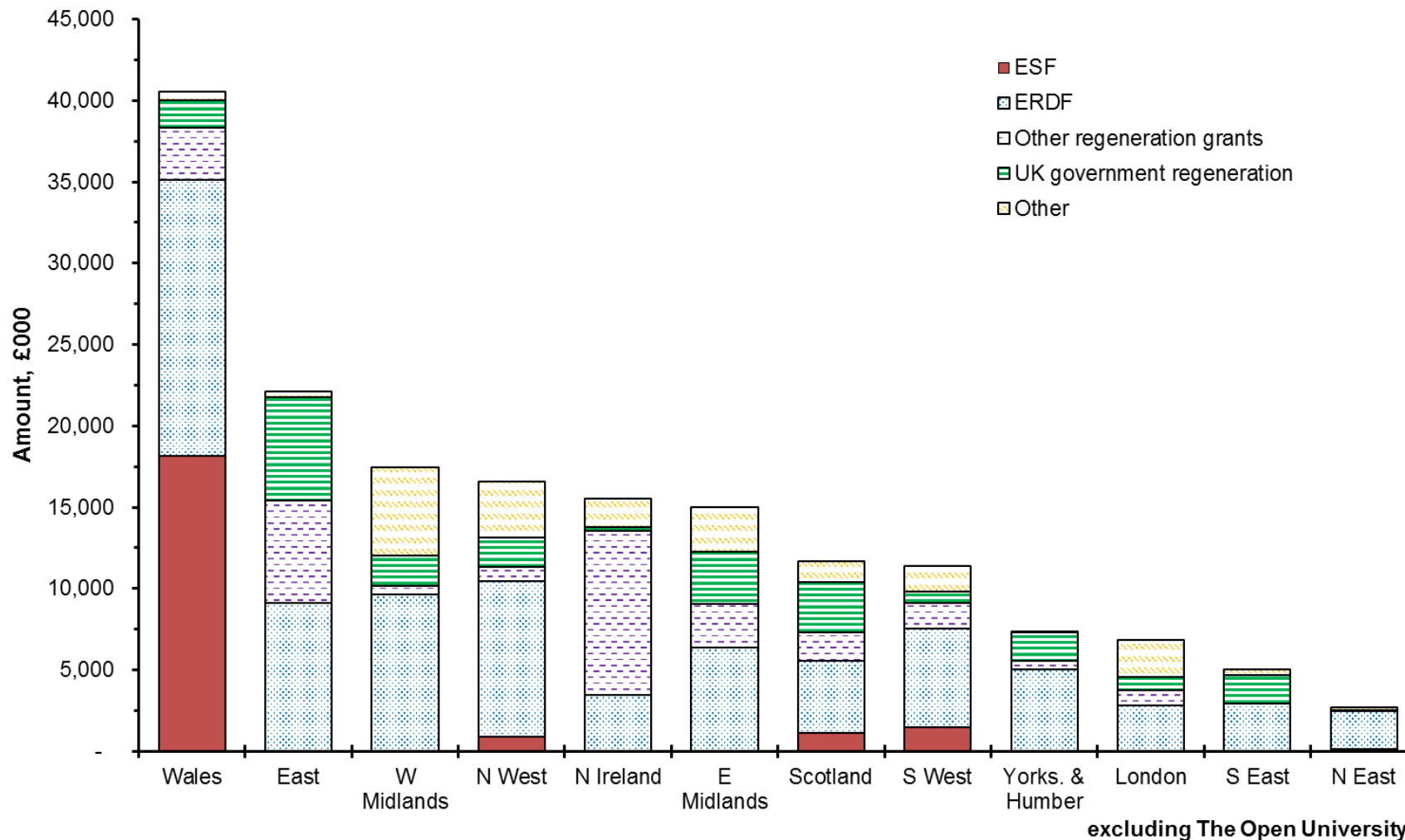

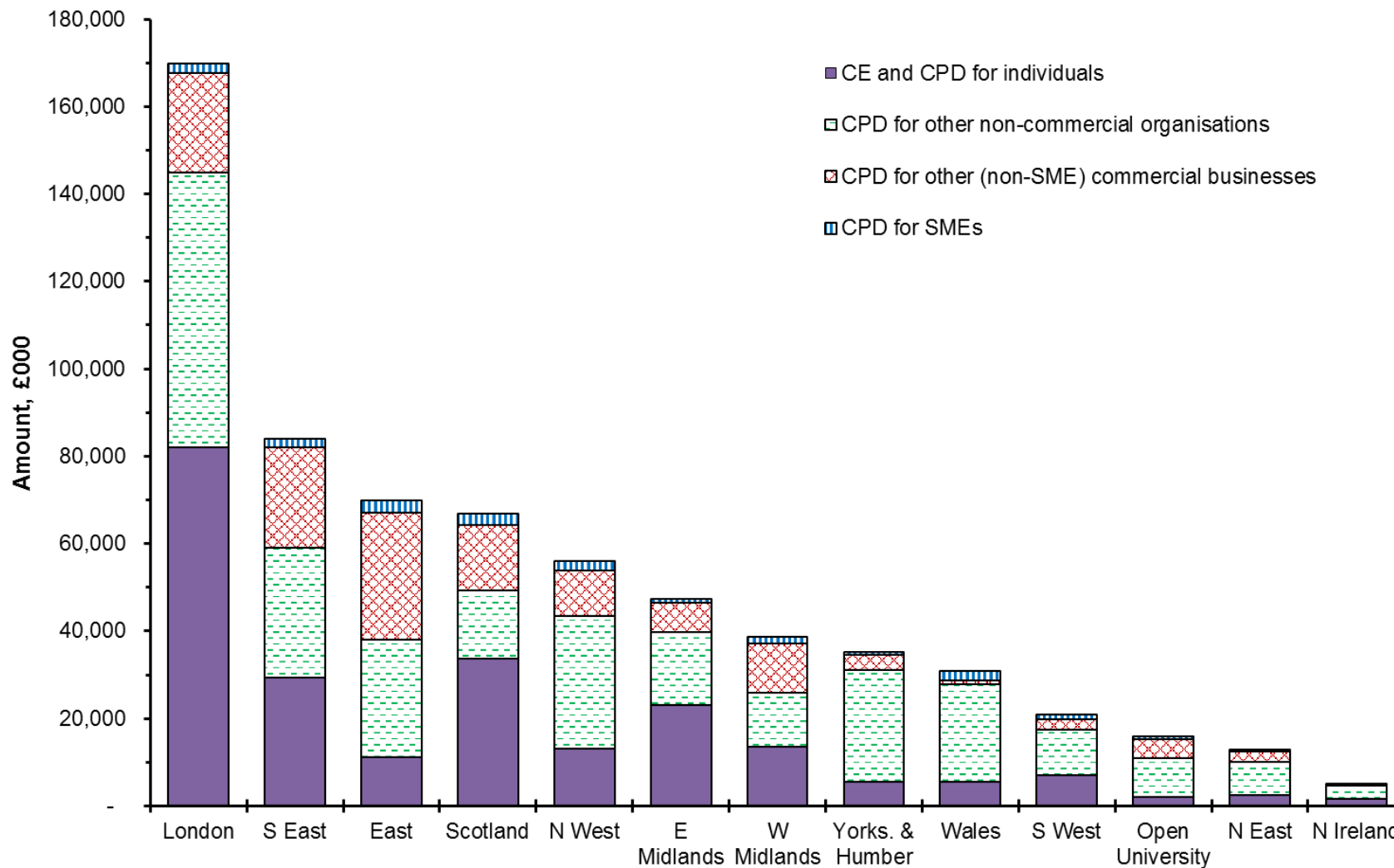
### Income from research contracts



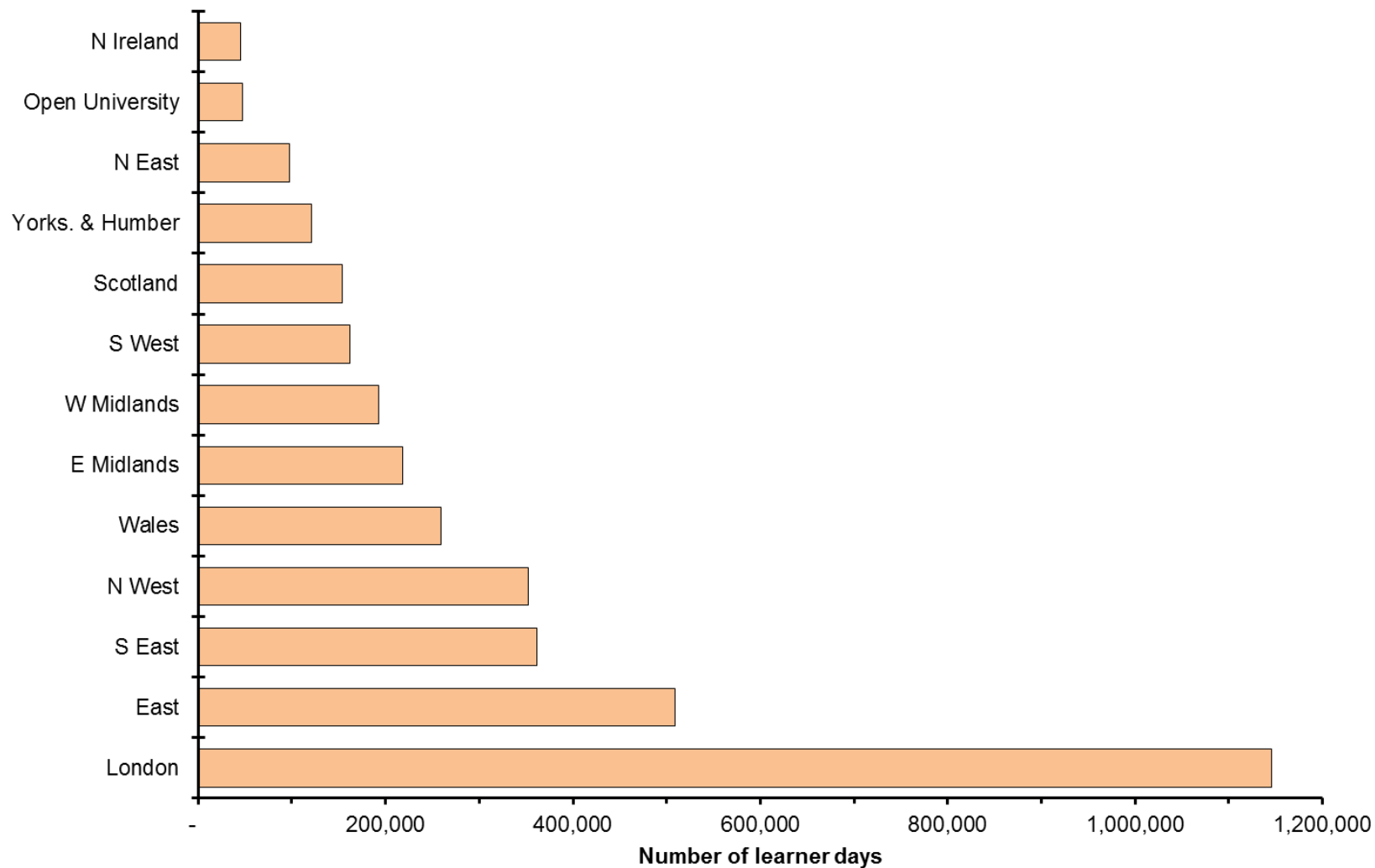
### Income from regeneration programmes



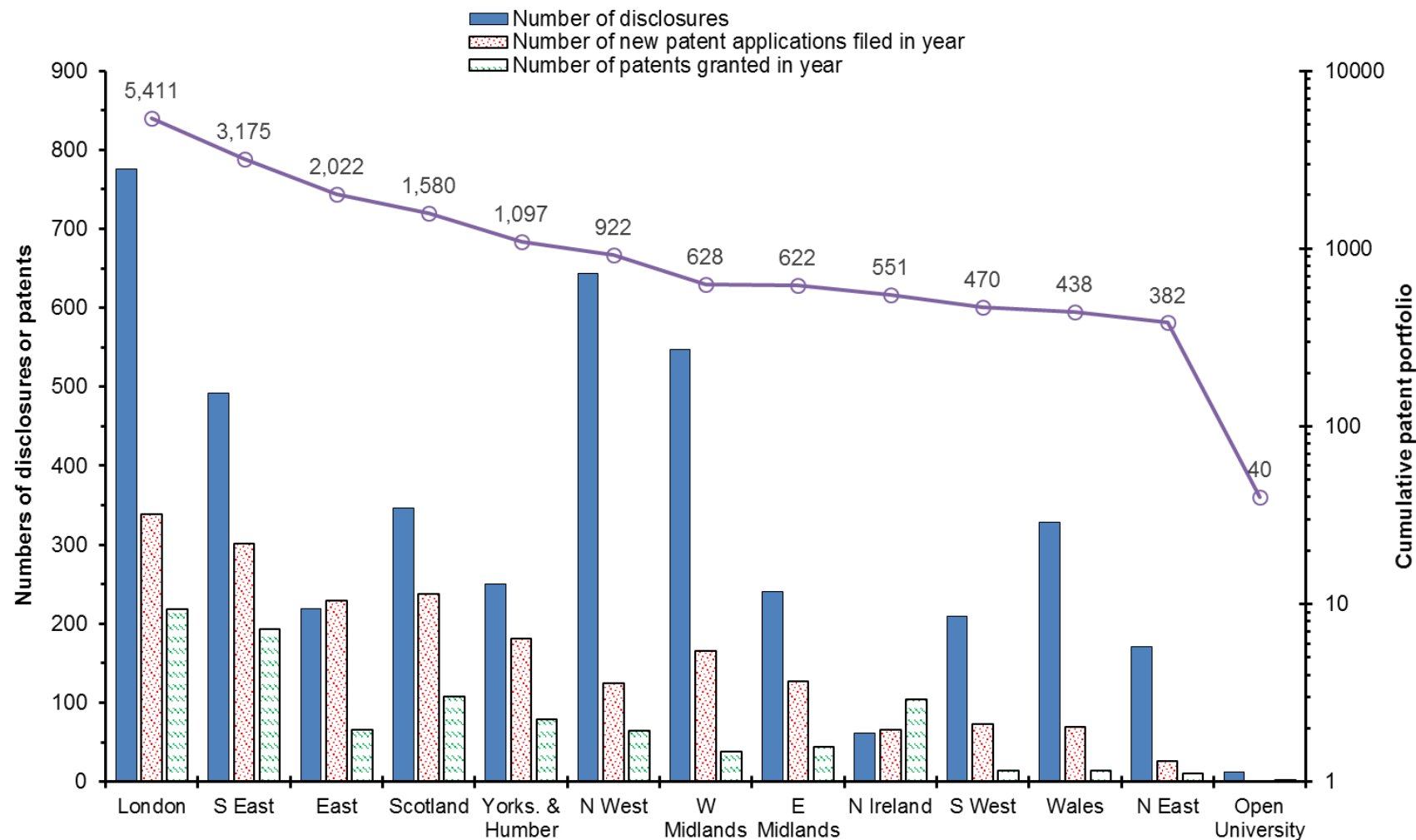
### Income from CE and CPD



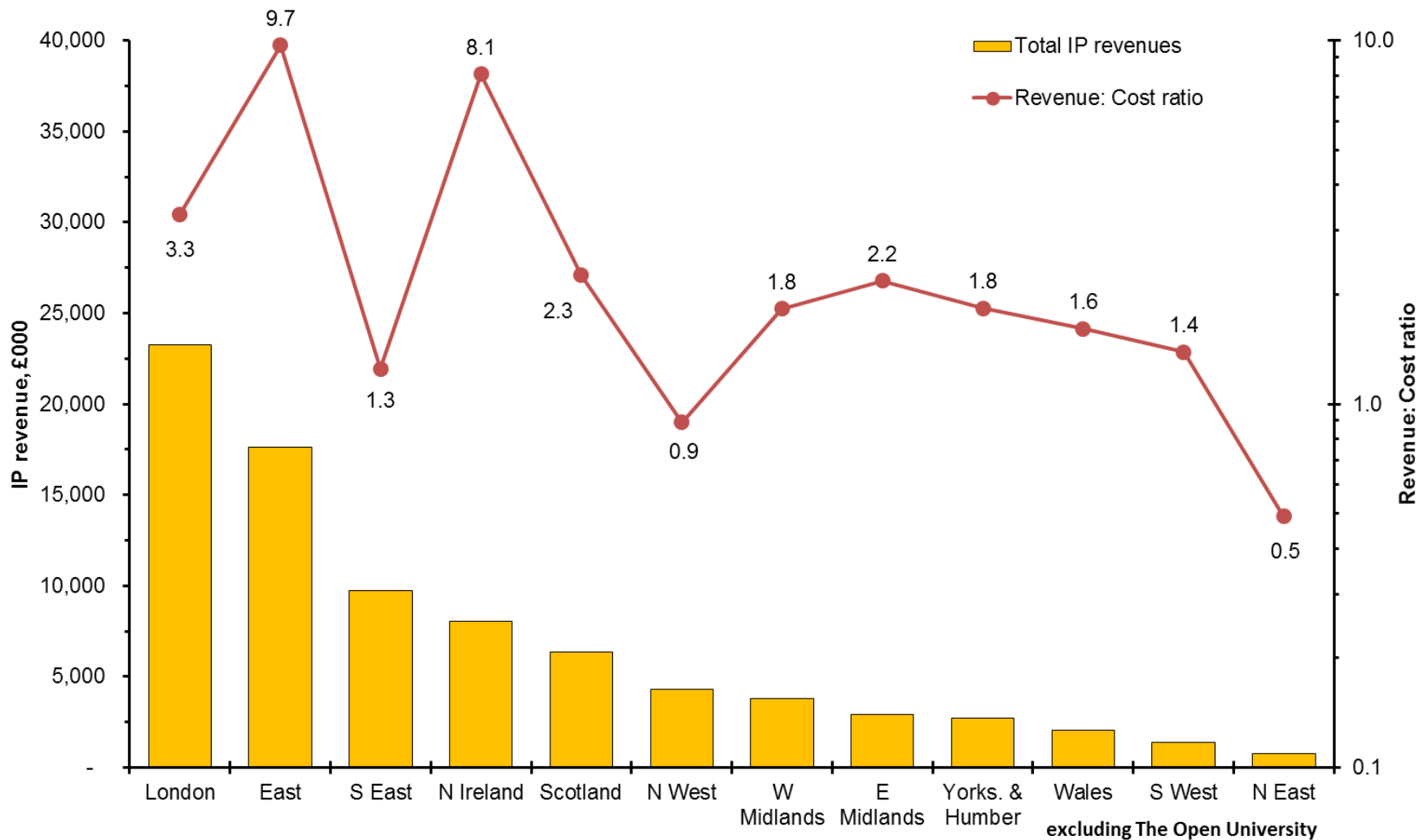
### Total learner days of CPD/CE courses delivered



### Numbers of disclosures and patents

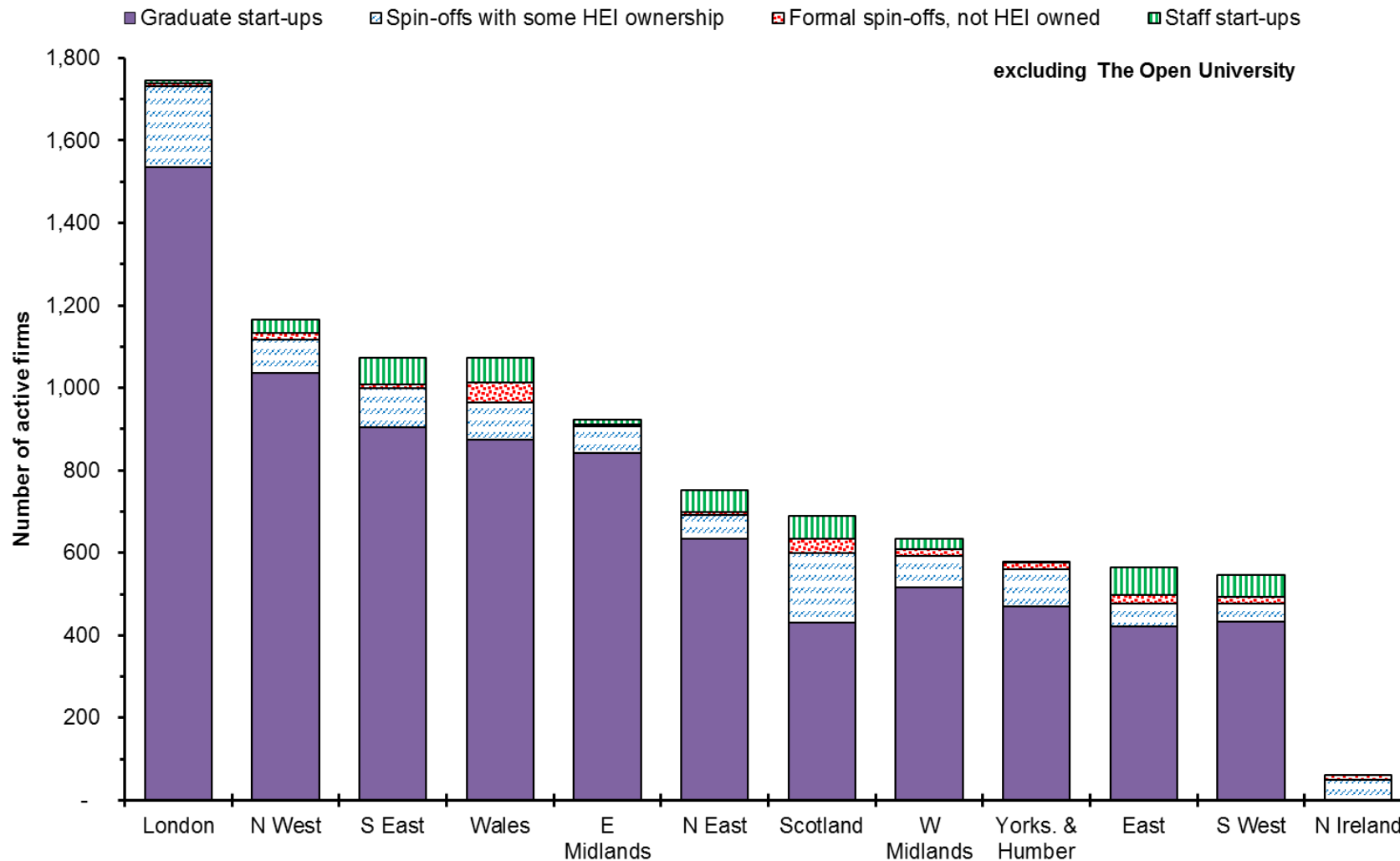


### Revenue from IP activities

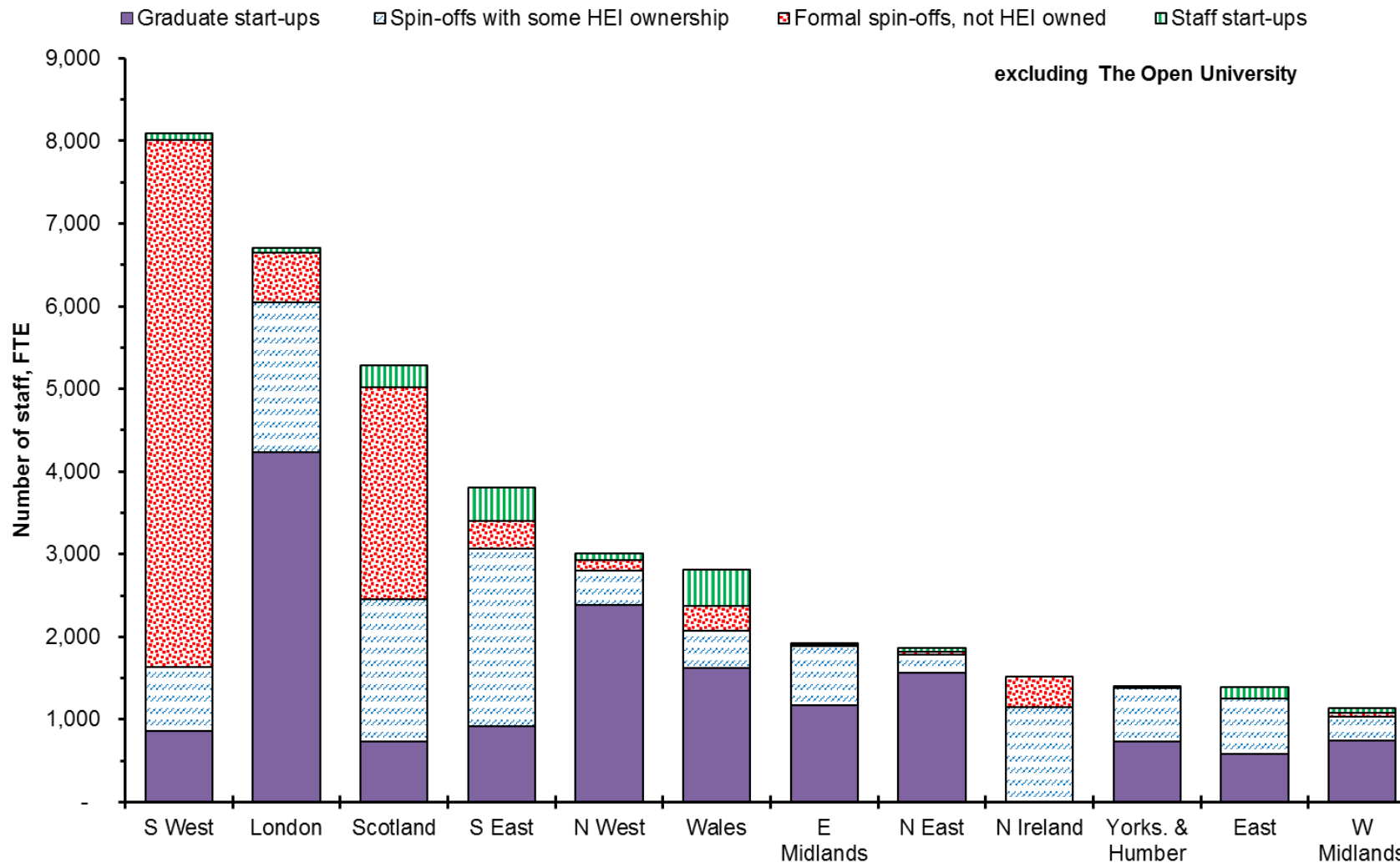




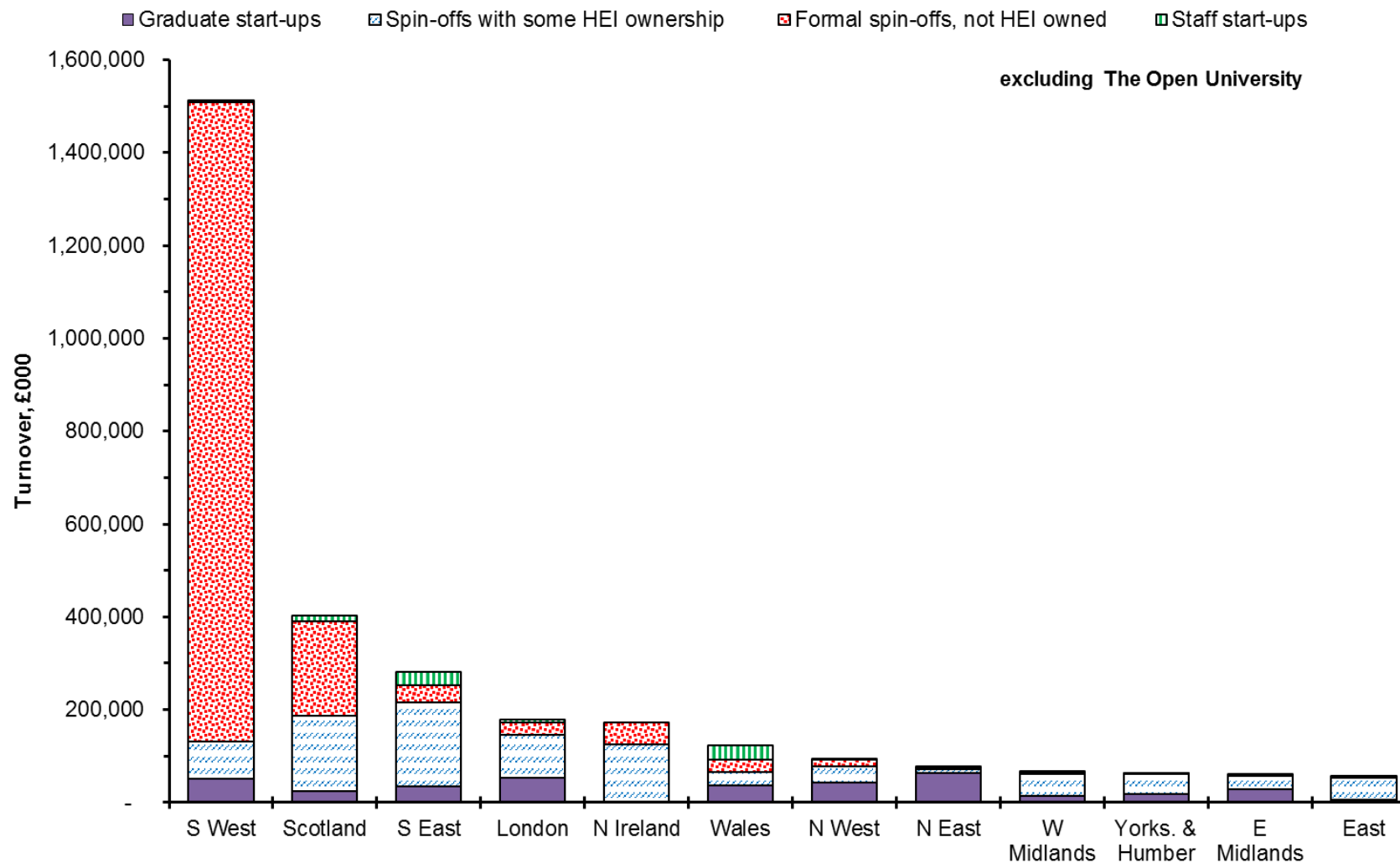
### Number of active firms from spin-off activities
