

LONDON HIGHER FACTSHEET 2014

STAFF IN HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS 2012/13 – LONDON REGION

- During the 2012/13 academic year 456,500 staff were employed at 162 higher education (HE) institutions in the UK.
- Over 84,000 staff (18% of the UK total) were employed in London.
- HE staff in London consisted of 39,690 academic, 32,790 non-academic and 11,650 academic atypical staff (see Notes).
- In London, 26% of academic staff carried out teaching duties, 49% did both teaching and research and 25 % worked solely in research.
- Women comprised 45% of academic staff in London, 60% of non-academic staff and 50% of academic atypical staff.
- Black and other ethnic minority groups made up 18% of London academic staff, 24% of non-academic staff and 19% of academic atypical staff.
- 30% of all academic ethnic minority staff in the UK were employed in London.
- Based on 28,790 FTE, 23% of academic staff in London were grouped under clinical medicine.
- Academic cost centres where staff in London comprised more than 20% of the relevant UK total included clinical medicine (34%); clinical dentistry (29%); anthropology (29%); art and design (24%), and music, dance, drama & performing arts (33%).

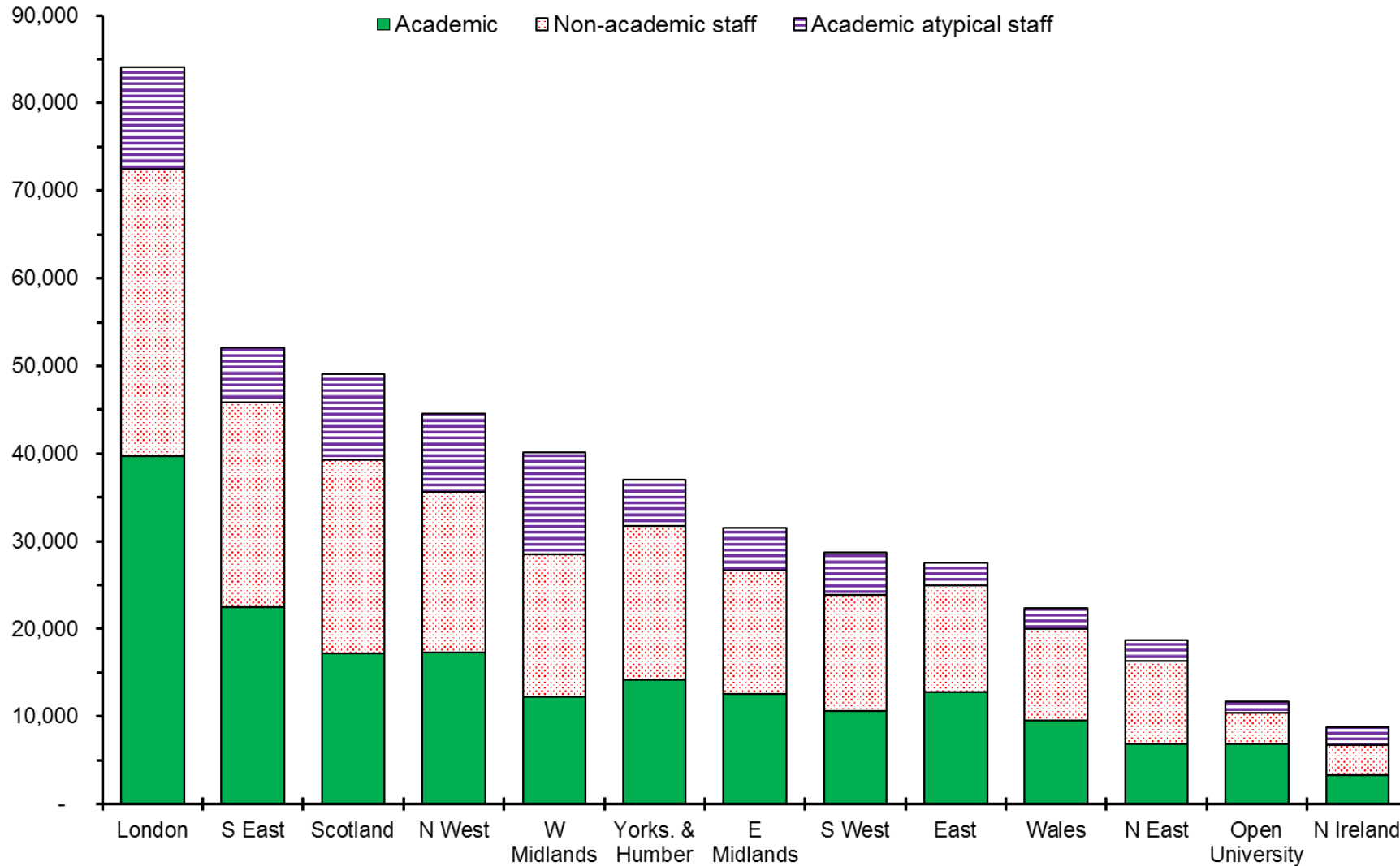

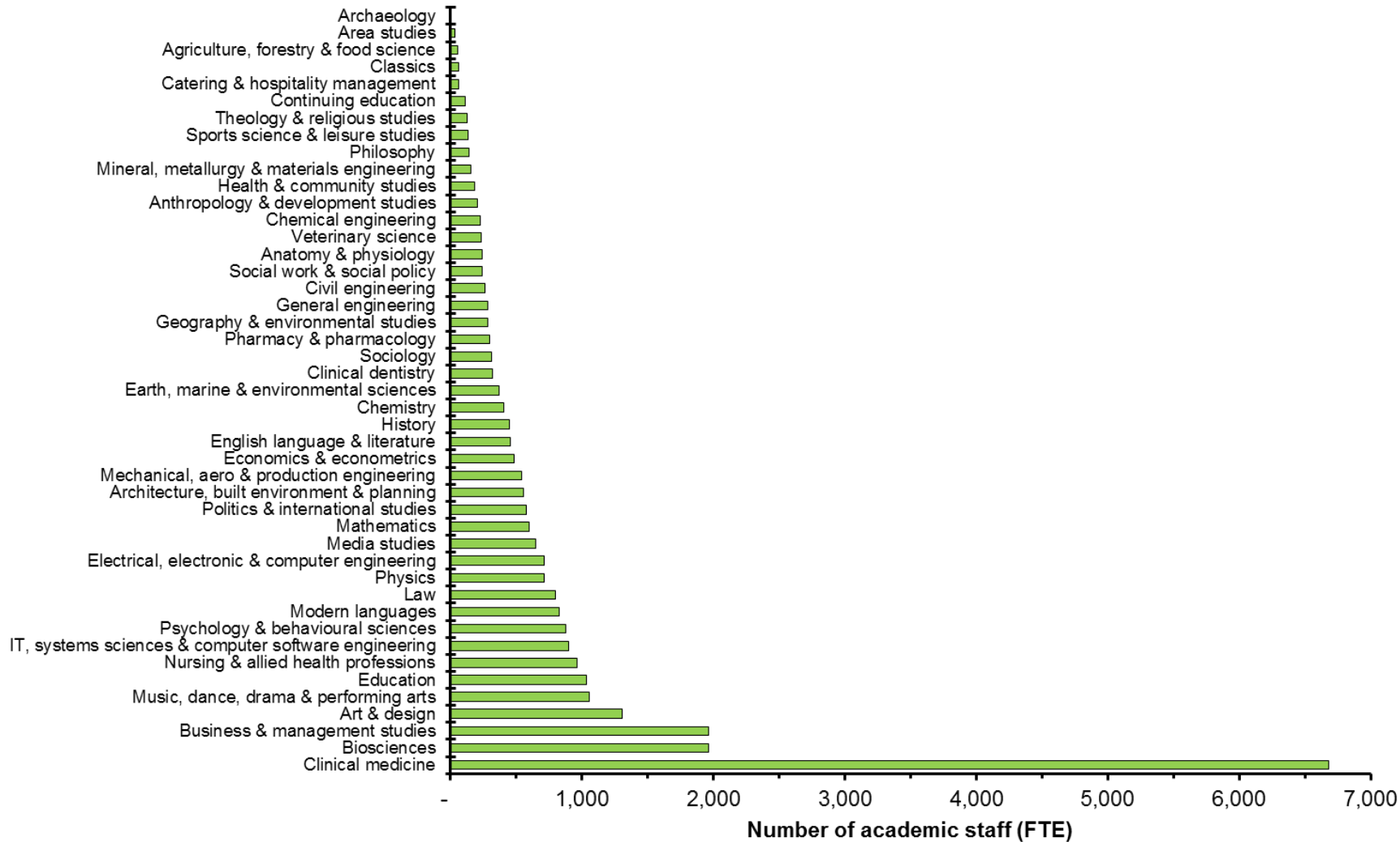
