Medical Research Council: Responsive mode grant awards 2009/10

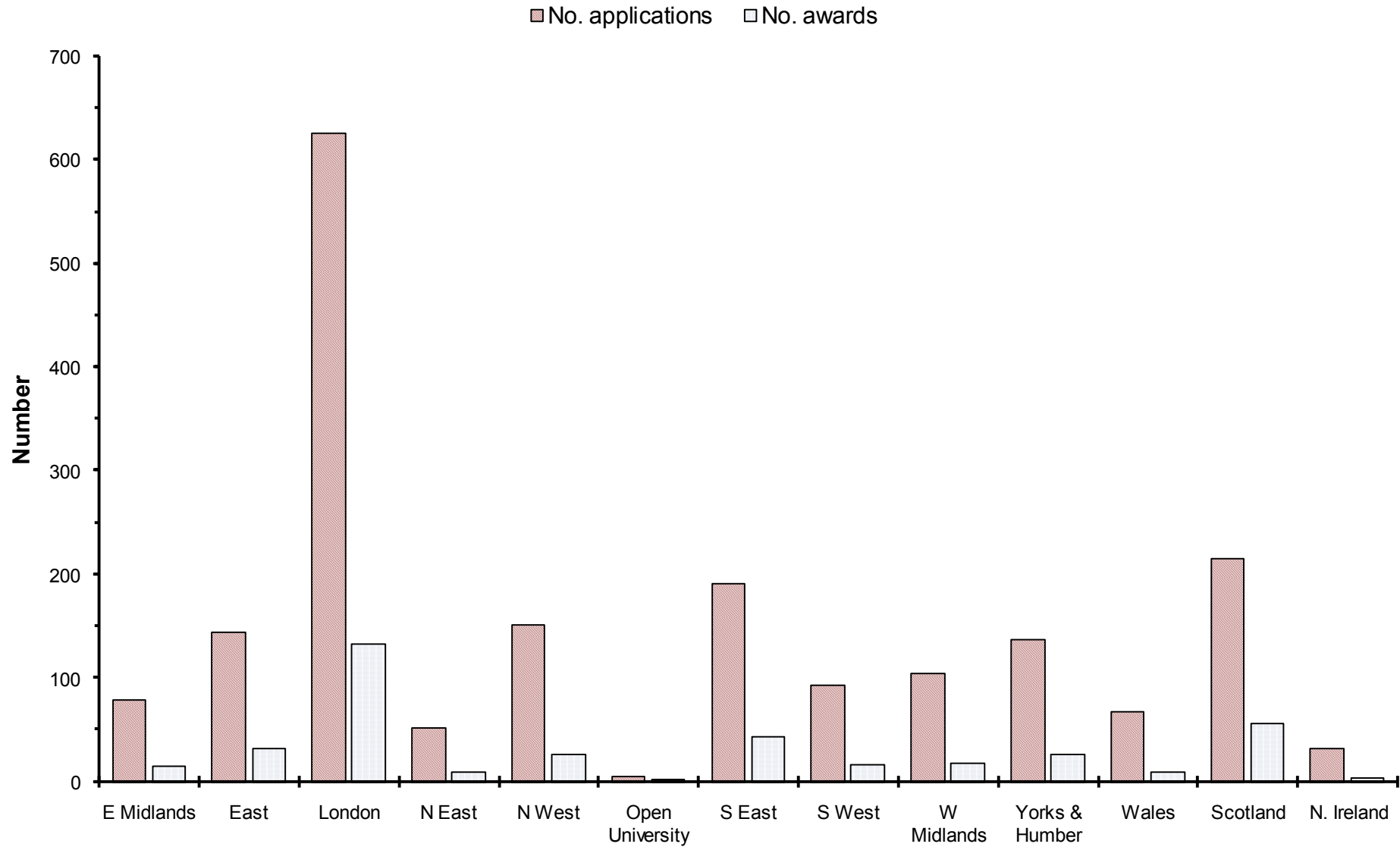
1. Awards made by MRC between April 2009 and March 2010 were summed by UK region for grant and Fellowship awards.
2. Of 94 research organisations (ROs) applying for grants, 25 were based in London and 11 of these received one or more grants

3. The success rate for ROs in London at 21% was a slight decrease from 23% in 2008/09 (179 awards from 792 applications).
4. ROs in Scotland had the highest success rate followed by the South East and East.
5. ROs in London obtained £83 million (*ca.* £20 million less than the previous year) which was equivalent to 36% of the £228 million in funding for 2009/10.
6. Of the 132 grants awarded to London, UCL received 49, Imperial College had 33 and King's College London obtained 24.
