### Medical Research Council: grant awards 2010/11

1. Awards made by MRC between April 2010 and March 2011 were summed by UK region for grant and Fellowship awards.
2. Of 94 research organisations (ROs) applying for grants, 20 were based in London and 11 of these were awarded one or more grants

3. The overall success rate for London at 18%, a slight decrease from 21% in 2010/11, was exceeded by the East at 28%
4. ROs in London obtained £81.7 million, *ca.* £1 million less than the previous year, which was equivalent to 32% of the £252 million in MRC grants.
5. Of the 132 grants awarded to London, UCL received 34, King's College London obtained 31 and Imperial College had 27.
