

Medical Research Council: grant success rates for 2013/14

- Grant and Fellowship applications during 2013/2014 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- Of 127 ROs applying for grants, 23 were in London and nine received one or more awards.

- The overall success rate for ROs in London was 2% less than for 2013/14.
- ROs in London won £123 million, 36% of the £342 million awarded by MRC in this period.
- Of the 134 grants in London, 41 were won by King's College London, 40 by UCL and 27 by Imperial College.
