

Medical Research Council: grant success rates for 2012/13

- Grant and Fellowship applications during 2012/2013 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- Of 96 ROs applying for grants, 21 were in London and 11 received one or more awards.

- The overall success rate for ROs in London was 1% less than for 2012/13.
- ROs in London won £121 million, 32% of the £373 million awarded by MRC in this period.
- Of the 149 grants in London, 46 were won by UCL, 31 by Imperial College and 30 by King's College London.
