

Natural Environment Research Council: Grant success rates, 2011/12

- Awards for responsive mode and research grants and knowledge exchange schemes during 2011/2012 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- From 312 ROs applying for grants, 23 were in London and of these nine received one or more awards.
