Natural Environment Research Council: Responsive mode grant awards 2010/11

1. Awards made between April 2010 and March 2011 were summed by UK region covering all responsive and knowledge exchange schemes as well as research grant applications but not Research Fellowships.
2. Of 173 research organisations (ROs) applying for grants, 23 were based in London and 17 of these were awarded one or more grants.

3. The success rate for London ROs was 27%, similar to the previous year's 26%, but exceeded by the South East at 31%.
4. ROs in London obtained £15.5 million, compared with £28 million in 2009/10 and £8 million in 2008/09, which was equivalent to 27% of the £118 million in funding for 2010/11 (£108 million in 2009/10 and £83 million in 2008/09).
5. Of the 63 grants awarded to London UCL received 20 and Imperial College obtained 18.
