

Natural and Environmental Sciences Research Council: grant success rates for 2013/14

- Research grant applications and awards during 2013/2014 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO)
- From 162 ROs applying for grants, 23 were in London and of these 12 received one or more awards

- The overall success rate for ROs in London was 2% less than for 2012/13
- ROs in London won £12.6 million, 10% of the £131 million awarded by NERC in this period
- Of the 59 grants in London, 13 each were won by Imperial College and the British Geological Survey, and 12 by UCL
