

Natural and Environmental Sciences Research Council: grant success rates for 2012/13

- Research grant applications and awards during 2012/2013 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- From 102 ROs applying for grants, 17 were in London and of these 12 received one or more awards.

- The overall success rate for ROs in London was 9% higher than in 2011/12.
- ROs in London won £12.3 million, 10% of the £123 million awarded by NERC in this period.
- Of the 43 grants in London, 13 were won Imperial College, 11 by UCL and six by Queen Mary, University of London.
