Science and Technology Facilities Research Council: overall grant awards 2008/09

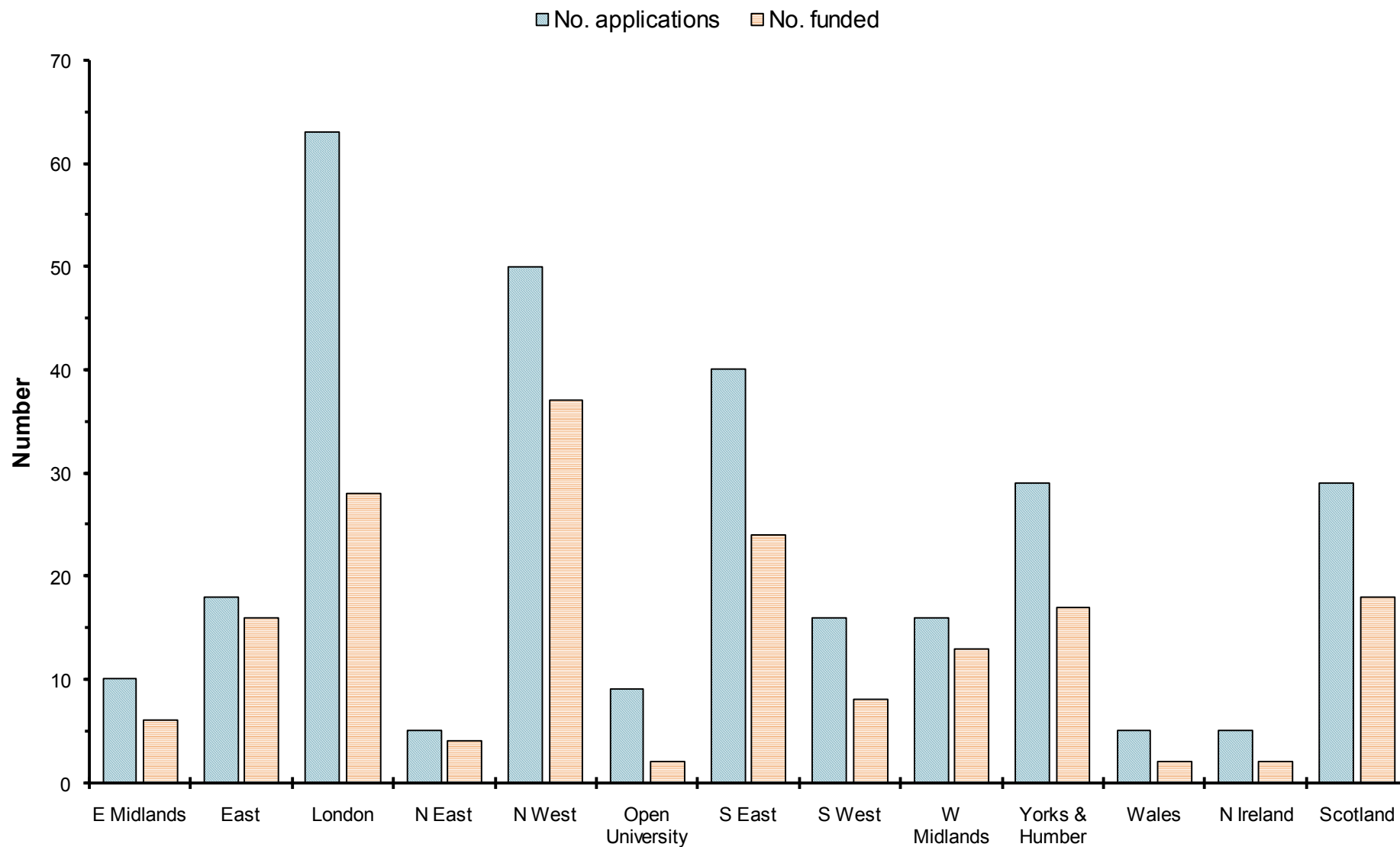
1. Awards made by STFC in 2008/09 were summed by UK region for research organisations (ROs).
2. Of 46 ROs applying for standard and rolling grants, seven were based in London and six received one or more grants.

3. The success rate for ROs in London was 44%, much less than success rates for the East, North East, or West Midlands with 80% or higher.
4. ROs in London obtained £10.8 million which was equivalent to 11% of the total of £95.8 million awarded by STFC during this time.
5. Of the 28 grants awarded to London ROs, Imperial College London obtained 10 and Queen Mary, University of London, received six.
