

Arts and Humanities Research Council: Grant Success Rates for 2015/16

- Awards for responsive, thematic and other grants during 2015/2016 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- From 123 ROs applying for grants, 33 were in London and of these 23 received one or more awards.
