

Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council: grant success rates for 2015/16

- Research proposal applications and awards during 2015/2016 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- From 103 ROs applying for grants, 16 were in London and 10 of these received one or more awards.

- The overall success rate for ROs in London was similar to 2014/15.
- ROs in London won £100 million, or 20% of the £509 million awarded by EPSRC in 2015/16.
- Of the 155 awards in London, 58 were to Imperial College London, 47 to UCL, 16 to King's College London and nine to Queen Mary, University of London.
