

Medical Research Council: grant success rates for 2015/16

- Grant and Fellowship applications during 2015/2016 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- Of 168 ROs applying for grants, 21 were in London and 10 received one or more awards.

- ROs in London were awarded nearly £98 million in grants, or 33% of the £294 million made available by MRC in this period.
- Of the 140 grants in London, 37 were obtained by King's College London, 36 by UCL, 26 by Imperial College London and 22 by the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine.
