

Medical Research Council: grant success rates for 2016/17

- Grant and Fellowship applications during 2016/2017 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- Of 184 ROs applying for grants, 31 were in London and 16 received one or more awards.

- ROs in London were awarded 34% of the £337 million made available by MRC in this period.
- Of the 154 grants in London, 38 were obtained by UCL, 34 by King's College London, 26 by Imperial College London and 22 by the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine.
