

Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council: grant success rates for 2016/17

- Research proposal applications and awards during 2016/2017 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- From 113 ROs applying for grants, 23 were in London and 14 of these received one or more awards.

- The overall success rate for ROs in London was similar to 2014/15 and 2015/16.
- ROs in London won 18% of the £533 million awarded by EPSRC.
- Of the 134 awards in London, 48 were to UCL, 37 to Imperial College London and 15 to King’s College London.
