

**Biotechnology and Biological Sciences Research Council: grant success rates for 2017/18**

- Awards for research grants submitted during 2017/2018 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- Of 109 ROs applying for grants, 17 were in London\* and of these 10 received one or more awards.
