

### Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council: grant success rates for 2017/18

- Research proposal applications and awards during 2017/2018 have been summarised by region and research organisation (RO).
- From 108 ROs applying for grants, 18 were in London and 11 of these received one or more awards.
