

TEACHING AND RESEARCH RECURRENT GRANTS FOR 2019-20

1. HE providers, including FE colleges and Alternative providers, in London have received a total of £908.4 million for teaching and research.
2. Teaching grants in London totalled £332.7 million with £327.3 million for 41 HE providers; £2.9 million for 12 FE colleges, and £2.5 million for 13 alternative providers.
3. Teaching grants for HE providers in London included £65.0 million for students living in the capital and £4.0 million for Erasmus+ and other overseas study programmes.
4. Research grants from Research England for London totalled £575.7 million 41 HE providers which formed 30% of total grant allocations.
5. Research grants to London included £54.6 million for knowledge exchange activities.
